Notes for William Lilburn;

At a July 22, 1775 trial held by the General Committee, Archibald Campbell and William Lilburn, factors at Leonard Town and St Inigoes were found guilty of violating one of the resolves which prohibited the export of provisions of any kind from the Colony, (History of St. Mary's County, Regina Hammett). Archibald was also from Scotland.

In 1775 William was a Merchant whose property was destoried by the British in 1781.

When Willaim made his will 4/14/1800, one of the witnesses was his brother, Robert Lilburn Jr.

John Gray Sr., 60 died at the residence of Dr. John M. Brome in 1st dist., 19 Jan. 1885. Last surviving s/o late Robert Lilburn, one of a number of Scotch gentlemen notable among whom were Archibald, Binny, John Thompson and others who came to St. Mary's County, Maryland about the begining of the century. John Gray married early in life, his wife preceeded him in death. He lost a great part of his property by the "Cruel War". (Beacon 1/22/1885).
