POSSIBLE FAMILY CONNECTIONS

Francis Malone is a cypher. He is only mentioned in his father's will. His sister was born 1811 Ft. St. Stephens, Ala., where his father was magistrate, land agent, asst. Indian agent who with Lt. Gaines arrested Aaron Burr. I desc. Francis brother, Capt. Edward Malone, Sr., CSA, Mobile cotton broker, born Mobile 1825.

From Malone's Mill Creek, Warren Co., N.C., in 1799 Thomas Malone was land clerk, Raleigh, N.C. By 1802 he

had removed to Ft. St. Stephens, Ala., with his Norsworthy kin, where he was land office agent, asst. Indian agent under Gaines, and magistrate. His wife was Mrs. Mary S. Malone. They married circa 1778 to 1806.

Thomas Malone arrive Ft. St. Stephens, Ala., circa 1802, then removed to Wakefield, Ala., and finally Mobile. He arrived from Raleigh, N.C., born Malone's Mill Creek, Warren County, N.C. His wife who died Mobile was Mrs. Mary S. Malone. Was she the daughter of Col. Nathaniel Baxter of Granville County, N.C.?

Thomas Malone, Sr., 1802 was land agent, magistrate, asst Indian agent, Fort St. Stephens, Ala. His wife was Mary S. Malone. Was her maiden name "Slade".

2. Burton Smith³ Malone (George M.², /Malone/ (Father of George M.¹ Malone)) was born October 12, 1842 in Washington Co.?, AL, and died January 06, 1907 in Madisonville, Madison Co., TX. He married **Clarissa Isabelle Steele**, daughter of William Steele and Isabelle Brazel. She was born April 02, 1840 in Illinois, and died March 10, 1913 in Madisonville, Madison Co., TX.

Notes for Burton Smith Malone:

The following are excerpts from the article, "Family of Burten Smith Malone." This family history was submitted by William Ray Malone and published in the "History of Madison Co., TX:"

"At the onset of the Civil War, Burten enlisted in Fisher's Company, Hood's Brigade. He participated in battles in Virginia and Louisiana, was on detached duty at the Second Battle of Galveston, and served in Sibley's Expedition to New Mexico. He recalled having narrowly escaped punishment for theft of a Spanish land-owner's overcoat on a cold night near Albuquerque, and having incurred the anger of his commander for predicting the ultimate defeat of the Confederacy. His last service for the South was the concealment near Houston of the "Twin Sisters," artillery pieces first used at San Jacinto."

"...Despite his Confederate background, Burten was appointed special policeman for Madison County by Republican Governor Davis. Burten farmed east of Madisonville and was a brickmaker and mason. He made the brick used to construct the Madison County Courthouse in 1893, and supervised its erection for the county."
