In 1819, during one of the famines which took place in Ireland, Felix migrated to Canada. Apparently, at that time, anyone from the Antrim area was told before leaving to disembark at Montreal and follow the south bank of the St. Lawrence River until they came to the Chateaugay River and follow it to a point known as Mooney's Mill which was on the Hinchinbrook River. Many Irish families settled in this vicinity, namely Lahey, McMullen, O'Leary, McGinnis, Donnelley, Layhon, Mooney, McCaffrey, Duffin, McCann, and many others. There was another mill on a brook in Rockburn and Felix settled there. He married Mary McMullen and for a time, owned the Johnston farm in Chateaugay later owned by Stewart Swantson. He later went back to Canada and settled on the farm that now belongs to Gerald McCormick.

"Pat" Meehan Dies Monday Of Heart Attack.

Was One Of First Businessmen In Village, Here 63 Years.

The following article is gleaned from a Blooming Prairie, Minn., newspaper relative to the death of Patrick Meehan, who died on May 5th. Mr. Meehan was a brother of the late Mrs. Hugh Lavery, of Chateaugay, and an uncle of Mrs. Daniel Flynn, of Burke, Mrs. W. E. Lefebvre, of Huntingdon, Mrs. George Murphy, of Ormstown, Que., Mrs. Bernard Phillips and Mrs. Hubert Denesha, of Syracuse.

Patrick Meehan, 85, prominent retired business man and one of this community's oldest citizens died on Monday afternoon, May 5th, at his home here.

His death followed a heart attack suffered Wednesday of last week. He had been confined to his home since last Wednesday, but his condition had not been considered extremely serious.

Funeral services were held here Wednesday morning at St. Columbanus Catholic church where the Rev. Father Paul A. Colbert, of Incarnation church, Minneapolis, read the requiem mass. Father Colbert is a brother-in-law of Mrs. John Colbert, daughter of Mr. Meehan. The Rev. Father J. V. Donovan, gave the sermon. Hundreds of friends and neighbors attended the funeral to pay tribute to one of Blooming Prairie's leading citizens and one of its first business men. Interment was made in the cemetery here.

Mr. Meehan was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Meehan and was born in Franklin Center, Quebec April 11, 1856.

At the age of 20 he came to Iowa where he became interested in caring for horses and obtained employment in that line of work. A year later he came to Claremont, Minn. where he cared for a string of

horses. In 1873, 63 years ago, Mr. Meehan moved to Blooming Prairie where he became a widely known livestock buyer in partnership with the late Tom Barry. In addition to buying livestock, Mr. Meehan conducted a livery stable and farmed for a short time. He was married to Miss Sarah Almond, of Fort Covington after coming to Minnesota Mrs. Meehan passed away in 1914.

For a number of years after becoming established in business Mr. Meehan served the village as mayor. He always maintained a active interest in civic affairs and all community activities. Mr. Meehan remarried in 1919. Surviving are Mrs. Meehan and five children by his first marriage. Mr. Meehan was the last member of a family of ten children. His last brother, Felix, died at the family homestead in Franklin Center, Que., in 1937.

A large number of friends and admirers from Minneapolis, St. Paul, Albert Lea, Claremont and other distant points, attended the funeral.

Mr. Meehan's passing has taken one of Blooming Prairie's most colorful figures. "Pat", as he was known to all, was a daily visitor in the business district and he took a keen interest in all village community affairs. He was a man well posted in current events and was regarded as an influential man in political circles in this area. As one of the first business men to come to Blooming Prairie, when the village was but a country crossroads, Mr. Meehan's aggressiveness and activity had much to do with the up building of this town. His death is mourned by all who knew and admired his gallant nature.

The community was greatly shocked on Monday, February 12th to learn of the sudden passing of Miss Mary McCormick, which occurred at 2:20 o'clock at the home of her brother, Felix McCormick, in Brooklet.

Miss McCormick was born in Hinchinbrook, 67 years ago, a daughter of the late John and Rose (O'Meara) McCormick. She was educated in the local schools and always made her home at the homestead where she died.

