Buried in the northwest corner of Richmond Cemetery. Enter the cemetery through the road currently marked Entrance (the entrance and exits will be switched in the near future), that is the road on the east off W. Main St. Go up the paved road and turn west when the paved road goes west. Park where the paved road goes south. Follow the unpaved path (extension of the paved road south) north until you are about 3/4 of the way to the end of the cemetery. Her grave will be on the left side of the path (to the west). There are no existing records of the lot numbers for this cemetery, so search for awhile in that area. Go to the Genealogical Library and make a copy of the Location page 2, to see the names on the stones in the vicinity of her's. She is buried near STEWARTs, WOLFES, and other LOVEs. His obituary was carried on the front page of the Daily Standard newspaper, Excelsior Springs, Missouri, June 4, 1963:

George Love, 86: Rites Thursday

Funeral services for George Love, 86, of 206 North Marietta, will be held 2:30 p. m. Thursday at Prichard Funeral home. Burial will be in Sunnyslope cemetery at Richmond. Mr. Love died Sunday, June 2, at the Clay County home at Chandler. He was born August 7, 1876, in Morristown, [Hamblen County] Tennessee, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Samuel Love. He had been a resident here 39 years. Mr. Love had been a member of the Latter Day Saints church. He was a retired coal miner. Surviving are two sons, Bennie Love, this city; Baxter Love, Phoenix, Arizona; a brother, Noah Love, St. Joseph; a sister, Mrs. Nan Blair, St. Joseph; a half brother, Arthur Love, Richmond; 12 grandchildren and 19 great grandchildren. Worked as a coal miner for the Wilson Coal Mining Company, Richmond, Ray County, Missouri, from April 1913 to May 1917.

Enlisted in the United States Army May 31, 1917 at Mt. Vernon, Missouri; service number: 001027660; Honorably discharged March 31, 1919 at Camp Travis, Bexar County, Texas [rank-cook] 35th Infantry; Re enlisted April 1, 1919; Honorably discharged March 31, 1920 at Camp Lewis, Washington [rank-cook] Company "F", 35th Infantry; Reentered the U.S. Army November 17, 1920 at Camp Lewis Washington; Honorably discharged July 17, 1921 at Camp Travis, Texas [rank-Specialist 4th Class] Headquarters Company, 3rd Infantry Brigade; Reentered the U.S. Army February 5, 1922 at Camp Travis, Texas; Honorably discharged February 4, 1925 at For Sam Houston, Texas [rank-sergeant] Headquarters Company, 3rd Infantry Brigade. William initially enlisted in the U.S. Army with the desire to serve as a Doughboy in the American Expeditionary Forces in Europe. As luck would have it he was instead ordered to protect the border with Mexico and the United States at Douglas, Cochise County, Arizona. It was during that assignment that he developed a flavor for the American Southwest; and where the seed was most probably sown that would lead him to plant his roots in South Texas. Notes for MARÍA ISABELLA CARDENAS CAMPOS:

María Isabella was baptized on November 7, 1902 by Father E. Illa, O.M.I. at San Agustín Catholic Church in Laredo, Webb County, Texas. Anastasio Garza and Rafaela Guzmán were her padrinos.

María Isabella, 6, and her sister Macrina, were placed in St. Joseph's Orphanage for Girls September 9, 1909 by their grandmother. Their father, Faustino Campos, brought them to San Antonio from the Mexican border in a covered ox cart; it is believed, shortly after their mother's death. The following entry was located in the Rare Books and Documents, 162:3, Book of Remarks: Girls 1887-1928. (Catholic Archives: San Antonio, TX), p. 86: "Macrina 8, Isabella Campos legitimate children of Faustino Campos and Josepha Cardenas. Their mother is dead but their father is not. They do not know where he has been for the past five years. The children were placed in the orphanage by their grandmother Josepha Cardenas. It is only their grandmother who can have any claim to them. They have also an older sister who is married and who is to visit them. Macrina born January 14, 1899, Isabella born May 12, 1902. Entered September 9, 1908. Taken out by their grandmother September 23, 1914."

Requiem Mass conducted at Little Flower Catholic Church, 10 AM on February 17, 1959. Bearers were: Reynaldo San Roman; Joe Chin; Jerry Garcia; Luis Lara; and Alberto Campos. Mission Funeral Home, 2602 W. Commerce, San Antonio 7, Texas handled the arrangements. Burial in San Fernando Catholic Archdiocese Cemetery #2.
