

# Descendants of William Smithers

## Generation No. 1

1. William<sup>1</sup> Smithers was born Abt. 1805 in England, and died Abt. 1854 in Ontario, Canada. He married Charlotte Sivyver<sup>1</sup> Jan 29, 1828 in Stedham, Sussex, England, daughter of George Sivyver and Mary Simms. She was born Jul 1808 in Heyshott, Sussex, England, and died Jan 27, 1889 in Huron Co., Ontario, Canada<sup>2</sup>.

Notes for William Smithers:

I am now positive that this William and Charlotte (Sivyver) Smithers family is that of my GG Grandmother, Charlotte (Smithers) Taber-Barr. The 1925 Sioux City, Woodbury County, Iowa State Census listed her parents as William S. "Barr" (should be "Smithers") and Charlotte "Chivier" (close to "Sivier"). When comparing the 1851 Oxford Co., Ontario, Canada Census entry for the William Smithers family and the information that is known about my GG Grandmother, the Charlotte Smithers in the census entry has an age of 15, thus a birth year of about 1836, which is within one year of the known birth year for my GG Grandmother of 1837.

Also, when analyzing the birthplaces of the children, the last child born in England was born in about 1845 and the first child to be born in Canada was born in about 1847. So, this family immigrated from England to Canada between 1845 and 1847, which correpsonds to the information in my GG Grandmother's obituary, which states that she moved with her family from England to Canada at the age of 10 years old, which would have been in about 1847.

There are some geographical connections between my GG Grandmother and other members of this William Smithers family.

The first one is that of the area Sussex, England which is mentioned in Charlotte's obituary, and in the LDS Marriage information for this William and Charlotte (Sivyver) Smithers couple. I'm sure that this the same couple that moved to Ontario, for a cemetery index reference from Tuckersmith, Huron Co., Ont., actually lists this Charlotte's maiden name as Sivyver.

The next connection is the area surrounding Woodstock, Oxford Co., Ontario, including Seaforth in Huron Co., and Port Rowan in Norfolk Co., Ontario. Oxford Co. is between Huron and Norfolk Counties. Members of this Smithers family lived in Oxford and Huron Counties, and my GG Grandmother married John Taber in Port Rowan, Norfolk Co., Ontario, then their eldest children were born in Huron County.

The third geographical connection is that of Redwood Co., MN. The John and Charlotte (Smithers) Taber family moved to Redwood Co., MN in 1869. The Thomas Smithers, from this William and Charlotte (Sivyver) Smithers family, and although his age is too young by about five years, appears there in 1885 living with one of my GG Grandmother's daughters, his neice. Also in Redwood Co., MN was William James Smithers, son of Stephen Smithers who was also a son of William and Charlotte (Sivyver) Smithers.

The fourth geographical connection is that of Sioux City in Woodbury Co., Iowa. After leaving the John Taber family, my GG Grandmother moved to Sioux City with Thomas Barr between 1875 and 1879. In the 1895 Sioux City, Woodbury Co., Iowa State Census William James Smithers, Charlotte's nephew, is living with Charlotte and Thomas Barr.

The Thomas H. Smithers that married Martha Cuff and that appears in Sioux City, IA in 1895, Plymouth Co., IA in 1900, and then Sherburne Co., MN in 1910 and 1920 was not an exact match for belonging to this William Smithers family. The Thomas H. Smithers who married Martha Cuff has been listed as being born April 1, 1840 and his father's name was John Smithers, according to his death certificate. A coincidence still remains with Martha Cuff's sister Caroline marrying William James Smithers, son of Stephen Smithers.

My gut feeling that this Thomas Smithers is the brother to Charlotte (Smithers) Taber-Barr has now been confirmed by Elaine Smithers, who is in possession of the marriage record between Thomas H. Smithers and his first wife, Dinah Fowler, in Ontario, Canada, which lists Thomas' parents as William and Charlotte Smithers, not John Smithers as stated in Thomas' death certificate.

