Ewe, of the City Of Camden, in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, make and publish my last will and testament as follows: First: I direct all my just debts and funeral expenses to be paid as soon as may be reasonable after my decease. Second: I give and bequeath to my daughter, Anna E. Crall, the sum of Five hundred dollars. Third; I give, and bequeath to my son, Martin W. Ewe, the sum of one thousand dollars, and all my household goods wheresoever situate. Fourth: I give and bequeath to my grandson, Clarence Berryman, son of Harriet Berryman, my gold watch. Fifth: All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, whether real personal or mixed, and wheresoever situate, I give, bequeath and devise to my two other children, viz: Harriet Berryman and Laura Abdill, to be divided between them share and share alike. Sixth: I constitute and appoint George Blake sole executor of this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made. In Witness Whereof, i have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of November, A.D., one thousand nine hundred and ten. Martin J. Ewe (Seal) Signed, sealed, acknowledged, published and declared by the said martin J. Ewe, as and for his last will and testament, in the presence of us (both being present at the same time) who, at his request, in his presence, and in the presence of each other hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses. I, Harry Reeves, Surrogate of the County of Camden, do hereby certify that the foregoing is a true copy of last Will and Testament of Martin J. IN P'VILLE 25 YEARS -- Dies Without Knowing that Council Refuse to Appoint Him -- (Special to The Evening Union.) -- PLEASANTVILLE, April 19. Police officer David Ewe, son-in-law of Lewis Henry Barrett, an active Republican politician following his exciting career in the U. S. Secret revenue service in Kentucky, died at 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon at his home on Fourth Street here, after an illness lasting one week. Death was due to a complication of pluro-pneumonia and spinal meningitis. He was 54 years old and funeral services will be announced later. Mr. Ewe was born in Philadelphia and was the son of Frederick and Mrs. Elizabeth Ewe, the latter who survives him. At an early age Mr. Ewe assisted his father in managing his two hotels in Philadelphia. He then became a member of the U. S. Secret Service and was a member of the band of men who were sent by the Revenue officers to raid the large number of illicit liquor distilleries in the mountains of Kentucky. He had an exciting career and after working there for several years resigned and returned to Philadelphia where he was identified with the Sheriff's office for some time. Twenty-five years ago he came to Pleasantville and entered politics in the Republican party. He resided with his uncle, Henry Gouldy. In 1903 he was married to Miss Barrett and took up a permanent residence here. Since that time he has been engaged in politics in Atlantic County and was a member of the Second Ward Republican Club. At the time of his death he was serving as a borough Marshal and acted in this capacity for nearly two months expecting to receive the appointment from the borough council, which body refused to accept him on account of his advanced age. He died without knowing that he had been refused the marshalship, as he was ill in bed and unconscious when council took action. Ewe was identified with all the civic betterments in the town, and always fought for the Republican party. He leaves a wife, mother, one sister, Mrs. L. Lodge, of 336 S. 17 Street, Philadelphia; and two sons, David Ewe, Jr., aged 8 and Arthur Ewe, aged 3.

THEY CALLED HIM SHEENIE, DELIVERED AT MASS ON THE OCCASION OF MY FATHER'S DEATH, SEPTEMBER 15, 1979, BLESSED SACRAMENT CHURCH, MARGATE CITY, NEW JERSEY, Paul J. McQuade, Jr.

