The History of The Daly Family

Preface

Origins

The Dalys are descended from an ancient Irish family. The name is an Anglicization of the gaeil O'Dalaigh 'descendent of Dalach'. Dalach is a personal name meaning "frequenting assemblies". The name goes back 1,500 years to King Naille of the 9 Hostages. O'Dalaigh was the son and scribe for the chieftain. Down through the years, the Daly family served many tribal chieftans as the recorder of annals and court poet. The Daly name has been prominent in Gaelic literature. There is a continuous record of literary achievement from the 12th to the 17th century. Cunconnacht O'Dalaigh who lived in the 12th century was a celebrated poet. Also living in the 12th century was Donogh Mor O'Daly, a poet who has been referred to as "the Irish Ovid".

Some kings of Meath were from the Daly clan. Later, a branch of the clan went to Thomond which is an area of Ireland that today consists of most of County Clare and a small part of County Limerick. Still later, a branch split off and went to Connaught. An interesting aside is that some historians suspect that the High King Nialle led the raid in which Saint Patrick was kidnapped when he was a teenager. This would have been about 395 A.D. Saint Patrick escaped after several years of enslavement. He later returned to Ireland as a Bishop sometime around 432 A.D.

Forced Migration

In the 16th century, our particular branch of the Daly clan was centered in Wwestmeath. There remains today, a town called Dalystown which is 10 miles south of Mullingar in County Westmeath. Apparently the Dalys in Westmeath had property and were well off. It was in 1653 that Oliver Cromwell came to power in Ireland. As a result of continuous British oppression, Cromwell evicted Irish Catholics who owned land from their property. The expression "To Connaught or Hell" was used by Cromwell. Each family had a choice. They could uproot their belongings and move to Connaught, a province in western Ireland which included five counties where the land was poor or they would end up in hell. Our forefathers gathered up their women, children, horses, wagons and panniers and crossed the Shannon into County Roscommon. The Dalys were late in arriving and so had to settle with less desirable property high up in the Arigna valley. The low lands were already settled by earlier refugees. They eventually settled on the side of a mountain in the Towland of Greaghnaulough in Roscommon.

Penal Times

The first of the penal laws was enacted against Catholics in 1695. The first penal law forbade any Catholic to own a gun, a sword or any weapon which could be deemed offensive or for that matter, defensive. Other suppressive laws were soon to follow. The land in Ireland was given to various gentry for services they may have rendered to the crown. In our case, the land had

been given to Colonel King Tenison and passed on to the Earl of Kingston who in the words of the local peasantry, was a tyrant of the first order. Lord Kingston was of such a nature that he demanded that the local peasantry not look upon his fair daughters. If his family went out in the carriage, outriders would drive back any peasants along the road so that none would look upon his womenfolk. The story goes that some people were beaten to death for the pleasure of looking at the ladies. Lord Kingston maintained a residence in Kilronan Castle. An ironic turn of events occurred in later years. Kilronan Castle was put up for auction. Michael Leyden, who is a grandson of Ann Daly, purchased the property.

The people had to pay rent for the land on which they settled. The penal laws were even more penalizing in that if the tenant made an improvement to the property, his rent increased. This resulted in low housing standards in the West of Ireland. Houses went without windows even when there were window frames so that no improvement would be noted. The penal laws extended to all areas of daily life. No Catholic was allowed to teach in school or even attend school. No Catholic was allowed to own land or to conduct business. No Catholic was permitted to own a horse. The local citizenry began a system of schooling called "Hedgerow School". An Uncle of Pat Lehany was among the last of the Hedgerow schoolmasters. He taught groups of students in hedgerows or on the side of the road. Tuition was a penny per week. There were several attempts of rebellion from 1700 to the middle 1880's but in general, the penal times were a burden borne by the Dalys along with other Irishmen. The enforcement of the penal laws and therefore the amount of burden felt by the local people varied by which monarch was in power or the level of threat that the "Ascendancy" to power felt. The "Ascendancy" refers to both the English gentry and to Irish Protestants who were primarily of English descent and could therefore hold public office in Ireland.