Miss McCormick possessed a quiet and sterling character, was one who always had a kind word for everyone and will be greatly missed by all who knew her.

She is survived by two brothers, John, of Chateaugay; and Felix, of Hinchinbrook' one sister-in-law, Mrs. W. D. McCormick, of Huntingdon, Que., besides numerous nephews and nieces.

At his home in Hinchinbrook, Que., at 10:30 o'clock on Wednesday morning occurred the death of Felix McCormick, following a gradual decline in health.

The deceased was born at Hinchinbrook 76 years ago and had been a lifelong resident of that place. He was a farmer by occupation and was thorough and progressive in this line. The deceased was in every sense a most exemplary and upright man, one whose friendship was prized and his loss is keenly mourned.

Mr. McCormick was a devout member of St. Patrick's church at Hinchinbrook, a former member of Wadhams Council Knight of Columbus at Chateaugay.

Mrs. McCormick was born in Chateaugay, a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. William Healey. She attended local schools. After her marriage to Mr. McCormick about 50 years ago she has since resided in Canada.

The deceased numbered her friends by all who knew her. She was a steadfast loving Christian woman, active in all good works and deeds. Her home was the scene of happiness and contentment and her loss will be deeply felt by her family and also in the community, where she has always lived. Struck by a truck as she alighted from a bus in Albany during a heavy rainstorm late yesterday afternoon, Miss Margery McCormick, of Chateaugay, died last night in Albany hospital.

Miss McCormick, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Felix McCormick, and a post-graduate at the New York State Teachers' college, suffered a concussion of the brain and numerous lacerations.

Local Woman Killed In Albany

Miss Marguerite McCormick Struck By Truck During Severe Storm in Capital City.

The saddest news to reach Chateaugay in a long period was that of the death of Miss Marguerite McCormick, which occurred at 8 o'clock Tuesday evening in an Albany hospital.

The death of this popular and estimable young lady was attributable to a wild storm of rain, hail, wind and lightening which swept over Albany at 4 o'clock that afternoon. Miss McCormick was fatally injured when she alighted from a bus and was run down by a truck. The heavy rain prevented her from noticing the oncoming truck, and the driver states his vision was so impaired by the storm that he did not see the young lady as she endeavored to reach the sidewalk.

Miss McCormick had been in Albany since February taking a post-graduate course at the State College for Teachers.

Mr. and Mrs. McCormick started for Albany as soon as the sad news was received, but did not reach the city until after their daughter's demise.

Miss McCormick was born at Hinchinbrook, Que., on February 28, 1904. She graduated from Chateaugay High School and Teachers Training Class in 1923, and graduated from Potsdam Normal. She taught school in Amsterdam a year and at Westbury, Long Island for two years. She resigned that position and matriculated at New York University, graduating in 1932 with a B. A. Degree. At the time of the accident she was attending State College for Teachers, working for a master's degree. Miss McCormick's ability was recognized as her advancement had been won by faithfulness and fitness.

She was regarded as one of the finest young ladies of the community, a general favorite of all, and one who commanded the highest regard. In her untimely demise there is the deepest sorrow expressed and so far as the human sympathy may be conveyed this is given in the fullest measure to the members of the grief stricken family.

She is survived by her parents, Mrs. and Mrs. Felix McCormick, one sister, Miss Florence, of Lake Placid, five brothers, Arthur, of Baltimore, Md., Clifford, of Saranac Lake, Earl, of Chateaugay, Francis and Gerald, of Hinchinbrook.

Funeral services will be held Friday morning at 9:30 from St. Patrick's church in Hinchinbrook.

MAN AND WOMAN HELD FOR CROSSING LINE ILLEGALLY

Miss Blanche Serokey, 24, attractive Czechoslovakian girl, and Thomas J. Corbin, 55, of Clinton, Mass., accused of assisting her in illegally crossing the international border near Cooks Line, north of Chateaugay, were held for Federal Court when they waived examination before U. S. Commissioner Herbert C. Genaway.