RESIDENT HERE 51 YEARS PASSES AWAY AT AGE OF 92

Funeral services for Mrs. Charlotte Barr, a resident here 51 years, who died Friday in the home of her daughter, Mrs. George Musselman, 4623 Tyler avenue, will be held at 2 o'clock this afternoon in the Musselman residence and at 2:30 o'clock in Wesley Methodist Episcopal church.

Rev. W. M. Baker will officiate and burial will be in Floyd Park cemetery under the direction of Anderson's funeral home.

Mrs. Barr's death was attributed to old age. She was 92 years old.

Born in England, July 14, 1837, Mrs. Barr lived there until she came to Montreal, Can., with her parents when she was 10 years old. From Montreal she moved to Seaforth, Minn., residing there until she became a Sioux City resident.

Of the 104 men in the company only 17 were living at the close of the war.

For more than a year he was a body guard for Gen. Scott. He returned to Canada and in 1869 came to his present farm. It being the first house built in the town of Vail. He married Oct. 1.1856 and had 8 children. Elizabeth A, Charlotte L, Emma S., Mary A, Carolina, Ellen S., William C, Minnie R. "

John Taber also served as a justice in the town of Vail.

He was married October 1, 1856, and has eight children: Elizabeth A., Charlotte L., Emma S., Mary A., Caroline, Ellen S., William C. and Minnie R."

Marriage Notes for Charlotte Smithers and John Taber:

The divorce record states that John and Charlotte were married on Oct 1, 1856 in Port Rowan, Canada and that they have been residents of Redwood County since March of 1869 and that on Aug 14, 1874 Charlotte told the family that she was leaving forever, not to return to live with their father and would not "live with him" ever again. The divorce was applied for by John Taber on Oct 11, 1880, stating that the defendant was absent for more than three years (actually over six years). The judgement for this divorce was dated May 2, 1881.

In the affidavit by John Taber he states that "It is a matter of public notimely (?) in this community that my wife and one Thomas Barr a married man were criminally intimate before the date of said desertion and that they lived and cohabit together for some months at Mankato Minnesota commencing soon after said desertion."

In the "Complaint for Divorce" document, dated Oct 11, 1880, the children of this union are listed as follows:

Elizabeth Ann 23, Charlott Louisa 21, Emma Sarah 19, Mary Ann 17, Caroline 15, Hellen Susan 13, William Charles 11, Minnie Rose 8.

In summary.....

John Taber and Charlotte Smithers were married on Oct 1, 1856 in Port Rowan, Canada, (John about 32 years old and Charlotte about 19) moved to Redwood Co., MN in March of 1869,

On Aug 14, 1874 Charlotte left the family and had been intimate with Thomas Barr prior to the desertion, and Thomas and Charlotte moved to Mankato, MN. (Charlotte age 37 and John Taber age 50, Thomas Barr age 49)

Nettie (Notta) Taber was born on Feb 14, 1875, father's name on birth record is John Taber for Charlotte and Thomas weren't married yet. (Charlotte age 38, Thomas Barr age 50)

Nettie would have been conceived in about June of 1874, if she was carried for the whole nine months, which is before the desertion by Charlotte.

Most likely Nettie is of Thomas Barr's blood, for this is probably why Charlotte felt that she had to leave. There is still a chance that Nettie is John Taber's daughter, however.

Charlotte and Thomas were married in Sioux City on Jan 08, 1879 (Charlotte age 42, Thomas age 54) and Hattie Barr was born on Jan 25th, 1879.

The divorce for John Taber and Charlotte wasn't finalized until May 1881.

My gut feeling that this Thomas Smithers is the brother to Charlotte (Smithers) Taber-Barr has now been confirmed by Elaine Smithers, who is in possession of the marriage record between Thomas H. Smithers and his first wife, Dinah Fowler, in Ontario, Canada, which lists Thomas' parents as William and Charlotte Smithers, not John Smithers as stated in Thomas' death certificate.

I'm sure, now, that the name "John Smithers" listed on Thomas Henry Smithers' death certificate is incorrect and the birth year of Thomas Henry Smithers isn't 1840, but 1846. References to this Thomas Henry Smithers' age and birth year vary from record to record, anywhere from 1839 to 1850.

There is no "North Hampton" in Sussex, England. The WFT source for his birth place is inaccurate.