The Potato Famine

The potato famine began in 1845 and lasted until 1849. The worst years were 1847 and 1848. In order to understand the full impact of the famine, you must realize that Ireland was almost totally an agricultural society. The potato was her economy. Potatoes were introduced to Ireland from America by Sir Walter Raleigh and were immediately accepted because of the ease with which potatoes are grown. Soil requirements were minimal and potatoes needed almost no attention. For these reasons, the potato was the crop of choice especially in the West where the land was rocky. There were almost eight million people in Ireland (compared with 5 million in 1989). The population was reduced from 8 million to 5 million as a result of the famine. 1.5 million emigrated to other countries while another 1.5 it is said, starved to death. The population figures include the six counties of Northern Ireland. These numbers take on more significance when you realize that most of the exposure to famine problems was in the West of Ireland. The farms of Connaught averaged no more than five acres and small farms were particularly hit by the famine. In Mayo, for example, over 450 people were dependent on each arable acre. Similar numbers apply to each of the counties of Connaught. The famine was devastating to the Dalys and other farmers in the West.

Farmers Rebellion

As time went on to about 1880, the people rose up against the landlords. The decided to band together and not pay their rents. The Dalys were prominent in this agitation. Johnny Daly who was a quiet, thoughtful man was involved. When the rental agent came to Johnny, he was told that the tenants were not going to pay the rent. The agent said that he had heard about this but that the leader of the tenants rebellion had already paid his rent. Johnny didn't believe the agent at the time but it turned out to be true. The ex-leader of the rebellion was forced to leave the country to save his skin. He lived in Scotland for his remaining years. Johnny Daly and his family were evicted by soldiers from Kilronan Castle for non-payment of rent. The house was torn down by the soldiers who then camped on the site. Johnny's son Tom remembered carrying potatoes to the soldiers who were living on the site of the old house when we was a small boy After the soldiers left, the house was rebuilt and the Dalys returned to the property. There was a concern that if a farmer was evicted from his farm that someone else could bid on the property and take over by resuming the rent payments. Our people wondered how to deal with those who would take advantage of this situation. A rent agent in County Mayo became involved in just such a matter. The local people decided to ignore him totally. The name of the rental agent was Boycott. The word "boycott" got its meaning from this situation.

Land Reform

Shortly after the start of the 20th century several land reform acts were passed. The first was passed in 1903 followed by another in 1909. These acts allowed tenants to purchase the property on which they resided. The net cost to the Irish farmer was less than what he had paid before the acts were passed. The acts provided for the State (Britain) to purchase the lands from the land owners and to sell the lands to the tenant farmers. The loan was carried by the State at some minimal interest. The payments were called "land annuities". Farmers were given the opportunity to upgrade their property to what was known as an "economic holding". That is, sufficient property to support the owner and his family. Tom Daly took advantage of this offer and traded is small farm on the side of the mountain for about 40 acres near the town of Boyle. The small farm that was traded was given to the Lehany family by the Land Commission and merged with other property that the Lehany's already owned to form an "economic holding". Tom Daly lost the new farm as a result of some bad decisions.

The Irish Freestate

The 1916 rebellion in Dublin eventually led to treaty in 1922 with Britain which established the Irish Freestate. Ireland would be divided. The Irish Freestate would become a commonwealth with its own governing body while the six counties of the north would continue as a direct province of Britain. Even though this treaty was agreed to by both Britain and Ireland, there are many people in Ireland who bitterly opposed the concept that Ireland would be split. Civil war ensued. Ireland elected its first stable government in 1932 under Eamon di Valera. One of the first acts of the new Irish government was to suspend land annuity payments to Britain. Why should poor Ireland pay wealthy Britain for land that rightfully belonged to Ireland? The economic war followed.

Economic Reprisals From Britain

Because of the suspension of land annuity payments, England placed a boycott on Irish goods. Since Ireland had not developed any of the markets for its agricultural products other than England, the boycott was effective. Irish families everywhere in Ireland had a surplus of native products such as beef and potatoes and a dearth of necessities that had to be imported. Michael Daly reports an incident where a local farmer stopped by to visit on his way home. He carried a large piece of beef which he laid by the ditch as he talked. After a while, he left, leaving the beef. Tom Daly called to him reminding him to take his meat. He responded "Oh, to hell with it. Let the dogs have it". Such was the attitude about local products. Ireland retaliated. The slogan in Ireland was "Burn anything British except her coal". The effect of the Irish boycott on English products was minuscule. Only the onset of WW II ended the economic war.

Independence (Of Sorts)

Ireland declared herself to be a republic in 1949 and England agreed. The internal bitterness remains. The same attitude prevails among many Irishmen as cause the civil wars of the early 1920's. They feel that there should be but one Ireland, a republic independent of any foreign influence which should include the six counties of the North. And the strife goes on.