The two, who had previously called for an examination, announced a change of mind when the case was called. They were represented by Attorney George J. Moore.

After they had been ordered held for court, they were taken back to the county jail by Deputy U. S. Marshall Thomas McKenna.

Miss Serokey is charged with illegal entry within a year of a prior deportation. She stated that she was deported from Boston in April of this year and before that had resided at Clinton, Mass., for several months.

Earl McCormick, a Chateaugay youth, was released after immigration officials had charged the youth with harboring the young women in his automobile. He was discharged following a hearing before Commissioner Genaway.

Miss Serokey is alleged to have walked across the border after being brought to the Canadian side of the line in a taxi. She is then alleged to have gotten into the McCormick car which was later halted by immigration officials. Mr. McCormick testified at his hearing that he had no knowledge that she was an alien and that all he knew of the matter was that he was to meet a woman at that point and bring her to the "cement road" north of Chateaugay, receiving payment for the service.

Mr. Corbin was halted in his own automobile at almost the same time the girl was apprehended.

Earl McCormick Acquitted On Smuggling Charge

Before Commissioner Hubert C. Genaway at Malone on Wednesday a motion was granted for the dismissal of Earl McCormick, 24, of Chateaugay charged with having assisted an alien to enter this country illegally. The motion was made by McCormick's attorney, H. W. Main and was strenuously opposed by John D. Ryan, of Malone, head of the local immigration office.

McCormick was arrested Sunday afternoon near Chateaugay with Miss Blanch Serokey, 24, a Czechoslovakian alien, and Thomas J. Corbin 53 of Clinton, Mass. The latter two will be given a hearing Thursday. Miss Serokey on a charge of entering illegally within a year after deportation and Corbin with having aided and abetted her entry.

The government charged that Miss Serokey was brought to Cook's lines, north of Chateaugay, and that after crossing on foot she was taken in McCormick's car and driven toward Chateaugay while Corbin entered regularly at the immigration office.

In moving for discharge of his client Mr. Main argued that McCormick had no guilty knowledge that the woman who got into his car was from Canada and an alien, and that there was no evidence he had brought her in from Canada. McCormick claiming to have picked her up on the American side.

Inspector Ryan told the court in opposing the motion that McCormick had made a trade to bring the girl into the country for \$5 and his trade had been made while he was in Canada and that when the woman got into his car he knew she was from Canada.

In granting the motion the commissioner said he felt there was no probable cause to believe the defendant committed a crime intentionally.

Inspector Ryan announced he would present the facts to the United States office and would attempt to indict the your over the commissioner's decision.

Dr. Gerald McCormick, Veterinary Killed In Car Accident.

Returning from anniversary party early Saturday morning when accident occurred.

A very tragic accident occurred early Saturday morning, when Dr. Gerald McCormick and Dennis McKeegan were returning home from an anniversary party at Kenneth Finlayson's. They left there, proceeding east on the River Outarde Road, at 3:45 a.m., and at approximately 4:15 a.m. the accident occurred.

From all reports, the driver, Dr. G. McCormick, on hitting a bump lost control of the car where the gravel road joints the tarvia road. The car skidded along the ditch for about 100 feet, then struck a telephone pole and turned over several times. Dr. Gerald McCormick was killed instantly, while Dennis McKeegan was rushed to the Barrie Memorial Hospital. He was removed from there to the Neurological Institute, Royal Victoria Hospital later. McKeegan never regained consciousness, and he died on Sunday, at 3 p.m.

Dr. McCormick was 25 years of age and was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Felix McCormick, of Hinchinbrooke. Besides his parents, he is survived by one sister, Miss Florence McCormick, a teacher in the schools at Lake Placid, four brothers, Arthur of Washington, D.C; Clifford, of Saranac Lake; Francis, of Hinchinbrook, Que.; and Earl, of Chateaugay. His funeral was held on Monday, September 21st in the Hinchinbrook Church at 9:30 a.m.