There is, however, a "Hampshire" in Sussex, England and there's a birth record for a Thomas Smithers born in the second quarter (Apr-May-Jun) of 1846 in "Hampshire, Sussex".

THOMAS SMITHERS

Funeral services for Thomas Smithers were conducted in the Congregational church by Rev. E. F. Wheeler on Monday afternoon. Interment was in the Baldwin cemetery.

As was reported in the last issue of the Union, Thomas Smithers on last Thursday afternoon was killed instantly when thrown from a wagon on the Baldwin road near the Al Heath farm. The accident occurred at about 1:45 when Mr. Smithers accompanied by Harold Heath was on his way to get some fence posts. Both of them were driving a team of horses and just as the two teams were near the Al Heath farm the horses became frightened. It is not known what created the disturbance but in some manner Mr. Smithers was thrown from the wagon and killed instantly as he struck on his head. Harold Heath immediately rushed to his home and summoned his parents and Dr. H. C. Cooney. As the blow had been fatal nothing could be done. Mr. Smithers' family was then notified of the accident.

Thomas Smithers was born in Sussex, England, on April 1, 1840. When he was six years of age he came with his parents to Seaforth, Ont. In 1876 he was married to Miss Diana Fowler and two years later with her removed to a farm at Sheldon, North Dakota.

Mrs. Smithers died while the family was still residing at Sheldon, leaving two children, Gertrude and William. Shortly after the death of his wife Mr. Smithers removed to Redwood Falls, "Iowa" (should be Minnesota) where he resided for 15 years.

While in Redwood Falls Mr. Smithers was married to Miss Martha Cuff. In 1902 the family came to Onamia and remained there for a year. Later the family moved to a farm in Baldwin and have since resided there.

Mr. Smithers is survived by his wife, seven children by the second marriage, Mrs. Lee Lambert, Baldwin, Delbert and Carl, Klamath Falls, Ore., Mrs. Oliver Bergeron, Duluth; Elita, Charlotte, and Benjamin, Baldwin; and two children by the first marriage, Mrs. Wm. Burgess, of Russell, North Dakota, and Wm. Smithers of Thief River Falls.

All the children residing in Baldwin were present at the services on Monday including Miss Elita, who has been in Minneapolis for the past four years but had just returned to her home

for a brief vacation on the morning that her father was killed. Other members of the family present were Mr. and Mrs. Oliver Bergeron, Wm. Smithers and Mrs. Wm. Burgess.

Thomas Smithers was an industrious, progressive farmer, who had the respect of all the neighbors in the community in which he had resided for so many years. Although he was almost 85 years of age, he was still exceedingly active for a man of his years. His sudden death was a great shock to the members of the family and to the whole community.

Amos Smithers, retired farmer and banker, resides at Cambria, San Luis Obispo County, and has been a resident of California more than half a century.

Mr. Smithers was born on the parental home farm near Woodstock, Ontario, Canada, October 31, 1851, and is a son of William Smithers, who was born and reared in England, where he was a farmer in Sussex County until he came to America and established his home in Ontario, Canada, where he gave the rest of his life to farm enterprise.

Amos Smithers was a child of three years at the time of his father's death and was reared in his native county, where he attended school until he was twelve years of age. He there followed farm work until November, 1874, when, at the age of twenty-three years, he came to California, the following year having marked his settling in San Luis Obispo County, in May of that year. He found employment on a farm near Cambria, and after his marriage, in 1878, rented land and engaged in independent farm enterprise. He soon purchased the nucleus of his present valuable farm estate of 315 acres. He established a herd of Jersey cattle on his farm and soon gained high reputation for the products of his dairy. Success attended his well ordered efforts during the passing years and finally he became a stockholder and director of the Bank of Cambria. Of this substantial and well conducted financial institution he eventually became the president and so ordered its affairs as to make it a communal asset of exceptional influence and value. After turning his ranch business over to his sons Mr. Smithers established his home at Cambria, where he still resides. In July, 1930, he retired from the presidency of the Bank of Cambria, and his successor is James Stewart, whose parents, Mr. and Mrs. Neal Stewart, came to the Cambria community in 1868.

