Robert Barr (Concession #7; Lot 32) had 100 acres, 25 cultivated (22 in Crops, 2 in pasture and 1 acre of orchard) and 75 woods or wild; he grew wheat, peas, hay, oats, and potatoes. Robert had 2 milk cows, 2 calves/heifers, 3 horses, 10 sheep, and 2 pigs, and he produced 200 lbs. of butter and 270 barrels/cwts of pork, and 200 lbs. of wool, a year.

Thomas Barr (Concession #7; Lot 33) had 100 acres, 20 cultivated (18 in Crops, 2 in pasture and no orchard) and 80 acres of woods or wild; he grew wheat, peas, hay, oats, B. Wheat, and potatoes. Thomas had 1 Bull/Oxen/Steer, 2 milk cows, 1 calf/heifer, no horses, pigs, nor sheep, and he produced 200 lbs. of butter and 370 barrels/cwts of beef, and 324 barrels/cwts of pork a year.

DIED

BARR - In Sioux City, Nov 11, 1879, at the residence of her son, Thomas Barr, Mrs. Mary Barr, in the 91st year of her age.

Funeral from the First Methodist Church this afternoon at half-past 2 o'clock. Services by Rev. J. H. Lozier. Friends of the family and members of the congregation are invited to attend without further notice.

The deceased was born in Flamborough, Yorkshire, England, in 1789. She came to this city from Chicago only a month ago, making the trip alone. Since arriving in this city she had been in failing health and for some days it has been plain to her friends that she had only come here to die.

Floyd Cemetery Sioux City, IA Alphabetical Listings lists "Mother of Thomas Barr". The Official Cemetery Records state that she was 88 years old at the time she was buried in "9/ /1880" Block 508-lot 1. The grave was purchased by a Thomas Barr on 9/4/1880. But Thomas and Charlotte Barr are buried in Block 199. This purchase and burial date does not match up with her death date of Nov 11, 1879 which is confirmed by Thomas Barr's handwritten notes as well as the Sioux City Journal obituary dated Nov 12, 1879.

Block 508 just so happens to be the same block number as Carl J. and Anna (Erickson) Fredrickson. No relation, just coincidence.

POLICEMAN ENDS HIS LIFE

George Kenyon Thought by Comrades to Have Been Unbalanced

Brooding over charges made against him and fearing that he was again to be called before the police trial board, Policeman George Kenyon of the Irving Park station took his life by drinking poison in a rooming house at 7 North Clark street early today. Kenyon had been on the police force at intervals since 1880.

Saturday evening he went to the rooming house, engaged a room and went immediately to it, closing and locking the door. All night Saturday, all day Sunday and Sunday night he is thought to have been in the room. It is not believed that he took his life, however, until early today, as roomers in the place say that he was heard walking about in the room last night.

End Their Own Lives -- The following suicides were reported to the police yesterday:

KENYON, GEORGE, a policeman of the Irving Park station, drank poison at 7 North Clark street. He is supposed to have been mentally unbalanced as the result of a fall. He had often been disciplined by the trial board and brooded a great deal over his troubles. He was unmarried and lived at 211 North avenue.

Unidentified colored man, about 28 years old, drank carbonic acid in a hotel at 487 Sate street.