They called him Sheenie because he was the only person in his parochial school class to name the capital of Wyoming. It was Sheenie, Dad answered, and as far as we are concerned, it always will be. Sheenie went on to work for the Atlantic City Electric Company, his only employer for over 46 years. He did not want to be known as a job hopper. He never made vice president until yesterday when his obituary stated in error that he was a retired vice president. Dad would have had a good laugh over that one. I remember a vacation in Ocean City, sometimes commuting daily from Glassboro. Once Dad was riding a wave in with others as I stood on the beach and announced to all within hearing range that I knew exactly where he was because I followed his bald head in with the waves. I thought Dad was bald from birth. When the Pig War ended, Dad took Pete McQuade's old pistol into the back yard. Try to picture Sheenie with his finger in one ear and a pistol in his other hand crouching away from the gun, trying to get as far away from the noise as possible and no matter how low he crouched, the pistol and the noise was still only an arm's length away. I was disappointed the noise wasn't louder. I remember being chased home by some of my friends who lived in the neighborhood. We alternated picking on one another but I was receiving more than my share. Dad came out on the back porch and told me I was not to take any more of that crap. I turned, chased both boys across the yard, caught one and roughed him up quite a bit. I will never forget the smile on Dad's face. Although he did not do it often, I remember his coaching me on my little league baseball hitting. I had plenty of talent but no confidence. There was a method in his madness since Glassboro, the team I played for, was soon to play pitman in the area finals. In that game, after Dad's coaching, I cleared the bases with a game winning double. I felt great and my confidence was never better. Dad had succeeded. He was never prouder than in 1950 when the Pitman Kiwanis Club presented him with its Outstanding Citizen Award. It

was my honor to hand Dad the trophy. I remember the day my Mother and I left my Father and I had to tell him in private that the decision to separate was a joint decision I concurred with and would not try and convince my Mother otherwise. Dad made a promise to me that day which only he and I share. He never broke that promise. Although I have guilt feelings about that day, I feel good that I had the opportunity to tell him a dozen years later that he kept his word. Dad was an inveterate prankster. For years Army and Navy recruiters would visit and try and enlist Ed Coleman in Glassboro and Ed never knew how they got his name. A friend of Dads once complained to the Eagle's front office that his season seats were behind a pillar. Dad drove to Philadelphia, secured Eagles stationery, typed and postmarked a letter of response. He told the ticket holder he was a known complainer and cheap, suggesting that if he would spend a few more dollars he might get better seats. Boy, did it hit the fan. In 1964 Peg and Dad got married and I was honored to serve as best man. Peg was the best thing that ever happened to Dad. She knew how to cope with his stubborn Irish temper. I don't believe the first few years were easy for Peg but her incredible disposition and sense of humor carried her through. Then all else failed she would simply tell Dad to bug off. After the marriage Peg soon learned to fix things around the house -- she had to. To call Sheenie handy was a gross overstatement. With Dad a screwdriver was an instrument at destruction. To change a light bulb, he needed two people to rotate the ladder he stood on. While changing a flat tire Dad once jacked up the wrong wheel. Following a heart attack in the late 60's, Dad lost weight, slowed down, retired and prolonged his life. He had 15 good years of marriage with Peg. Dad lived to see the birth and development of his grandchildren, Annie and Paul --who is named after him. He loved them dearly and they are both puzzled and crushed by his death. Jane and I regret not living closer but we cherish the memories of those times when we were together. The children remember Pop Pop and Peg on those special occasions and who could ask for more. Sheenie had eight years of retirement and enjoyed every minute. I once asked him and he said retirement was "the frosting on the cake" and he meant it. Dad made many sacrifices to send me to college and subsequently to graduate school. He said the education would be my ticket to success - it would open doors for me. Significantly, my last communication from Dad was two days before his death. He had mailed a clipping from the Atlantic City Press which announced my appointment as Administrator and Chief Executive Officer of South Coast Medical Center in South Laguna, California. The doors had opened and Dad knew it before he died. John and Paul were closer than brothers. They were two completely opposite personalities and yet they were one. They enjoyed and played tricks on one another. Dad would set John up for the inevitable trap and John, playing his role well, would fall in it. As is the privilege of all older brothers, Dad would on occasion read John the riot act -- and get away with it. The past few years Dad visited John and Helen at least once and sometimes twice a day. His love and devotion to John is legendary. I never knew my Father to tell a lie. He had prejudices but he never passed them along to me. He did not want to bother anyone and would be embarrassed by the attention he received today. He would have an absolute fit if he knew how much Peg had paid for his casket. I never saw or heard him deliberately harm another person. He never shirked responsibility. People liked and respected him. Annie, our eight year old, tried to comfort me on Wednesday.