Mr. Smithers has been affiliated with the Independent Order of Odd Fellows since 1886 and is not only past grand of Hesperian Lodge, No. 181, at Cambria, but has also represented this lodge in the grand lodge of the state. In the early period of his residence at Cambria Mr. Smithers was engaged in the lumber business. He is still one of the largest stockholders of the Bank of Cambria and his son Lester is a director thereof. He has been loyal and liberal as a citizen and served many years as school trustee.

In 1878 Mr. Smithers was united in marriage to Miss Ida M. Terrill, who was born in Sonoma County, this state, whose parents settled at Cambria in 1851 and whose paternal grandparents were associated with Brigham Young in establishing the pioneer Mormon colony in Utah. Mr. and Mrs. Smithers became the parents of nine children: Warren, Ernest T., Mabel I., Shelby W., Lloyd, Lester, Mary Lottie and Charlotte. [p.460] Of the children only three are living, and the death of the loved wife and mother occurred September 5, 1914. Lester Eugene and Ernest Tyrell Smithers are associated in the management of their father's old home ranch, and the former is a director of the Bank of Cambria, as previously noted. Lester E. Smithers married Miss Gladys Kester and their four children are Irwin, Lester Amos, Arthur and Shirley. Shelby Wayne Smithers, the other surviving son, resides with his father in the pleasant home at Cambria. He met with an accident that destroyed the sight of his eyes, is twenty-six years of age and is a fine young man who has a host of friends. He attended the State School for the Blind, at Berkeley, and has become skilled in the Braille system for the blind, so that he is able to read well by touch.

The third house seen in the upper left background of the photograph was purchased by the Smithers family at the turn of the century. Amos Smithers arrived to Cambria from Canada in 1875 and married Ida Terrill, whose mother was a member of the Leffingwell family. Amos and Ida lived at the home that is now the Olallieberry Inn, located at 2476 Main Street. Their son, Ernest "Friday" Smithers, probably lived in the photographed house prior to serving in World War I. After returning from the war, "Friday" lived in an adjacent cabin (the house by now was abandoned) and helped his father, Amos, in the cultivation of their neighboring apple orchard and alfalfa field (shown behind the two foreground homes).

From 1938 to 1956, "Friday" served as Cambria's deputy constable with his longtime friend and boss, Constable E. C. "Boots" Blake. Constable Blake didn't possess a driver's license and was dependant on deputy Smithers to drive him to the scene of a crime. Many longtime Cambria residents fondly remember seeing "Friday" and "Boots" frequently sitting in Friday's jalopy, smoking White Owl cigars in front of the Bank of America on Main Street.

Bunting; two sisters, Mrs. Charles Pickett of Seaforth, and Mrs. John Heimer of Redwood Falls; a brother, William Taber of Seattle; Mrs. Charles Davis of Seaforth; two half sisters, residence unknown; four children, J. Earl Bunting of Maple Plain, Roy and Hubert Bunting of Delhi, and Mrs. Mildred Hubner of Syracuse, Ind.; eleven grandchildren; and other distant relatives.

Mrs. Bunting came to this country from Ontario with her parents when she was seven years old, and has lived ever since in Redwood county. She and Mr. Bunting were married in Redwood Falls July 27, 1892. Several years ago she joined the Presbyterian church where she has worked faithfully in all its activities.

Her death followed a period of poor health which had continued for several years, culminating in the illness which sent her to the hospital in vain hopes of recovery.

Joseph Franklin Bunting, of Delhi township, was born October 22, 1864, in Dane county, Wisconsin, son of Job and Mary (Noble) Bunting, natives of England, who came to America at an early age and met and married in Dane county, Wisconsin. Here the father purchased 100 acres of land and engaged in farming and here he and his wife resided until their death. Job Bunting was born in 1823 and died May 5, 1894; his wife, born in 1830, died May 13, 1910. They had the following children: Alice, now Mrs. D. W. Whittet of Redwood Falls; Selena, now Mrs. Henry Abbott of Rock county, Wisconsin; Isaac, of Dane county, Wisconsin; Sarah Ann, deceased; James, deceased; George, deceased; Joseph F.; Elizabeth, now Mrs. Arthur Vickers, of Dane county, Wisconsin; Amos, of Dane county; and Agnes, deceased.

