First then I give and bequeath to my dear wife Sarah Lewis one cow and calf her choice and my housal (torn)f as she shall stand in need of during her

life or widowhood afterward to be equally divided between my two sons
Jeremiah and Thomas Lewis.

Next I give to my son Jeremiah Lewis two hundred acres of land on which I
now live likewise my bay horse and shoemakers tooles provided that this
Jeremiah find my wife Sarah an horse to ride when ever she wants and her
maintainance during her widowhood.

Next I give to my son Thomas Lewis my bed and furniture and also my
chest/next the mony that is in the hands of my son Phillip Lewis I desire he
may have ten pounds Verginy mony, my daughter Martha Dyer ten pounds my
grandson William Lewis one shilling (torn) the rest of that mony together
with my cattle hogs and all I possess to be equally divided between my two
sons Jeremiah and Thomas whereunto I set my hand and seal this 9 day of June 1796

Page 1128 ET.SEQ. of Biographical and historical memoirs of Mississippi Volume 1 published by the godspead publishing company of Chicago in 1891. The infomation begins with Colonel John South Lewis, Son of Aaron Lewis, of Kentucky and Virginia.

Col. John S. Lewis (deceased) one of Wilkinson county's most worthy citizens, as well as one of its earliest settlers, is worthy of extended notice in this work. He was so well and favorably known, and his high character was so strongly appreciated, that his name should be written high on the role of fame. He was a native of Virginia, born February 25 1780 and died on February 29 1848, and was of a family of nine sons and three daughters. when but a child his parents emigrated to Kentucky and located in what is now Harden county, where they engaged in the growing of tobacco, which special occupation they had successfully followed in Virginia. John S. was principally educated at home by his father, who was a highly cultured gentleman of the old school, and had followed teaching to some extent. The father took special pains in educating his children and preparing them for active and useful lifes. He was himself one of a large family, having been the eldest of nine sons and one daughter, he was a native of Virginia but finally came to Kentucky, where he lived until his death, well advanced in years and honors. He Marie a Miss South , also of Virginia, who was a lady of unusual refinement and education. She lived the allotted time, three-score years and ten, and was a noble woman, full of good deeds and purposes. John S at the age of fourteen years, commenced flat boating down the river to New Orleans for his father, carrying tobacco, provisions, etc., and each time having to make his way back overland, following the Indian and Natchez trails to his home in Kentucky. Thus he must have traversed what is now Wilkinson county before 1800. He was quite prominently connected with the history of this county and with the Indian troubles. He distinguished himself to such a degree as to receive the title colonel by general consent. Some few years after 1800 he came to Woodville, and is credited in Claiborne's history as having built the second house in the place. Here he engaged in merchandising for a great many years, and became quite well to do. He invested heavily in the West Feliciana railroad and the Planters bank, of Woodville. After retiring from his mercantile pursuits he devoted his time to his plantation near Woodville, and there he spent the remainder of his days. He was a ardent supporter of the Whig party, and kept himself thoroughly posted on the topic of the day. He was first married to a widow Bruce. To Mr and Mrs Lewis was born one daughter. Sarah Ann who died at the age of twelve years. Some years after the death of Mrs Lewis the Colonel married Eunice W Higgins, who still survives him. She was born in Main, November 11, 1812, and was the daughter of Theopilus and Sarah (Hodgkins) Higgins, who were both natives of Maine. Mrs Lewis was the fifth child of a family of nine, all of whom lived to be grown. When a girl of thirteen summers She then entered the Wilbraham Academy, near Boston, Mass., where she graduated in 1834 standing high in all of her classes. soon after graduation she came south with Freind, and lived near Jackson, LA., with the family of Mr Thomas, where she was Marie to Mr. Lewis in 1836. By this union were born seven

children - four sons and 3 daughter - five of whom lived to be grown, five of which are yet living: John S., Anna S., William H. H., Fletcher D., and Edward H. all of whom lived in this county. The other two died at Infancy. ** Mr Lewis was a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church, in which he took a very active part, was class leader and steward, and was also a very liberal supporter of the church. Mrs Lewis was a teacher in the first Sabbath school ever organized in Woodville, in which she took a very active part for many years. She was a highly cultured and respected lady, notwithstanding her age, is well preserved and in full possession of her faculties. She is still a teacher of Sunday School.

William H. H. Lewis was born June 28 1842 and while being educated at Centenary College, Mississippi and in the sophomore class, he entered the Confederate army, joining the Sixteenth Mississippi Regiment as orderly Sargeant, and soon after was promoted to first lieutenant for daring and brilliant service, and was finally killed in 1963 at Graines' farm. In the Army he was conspicuous for his daring and military genius, and as a student before the war, stood at the head of his classes. He would unquestionably have graduated with first honors had he remained at school. He was very highly respected by the faculty and the students.

