

# *Descendants of James Brogan*

## *Generation No. 1*

**1. James<sup>1</sup> Brogan<sup>1</sup>** was born Abt. 1820 in Ireland<sup>2</sup>, and died August 25, 1866 in St. Louis, Missouri<sup>3</sup>. He married **Catherine Sloughy<sup>4</sup>**. She was born June 1839 in Ireland<sup>5</sup>, and died July 28, 1902 in An institution of senility<sup>6</sup>.

Notes for James Brogan:

Mary Vanicelli has a note saying James entered the US by way of Boston on a ship named the Joseph James Clark on August 31, 1839. She is unsure of her source.

Evelyn Brogan has info that leads her to believe James may have come from County Mayo, Parish of Attymass, Ireland.

In the 1870 Census there was a James Brogan in MO (not St. Louis) b about 1830 and was a cooper - could he be the same?

There is a Michael Brogan who could possibly be related to James - brother - they are 10 yrs apart, b. in Ire and lived in St. Lo. At one point, he lived one street away from James' s wife, Catherine. He died 24 Nov 1881 and is buried in Calvary - check family plot for more info.

He married **Louisa Hellenschmidt** April 13, 1877 in Old Cathedral, St. Louis, Mo Easter Sunday, daughter of Hellenschmidt and Unknown. She was born November 10, 1858 in Renault or St. Joe, Monroe County, Illinois<sup>13</sup>, and died October 1936 in St. Louis, Missouri.

Notes for Louisa Hellenschmidt:

According to her granddaughter, Celeste Rose (Walsh) Mulcrone, Lucy lived in North St. Louis. She spoke German fluently.

Celeste remembers visiting her grandmother's relatives and cousins in Renault, IL. Celeste's family visited their Grandma Brogan frequently since she was the only grandparent alive. They'd walk to her house, but Celeste recalls it was a long walk. Sometime, they'd take the street car.

Celeste notes that Louisa's friends "changed" her name to Lucy Smith.
