Casper was born March 28,1853 and died Dec. 3,1936.He was 83 when he died ....., He lived 15 years longer .Elizabeth,he died at the age of 83.Charles was 45 when his father died. (wife) Sallie was 36,Robert Kimble was 18,James Lawerence was 16,and Charles Edward was,13. His mother Elizabeth was born January 16,1854,died April 29,1922. She was 63 when she died. She died when Charles Kimbe was 32,(wife Sallie was 22)There children Robert Kimbe was 4,James Lawerence was 2,Charles Edward wasn't born yet. They are both buried at Big Bone Cemetery,Boone County,Kentucky.Along with ,, children,Fred, Mary Ann and Hattie Lou Marksberry and (Lou's husband John Thomas Allphine,die in car accident at age 36. 1893-1929) Lou died at the age 54,1889-1943.

This could be the right age for James to be married Mary Kimball who had married 1860. Willis and Sarah show up on the 1860 census with Nancy J. Marksberry ... This time he is listed as 65 ??? but Sarah and Nancy have gain 10 years to 63 and 17 respectively. When there is a difference usually take as the time of the year when census information is gathered by 1870.

Sarah is listed as 74 with Nancy J. Marksberry as 28, take that Willis has died somewhere between 1860 and 1870, as he is not listed. Also shows Willis Served as a PVT. in Capt. Myer's and Anderson's (later Laosley's) Kentucky Militia. He enlisted in Capt. James Anderson's Co., Second Regt. Ky. Military on 9/1/1812 and was engaged to Sarah Milroy 10/1/1812. His pension number is WC-3271. According to 1820 Census, they had Peggy, Teresa, Nancy J., and William M., James L., and John R. Marksberry.

John Marksberry ,,,,,,,,,,,,,, is the 2nd Great--- Grand Father of \*Charles Kimble Marksberry\* , who was born 1768 in Amherst , Virginia, .Died 1/Feb/1835. Grant County, Ky. Married Catherine Franks born 1770 in Pennsylvania. Married 4/feb/1794, Lincoln, Ky. John and Catherine move to Grant County, Kentucky around 1800. John was the first to spell the name Marksberry, in this way. Catherine died 1852 , Grant County, Ky.

Sources::, John was the member of the Constalk Militia of Kentucky. Serving as an Ensign in the 26th Regiment , 2nd Brigade , 1st Division dated June 15, 1799 and July 30, 1799. John was a member of the Grant County Kentucky Legislature, House of Representatives from 1824 through 1826. On April 12, 1820 John was recommended to the Governor to be Commissioned as the first surveyors , that being a profession in that day of considerable dignity and demand. John owned land around Sugar Creek , Ky.
