Family tradition has it that he saved the life of General Morgan by killing a British soldier before he could kill Morgan. Henry received a horse and bridle for this act. Claudia also states that a cousin of hers owns the guns that Henry used in the Revolution. (Carolyn Malone, Nov. 08, 1998)

Per WFT Vol 9, Tree 1551, Henry Hall was born about 1765 in England and died June 04, 1831 in St. Helena Parish, LA. He married Mary Jane Ross about 1781. About 1780, Henry fought in the Battle of Cowpens in Revolutionary War and he saved the life of a superior officer. In 1790, he moved to Louisiana, and later to Mississippi.

**16. Britton<sup>4</sup> Hall** (Henry<sup>3</sup>, Robert<sup>2</sup>, James<sup>1</sup>) was born Abt. 1795 in Wilkes Co., GA, and died 04 Jun 1849 in Pine Grove, Newton Co., TX. He married **Harriett Pool** 04 Jul 1820 in St. Tammany Parish, LA; Ebenezer Ford officiated., daughter of William Pool, Jr.. She was born 1806 in Bullock Co., GA, and died 01 Aug 1856 in Newton Co., TX.

Notes for Britton Hall:

The following passage was transcribed by Larry Hall (from a document from his father's research), son of Earl Grice Hall who did extensive research on Britton Hall's family in the 1920s & 30s:

"Britton served in the War of 1812, De Clouet's Regiment, Louisiana Militia, discharged March 15th, 1815 at New Orleans, Louisiana. (His brothers, John & James, also served in De Clouet's Regt., Capt. Laughlin's Co.)

In 1829, Britton crossed the Sabine River into Texas and settled on Thickety Creek, a tributary of the Sabine, about 6 miles S. E. of the present city of Jasper, Texas. He moved his little family and all their possessions there in 1830. He is shown on the first census of Texas, Bevil District, 1829-1835. His age is shown as 34, but this is a transposition and in error. His occupation is listed as "cooper," but he also farmed and raised cattle and hogs. At the time of his death, he owned 4,740 acres of land and other real and personal property and was considered well off by standards of that time. He was a patriot of the Revolution. A man of good moral habits, etc., is attested by the fact he received a good character certificate, made out and signed by John Bevil, Alcade of the area. He was one of three commissioners elected by Jasper County to examine the land office and was commissioned on Jan. 4th, 1840. He received a grant of land, one league and labor and purchased many other parcels of land. In 1843, he built a home on the Ruffin Turner Grant in Newton Co., that being one of the parcels he had bought. He died there on June 4th, 1849, and he is buried on the old home site. A large marker was erected there in his honor. (A project of a great-great grandson, Prentiss Hall, Jr., who lives in Liberty Co., Daisetta, Texas - 1965.) There are five unmarked graves by Britton's." END OF PASSAGE.

Stella's death certificate lists her last place of residence as 707 Wilson Blvd., Clarendon, VA. She died in Emergency Hospital in Washington D. C. on April 02, 1921. The cause of death was emphysema thoracis & pulmonary tuberculosis both due to myocardial insufficiency. She had surgery on March 30-31 and was in the hospital for six (6) days before she died. She was buried in Falls Church, VA on April 04, 1921. On the death certificate, her father is listed as Wm. McGlothlin born in W. Va, and her mother is listed as Ellen Broadus born in W. Va (or W. Pa).