After finishing school at Albion Academy, Albion, Wis., Joseph F. Bunting came to Redwood county and a few years later purchased 160 acres of land in section 21, Delhi township. Here he began to break ground and erected a five-room house which in 1910 was replaced by a fine ten-room house. He made many improvements and erected suitable buildings---a barn, 32 by 60 feet, an implement shed, granary and corn crib. He has a fine grove around his home and a small apple orchard. He has the following acreage of grain: wheat, 30 acres; corn, 40 acres; oats, 45 acres, and barley, 10 acres. He keeps a good grade of stock, having graded Durham cattle, and has from 12 to 14 milch cows, also raising Poland China swine and Percheron horses.

In politics, Mr. Bunting is a Republican and has been supervisor of: the Delhi township board for 16 years. He is a member of the Presbyterian church.

Mr. Bunting was married July 27, 1892; to Emma Taber, who was born February 25, 1861, in Ontario; Canada, daughter of John and Charlotte (Smithers) Taber.

Her father, born in England in 1823, came to Canada when 16 years of age and was engaged in the hotel business about one mile from Seaforth, Ontario, Canada, for several years. In 1872 he came to Redwood county and bought 160 acres in Vale township, where he engaged in farming. In 1901 he retired from active work and made his home with his son at Seaforth, Minn., for a number of years. Then he moved to Green county, Washington, where he died in February, 1906. He was a veteran of the Mexican war, coming from Canada to the United States to enlist, and was twice wounded, once being left on the battlefield supposed to be dead.

She married Gustav Dietzman, son of Johan Dietzmann and Rosa. He was born Nov 20, 1851 in Germany, and died Jun 14, 1929 in Sedalia, Pettis Co., MO.

Notes for Mary Ann Taber:

This connection between Mary Ann Taber and Gustav Dietzman has been made based on several items of circumstantial evidence. Although inconsistencies exist in the birth date of Mary Ann Taber ( she may have had to "fib" about her age at one time and just carried it on), I think that the Mary A. Taber, daughter of John and Charlotte (Smithers) Taber, is the same Mary A. Taber, wife of Gustav Dietzman.

The heaviest piece of evidence is that Mary Ann (Taber) Dietzman's father is listed as "John Taber", born in England, on her death certificate. (Mother: "not known".) If documentation is found with reference to Mary Ann's mother's first or maiden name is found, it would make this logical assumption exact.

The next piece of evidence is that Mary Ann Taber most likely knew Gustav Dietzman for they were neighbors according to the 1880 Redwood Co., Minnesota Census, where they are listed on the same page.

Although Mary Ann's death certificate and the 1900 - 1920 Censuses state that she was born in England, her obituary states that she was born in Canada, as does oral history.

The Taber family lore passes down that Mary Ann Taber was taken by Indians as a little girl and was never seen again. The Dietzman family lore passes down that Gustav drove off with a wagon and was never seen again. The book "Redwood - The Story of a County", on page 142, states that Gust Dietzman was the victim of a blizzard in the winter of 1880-81: "...and at

least one man died here in that blizzard, Gust Dietzman of Vail township started home from Redwood Falls in the storm and neither he, his horses, nor sleigh were ever seen again."

The story of Mary Ann and the Indians has been disproved, for she appears in the 1870, 1875, and 1880 Censuses with the John Taber family, ages 6, 11, and 16 respectively, and she is listed in the divorce record for John Taber and Charlotte Smithers in 1880-81.

The story of Gustav Dietzman is most likely untrue, for the Gustav Dietzman from Redwood Co., MN in 1880 is identical to the one from Pettis Co., MO in the 1900 Census. The Dietzman descendants have Gustav's Naturalization papers from 1878 in Redwood Co., MN.

These two stories were most likely acceptable explanations, by the Taber and Dietzman families, for Mary Ann (age 17) and Gustav's (age 28) leaving together. Mary Ann was probably pregnant by Gustav, who was a married man, for their son William is listed as being born in June of 1881, which means he was probably conceived in about September of 1880.