Graduated from Chateaugay High School and then went on to the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor where he obtained a degree in dentistry after which he returned to Chateaugay to practice his profession.

Somewhere along the line Mike developed a craving for liquor. His dad always blamed it on his going to college but others always wondered if it wasn't brought on by his marital troubles. Anyhow, Julia and Leo went to East Rochester to live and Mike moved his office to his brother John's house. Leo used to come home during summer vacation and spend his time at the Jordan homestead with his grandparents and his Uncle Tom Jordan.

Mike's equipment was set up in a room over the parlor. There being no electricity, the power to run his drill was furnished by a treadle which was connected to the drill by a system of five belts and he had to work it himself besides doing the drilling. Along with his diploma was one other poem on the wall which read:

I shall pass through this world but once;
Any good that I can do or any kindness that
I can show to any human being
Let me do it now,
For I shall not pass this way again.

Mike was not a man who could take a drink or two and then leave it alone. Once he started he would keep at it as long as his money lasted. Then he would sober up and go for months without touching it. He was a great lover of the outdoors and loved to hunt and fish. When he had no patients to work on he was always out helping his brother with some of his projects. He had a tremendous amount of energy and it was suspect that by working outside when he had no office work it was a means of taking his mind off some of his personal problems. Very often, on a Sunday morning he would take his gun and strike off down across the woods and fields to his brother Felix's. When they grew older, he would take his nephews Charlie and Ed with him. Occasionally he would shoot a gray squirrel. Those were great days for the nephews because it gave them a chance to play with their Canadian cousins across the border.

During summer vacation in 1914 Mike hired a seven passenger Chandler touring car from Dwyer & Jenkins who owned the Chateau Hotel at that time, to take his son and nephews to Upper Chateaugay Lake for a days outing. The car was driven by Louie Gold who, still lived in Chateaugay. Making the trip were Leo, Arthur, Clifford (two Canadian nephews), Charlie and Edmund. The road between Chateaugay and Brainardsville was being paved that summer so they had to detour on some back roads. A lot of fun was had trying to count the fence posts as they

drove along. They went to the Merrill House on the Upper Lake where they were treated to a wonderful dinner in the dining room and then a motor boat was hired and all went for a ride around the lake. It was the most exciting day that we had ever experienced.

After his sister-in-law, Mary McCollam McCormick, died in Sept 1914, Mike moved his dental office to rooms on the second floor of the First National Bank building in Chateaugay which he occupied until his death on January 1, 1916.

During the summer of 1915 Mike hired Henry Smith who had a Buick touring car to take Leo and the nephews to Montreal. It had gas headlights and two brass braces running down from the windshield to the frame to support it. There were no doors on the front seat. At that time there was only one bridge across the St. Lawrence River to Montreal and it was at the eastern end of the city, so it was necessary for them to ferry across at Caughnawaga and drive into the city on the north shore. Again, they were dined at a hotel and taken to Dominion Park. That same summer he took them to a circus in Malone. They rode out on the Rutland Railroad to Malone Junction where he hired a taxi and took them to the fairgrounds where the circus was playing. Those were great days for them and I am sure that Uncle Mike enjoyed himself as much as they did.

Dr. Michael J. McCormick died at the Alice Hyde hospital in Malone at about 2 o'clock Sunday morning aged 44 years.

The deceased was well known throughout the entire community and the news of his death was learned with expressions of the keenest sorrow by all. Born in the neighboring township of Hinchinbrook, Que., Dr. McCormick early became identified with the activities of this section, first becoming a resident of Chateaugay when he took up his school duties here. Following this he entered the dental department of the University of Michigan at Ann Arbor and after graduating from the institution he opened a dental office in this village, which he maintained for some time. He then removed to Malone and later to Brushton, where he likewise practiced his profession and then he returned to his former home in Hinchinbrook and there engaged in professional work until he once more took up his residence in this village about a year or more ago when he assumed charge of the dental office of the late Dr. McCann. As a practitioner he was known as a skillful and careful workman, and always enjoyed the fullest confidence of his patrons.

