

# *Descendants of Ebenezer Ormsby*

## *Generation No. 1*

1. **Ebenezer<sup>1</sup> Ormsby<sup>1</sup>** was born August 22, 1760 in Warren, Bristol, Rhode Island<sup>2</sup>, and died April 18, 1832 in Mexico, Oswego, New York<sup>3</sup>. He married **Experience Clark** November 29, 1787 in Richmond, Cheshire County, New Hampshire<sup>3</sup>. She was born 1766, and died May 14, 1855 in Mexico, Oswego, New York<sup>4</sup>.

Ebenezer enlisted on March 1, 1776, and served as a private in Captain Francis Simmons' company, Colonel Hitchcock's Rhode Island regiment. He was discharged the last of December 1776. In January 1777, he enlisted as a private in Captain Hait's company, Colonel Philip B. Bradley's\* Connecticut regiment. In 1779, at the battle of Fort Montgomery, he was wounded in the thigh and was discharged in June 1779 after having served two and a half years.

On 16 April 1818, he applied for and was granted a pension for his military service during the Revolution. He was a resident of Mexico, Oswego County, New York at the time of his application. He had previously lived in Whites town, Oneida County, New York. In 1820, he was sixty years of age. He signed his surname as Ormsbee but stated that his surname was frequently spelled Armsbury. He died in Mexico, New York, April 18, 1832.

He married Experience Clark on November 29, 1788, in Richmond, Cheshire County, New Hampshire. They were both residents of Richmond and their marriage was recorded in the Richmond Town Clerk's Office. Experience was a member of the Baptist Church.

\*Philip Burr Bradley (Connecticut). Colonel Connecticut State Regiment, May to December, 1776; Colonel 5th Connecticut, 1st January, 1777; retired 1st January, 1781. (Died 4th January 1821.)

(Research): Richmond, Cheshire County, New Hampshire: In the spring of 1776, there were three men named Ormsbee living in Richmond. They were Ebenezer ORNSBE, Ezra ORMSBEE, and Oliver ORMSBE.

Betsey Ormsbee Bumpass' record shows that she was born in Herkimer County. Ebenezer's pension files show Oneida County as his home prior to Oswego County. Herkimer County was formed in 1791 from Montgomery County. Oneida County was formed in 1798 out of Herkimer County. Oswego County was formed in 1816 out of Oneida and Onondaga counties. It is entirely possible for Ebenezer and family to have been in the area of Mexico during all this time while the county names were changed around them.

On 15 Mar 1770, in Richmond, NH, Oliver Ormsby married Alice Cass, daughter of Deacon John Cass. They had eight children, whose names are now illegible on the records. Part of his children were born in Charlemont, and in Buckland, Mass. He died 1790. The family probably returned to one of those places.

Ruth Ormsby was probably the daughter of Oliver Ormsby, who married Alice Cass. She was never married. Lived at various places, at Moses Tyler's, at Peregrine Wheeler's, and other places. She was a comical genius, occasionally witty, but on the whole was considered below mediocrity. She died about 1830. p. 553

On 17 Aug 1789, in Richmond, Joseph Ormsby married Deborah Stone. He may have been the son of Oliver.

The following statement was found on p. 454 in the History of Richmond NH: "Ebenezer [Ormsby] was probably the first settler on L. 15, R. 1, the place where Reuben and Laban Phillips lived."

[The following is a verbatim copy of the Bounty Land grant awarded to Experience Ormsbee in the name of Ebenezer for his service in the Revolutionary War. Waiting until nearly all the veterans are dead before rewarding them for their service is apparently nothing new. Congress approved the Bounty Land grants for the veterans of the Revolutionary War on March 3, 1855. Ebenezer had died 23 years earlier at the age of 71, and Experience died two months after the enactment at the age of 89. The land was not officially awarded to Experience until February 6, 1868, by which time she had been dead for 13 years. In addition, the War of 1812 and the Civil War had also been fought. Her land went to a John G. Williams. I do not know what, if any relationship, he had to Experience and Ebenezer.]

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, in pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 7076 for 160 acres, in favor of Experience Ormsbee, widow of Ebenezer Ormsbee, Private, Revolutionary War, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South West quarter of section Twelve, in Township nineteen, north of Range eight, west, in the District of lands subject to sale at Ionia, Michigan, containing one Hundred and Sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor the said warrant having been assigned to Betsey Bumpus, Administratrix of the Estate of the said Experience Ormsbee deceased to John G. Williams, in whose favor said grant has been located.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said John G. Williams, as assignee, as aforesaid and to his heirs the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said John G. Williams, as assignee, as aforesaid and to heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Andrew Johnson PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, at the CITY OF WASHINGTON, the Sixth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty eight and of the INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES the Ninety second

During the War of 1812, Benjamin served in Capt. Malcomb's Company, 13th U.S. Infantry. He enlisted at Salina, Onondaga County, New York on 20 Oct 1813, and was discharged at Utica, Oneida County, New York on 30 Apr 1814. At Sacket's Harbor along the Canadian Border in the Battle of Queenston, he was wounded in the right arm. In a skirmish at Stony Creek in the capture of Little York, he was wounded in the back by a stone thrown by an explosion. Pension Certificate No. 7755 for invalid pension dated 2 Mar 1853. [Pension file]

On 9 Jan 1851, Benjamin F. Ormsbee of the Town of Avon, Livingston County, New York aged 61 years applied for Bounty Land for service in the War of 1812. He enlisted 21 May 1812 at Salina, Onondaga County, New York under Capt. Richard M. Maloom, Col. Schuyler, in the 13th Regiment of Infantry. Discharged account disability 21 Feb 1814. Received B.L.W. # 21021. [Pierce]

For this Warrant, he was granted 160 acres of land, being the S.E. 1/4 of Section 13 - Twp. 12 N - Range 7 E in the District of Land subject to sale at Genesee, Mich. Signed by President Franklin Pierce July 1st 1854.

This establishes the approximate time this family moved to Michigan. [p. 19]
