Came with son, Andreas to the US via New York from Herzog, Russia on the SS Mosel in 1876.

The Germans etc left Europe because of the never ending wars in Germany, France etc. Catherine the Great from Russia (a German by birth) invited them to live in the wild plains of Russia and she would set up house for them. Many people accepted the invitation, but later found out it wasn't all they thought it would be. They were, for the most part, required to farm even though they weren't farmers to begin with. They had crude homes, but made the best of it. These people flourished and prospered in Russia. More so than the Russians themselves. Many of the natives were jealous and this carried into the rulers after Catherine died. The German-Russians began being persecuted for their religious beliefs and eventually were required to serve in the Russian military. This made the people look again for a new home. Most went to America-both North and South (Canada, Kansas, Argentina etc). And those that came to Ellis County, Kansas did so immediately after getting off the train in Hays. Here in the states, they were predominantly farmers.

Robert E. Lee Eggenberger Sr. was named after his cousin General Robert E. Lee, the General of the C.S.A. His ggtgt grandfather was Revolutionary War Soldier William Fuson Sr. of Henry Co., Va. Robert E. Lee Eggenberger Sr. also had many family members who were in the Civil War. "Lee" Eggenberger as he was well known in all his life time had what some would call a photographic memory and he graduated from the Olathe High School in Olathe, Colo. as Valedictorian. He was also a very good singer. He spent much of his early childhood on the family homestead and farm known as the Kriben place. This property was located northeast of the present day Air Force Academy and only a few miles from his one room school house where he finished elementary school and it is very near to the Pioneer Spring Valley Cemetery where he is laid to rest among the cemetery pines and the late evening shadows cast over it from the Front Range Mountains, the Air

Force Academy and Pikes Peak. (The school is still there and protected.)

It appears from records and recollection that soon after his brother Roy was killed from a horse kick to the head and perhaps other circumstances unknown, Lee's father John Henry Eggenberger left the farm and family to seek work or opportunities in Colorado Springs. His father was a meat cutter by trade.

In 1940, Lee met and married Christine Marie Riedel, as his second marriage. To this union were born three children who are still living. His first marriage, much of which is still unknown, produced a son, Edward who died soon after his birth, and this first marriage failed.

After his marriage to Christine Marie Riedel he tried to enlist in the Navy at the beginning of WWII. After failing the physical he was asked to go to Las Alamos, New Mexico to work on the Manhattan Project (Atomic Bomb) as a carpenter. He and his family remained there until about 1948-49 and then returned to Colorado, later they bought a home on the west side of Colorado Springs, Colo.

Lee continued working as a carpenter most of his life, and for the most part as a foreman or superintendent. He was a superintendent for Hansel Phelps Construction Co, who built the complexes for the Air Force Academy, and was asked to personally supervise and do the finish wood work in the Academy Chapel, which he completed admirably.

Ironically, as some things go round-circle, the construction and building of the Air Force Academy was on his grandparent's and great grandparent's or other family homesteads, who had come to this area so many years before by wagon. (Please see note of interest below.) In addition to Lee working on the Air Force Academy as a supervisor he also helped supervise the construction for the NORAD Command Center at Cheyenne Mountain Colorado, until he retired in 1976.

In the late fifties and early sixties he, with help of family and friends built their new home in Sherwood Forest Estates at Divide, Colorado. He became the president of the board for the community and lived at this home until his death. His hobbies were hunting, fishing and the great outdoors. He had a deep love for his family and friends and always gave more than he took. His enjoyments were family outings, a good T-bone steak, a cup of coffee, a cigarette and a good fishing hole or stream to fly fish. Lee was very intelligent, and was one of the best builders and true craftsman of his profession.