It was, however, as a citizen and scholar that he was best known. There were but few men who possessed the keen mind and active intelligence of the deceased, and in matters of public affairs his judgment was considered as authoritative. He possessed a retentive memory and as a conversationalist he was so well informed as to afford pleasure and interest to his hearers. His untimely death cannot be otherwise than a source of the keenest sorrow to relatives and friends.

He is survived by one son, John Leo McCormick, of East Rochester, two brothers, John of Chateaugay, and Felix of Hinchinnbrook, one half brother, William D., and two half sisters, Mary McCormick and Mrs. Margaret Ouimet of Hinchinbrook, besides a step mother, Mrs. John McCormick.

Funeral services were held on Tuesday morning at the Catholic church at Hinchinbrook and a large gathering of relatives and friends assembled to pay the last sad tribute to the memory of the deceased, among them being many from Chateaugay.

Excerpts from autobiography "Antrim to Chateaugay" - John Edmund McCormick:

In the late fall of 1933, the Works Progress Administration, better known as the "WPA", had consented to sponsor a project for building a new bridge across the Chateaugay river at the Pulp Mill. The old bridge was single lane only and the road on either side of the river was to steep and crooked. A gang of men who were out of work was recruited, but it was necessary to hire available teams to help in moving stones and dirt. We were lucky enough to get a team put on the job. . .

The week between Christmas and New Years 1933, was unusually cold and the thermometer went to 34 below zero. We were working our team four days a week on the bridge project. Once in awhile I would drive but on January 6th Charlie took the team to the bridge job. They were working on the east bank of the river getting ready to build forms for the bridge foundation. The men had loaded the wagon that Charlie was using and as he started up an incline, the horses slipped and the wagon started backing up toward the river. When Charlie realized that the team could not stop the wagon he jumped off, but somehow got his feet tangled in the lines, so when the horses and wagon went down over the bank, he was taken too. It was a drop of maybe forty feet to the river. The water is very deep there and very seldom freezes, but because of the extremely cold weather the week before, it had frozen over to a depth strong enough to hold the wagon and team. Charlie apparently landed on one of the horses and received a fractured skull. The horse that dad had loaned us was killed and the other horse had to be led down the river to a point where he could be brought up the bank. It was nearly a month before he was well enough to be taken out of the stable.

WOMAN HURT ESCAPING FROM BURNING HOME

Charles McCormick, who operates the F. W. Hill farm located three and one-half miles northwest of Chateaugay arose early last week Tuesday to begin his daily labors and before going to the barn he lighted a fire in the kitchen stove as was the usual custom. He was accompanied to the barn by Raymond Ryan, and in about a half hour's time their attention was attracted by a light from the building, and hurrying to the door they were startled to see the dwelling house afire.

In the meantime, Mrs. McCormick was awakened by the dense smoke and quickly grabbing her young daughter she made an effort to escape from the building through the front door entrance, but being defeated in this effort she retraced her steps and was obliged to pass through the kitchen, which was at that time a mass of flames.

Having only time to wrap a blanket about herself and child, it was necessary for her to run across the burning linoleum on the kitchen floor in her bare feet, which were very badly burned. In addition to this a portion of the ceiling fell, striking her on the shoulders and ignited the blanket, the flames reaching to her head, back and body, thus inflicting other serious burns. The little girl's hands were also burned and blistered in the ordeal, and both are now under the care of Dr. Sprague.

So rapidly did the fire spread that it was impossible to save any of the contents of the building with the result that Mr. McCormick's loss in household effects, clothing, etc., is heavy. Mr. Ryan is also unfortunate as it is said he had nearly \$300 in the pocket of a pair of trousers which were burned.

In close proximity to the house is a group of fine farm building located to the west of the burned structure, and an east wind blowing at the time sent embers flying to this group. Fortunately the village fire department arrived at the scene by this time and soon had streams of water playing on the barns and in this way saved them from destruction.