Fletcher D. Lewis of Woodville is one of the representative citizens and successful planters of Wilkinson County, and is a scion of one of the most honored pioneer families of this count, where his father took up his abode more than a century ago. Mr Lewis was born in Woodville, Miss., January 10, 1884, being the son of John S. Lewis and Eunice W. (Higgins) Lewis, the former of whom was born in Virginia in 1780 and the latter of whom was born in Frenchmans Bay, Hancock County, Maine. John S Lewis was a child at the time of his parents removal from the Old Dominion to Kentucky, where he was reared to manhood. He made several trips to New Orleans of flatboat, down the Mississippi and Ohio rivers and returned home on horseback, passing through Mississippi. The first trip of this sort was made in 1794, when he was but fourteen years of age, and about 1800 he took up his residence in the little hamlet of Woodville, Wilkison county, Mississippi, where he passed the remainder of his life, having acquired much land in this locality, and having been one of these influential and honored pioneers of the state. He was a colonel in the Saminole war and was prominent in public and civic affairs in the early days. He died in 1848 and his wife survived him by a number of years. Fletcher D Lewis was about two years of age at the time of his fathers death, and was reared with solicitous care by his devoted mother. After leaving the school in his home town he entered the Centenary College of Jackson, La., where he was a member of the sophomore class at the time of the initiation of the Civil War. He forthwith enlisted in the confederate army becoming a member of Company K Sixteenth Mississippi Infantry with which he joined the fighting forces in Virginia, participating in the engagements at Front Royal, Port Republic and the valley campaign of Stonewall Jackson, Mr. and the seven days fight before Richmond, and the battle of Fredericksburg, Second Manassa, Sharpsburg or Antietam, Chancellorsville, Gettysburg, the Wilderness, Spottsylvania, in the "bloody angle" Petersburg and a number of engagements of minor importance. He was wounded in front of Petersburg 1864 and was home on Crutches at the time of the final surrender. He returned to his native country after the close of his service, and has been ever since identified with agricultural pursuits, being the owner of a well improved plantation of about 3,500 acres, while he is held in high esteem in the county which has figured as his home throughout life. He is a stanch Democrat, and served two terms and part of an unexpired term in the office of public trust. He is a member of the United Confederate Veterans and maintains a lively interest in his comrades of the Civil War On May 7, 1865 Mr. Lewis wed Miss Mary E Harris, daughter of Rev. Henry J and Nancy N.(Rogors) Harris, the father being a clergyman of the Methodist Episcopal Church South. and concerning the children of this union, the following data is entered- Dr William H is engaged in the practice of medicine in Fayette, Miss., Fletcher Jr and John S are deceased, Nannie E. is the wife of Henderson Aa Magruder of Woodville. Lyttleton is serving as treasurer of Wilkinson County, and Sidney M., is Deceased, and Mrs. Lewis are members of the Methodist Episcopal Church South.

Fletcher D. was born in Woodville, Mississippi, where he was reared, and while being educated at Centenary College, La., and in the freshman class, the first company for the war was organized at Woodville known as the Wilkinson rifles. He and his brother William H.H. came home at once to join them and went into the company a short time afterwards at Corinth, Miss., and four weeks latter was ordered to Virginia** After the war he returned to Wilkinson county, and was married to Mary E. Harris, daughter of Rev. H.J. and Nancy Harris, natives of

Mississippi. To Mr. and Mrs Lewis were born five children one of whom is deceased. Mr Lewis was elected Sheriff of Wilkinson county in 1885, which office he still holds to the entire satisfaction of the people. He takes no special parts in politics more than express the right of suffrage and to keep himself posted. Mr and Mrs Lewis are members of the Methodist Episcopal Church, and are very highly respected.

Lewis, the father of the subject of this sketch, was a native of Wilkinson county, and served for almost four years as a member of Co. K. Mississippi, being one of three brothers in that company, the others being Capt. Jno. S. Lewis and Lieut. W. H. Lewis. Mr F. D. Lewis was only 16 years of age when he enlisted and had another brother, E. H. Lewis who saw service under General Forest when only fourteen years of age. He was wounded at Petersberg, Va and was home on crutches when the war closed. He married Mis Mary Harris; to them on May 27th 1874, Lyttleton was born. He attended public schools of this community and was appointed to the Us Military academy at West point, New York. His eyes having failed him, he was forced to return home after one year of instruction.

Leaving school, Mr. Lewis went to Tensas parish where he spent a year and then returned to Wilkinson county to make his permanent home. On November 26 he married Miss Lizzie Morris a daughter of Mr and Mrs Monroe Morris of West Feliciana parish. The children of this union are Florence Euginia, a graduate of the A. H. In its long record of the events that have taken place in this county for more than a century this paper has never had to chronicle a sadder death than that of young Lyttleyon Lewis on last Sunday Aug 18 The tragic

news came as a overpowering shock to his many relatives and friends in this town, his birthplace and home up through his boyhood and in this county where he was so universally beloved. He passed away that afternoon as he was being taken to a hospital in Jackson for treatment after spending week at Brown's Wells where his physician had sent him for a rest cure and recuperation from an illness caused by overwork,. His remains were brought here the following day for funeral services conducted by Rev G P McKeown at the Woodville Methodist church of which he has been a member since childhood. They were laid to rest in the family lot in Evergreen Cemetery beneath a covering of beautiful flowers in the presence of a large crowd that assembled to show their affection and do honor to this fine young man who numbed his friends almost by his acquaintances.

Lyttleton Jr., a member of a family that has been prominent in the history of this section for over a hundred years, was born on Aug 7 1905, so he had just attained his thirtieth birthday and the prime of his young manhood. He was the older son of Mr Lyttleton Lewis, the clerk of the chancery court of this county and of Mrs Lewis. After graduation at the high school here, he secured work at a New Orleans bank, then later with a large tire concern there, so he made his home in that city until a year ago when his company promoted him to the management of a branch office in Jackson which responsible position he was holding at the time of his death. He is survived by his father and mother , two sisters Misses Elizabeth and Mary Lewis all of Woodville and a brother Mr Sydney M. Lewis of New York.
