On his marriage certificate his occupation is labourer. He could not write.

On his Death Certificate he was a Lodginghouse Keeper at Goat Lane South Queensferry, he died of heart failure, his son Owen Garvie ( Dalmeny Rows.) signed the death cert.

She stayed in Goat Lane at her death, Owen Garvie (son), signed the death cert.

for both Thomas and Elisabeth. In 1871 they stayed "Back of W Goat Lane", probably changed to Harbour Head, where Owen Garvie and Sarah Connely started their family. (seems to be a tradition eg . Uncle Peter and Grandad Ravie's house at 5 Inchgarvie Park).

On the birth certificate of Cathrine, Thomas made his mark . On Owen's death certificate Cathrine Prior is given as the mothers name.

When Owen and Sarah were married Thomas worked on the Forth Rail Bridge.

In 1891 census another Owen Garvie (born in Queensferry has shown up ) He is my ggrandfather . Bernard's family has moved to East Terrace by this time ( probably Patrick's house , Patrick has moved to Goat lane.) It looks like Bernard Thomas and Patrick are brothers ,

In the IGI Bernard and Mary were married on the 9th May 1865 in Linlithgow, this is different to the marriage certificate. (19-10-96)

According to latter data Bernard and Mary's family are in South Queensferry , the family is started in 1867 with the birth of Mary Garvie.

Another Mary Garvie is born to this family in 1888. On Mary Reilly Garvie's birth certificate, Bernard is working as a Bridge Labourer, I assume the building of the Forth Rail Bridge, and at this time they are staying in Brewery Close Queensferry.

From the Scotsman 10th Nov 1890:

Tragic Affair at South Queensferry.

A fatal stabbing affair occurred at South Queensferry early yesterday morning, the victim being Thos. Devlin, 18 years of age, the son of a fish-hawker in South Queensferry, and his assailant a fellowworkman Chas. James Thomas, a steamboat fireman, recently employed as a labourer at the taking down of the Forth Bridge workshops and residing at Newhailes. The scene of the tragedy was ' the house of Charles Kerr, who lived at Rosshill Cottages, and was foreman of a squad of men who are employed in taking down what is known as shed No 1.

It appears that on Saturday night Kerr and his wife were down town, where they met the deceased, Thomas Devlin, and another young man, Patrick McMahon, both of whom were employed under Kerr. They accompanied Kerr and his wife to their house at Rosshill, and, it is stated, had some drinks. Later on; they were joined by Thomas and a man called Lafferty, both of whom were also employed by Kerr. They too had some drink with the rest, and the merrymaking was prolonged till after midnight. By that time, all the men, with the exception of Macmahon, who is said to be a sober lad, were stated to be the worse of drink. Some chaff would have appeared to have been indulged in, and from chaff they went to rough play, which culminated in Devlin and Thomas getting out on the middle of the floor and engaging in a sparring match. It is alleged that they were not on the best of terms, that there had been some sort of rivalry between them over their work in taking down the sheds, where the payment was by piece, and some were better paid than others. Be that as it may, it would appear that in their sparring match a good deal of heat was evolved, and consequent ill-temper, for in the midst of it, the rest of the company were horror-struck to see Thomas suddenly, and apparently without premeditation, seize a large ham knife which was on the kitchen table and make a thrust with it at Devlin's head. The sharp point of the knife entered the neck about two inches behind the left ear. Devlin dropped to the floor, and according to testimony of the witnesses he never spoke nor moved. They turned him over, but there was no sign of life.

Macmahon suggested that they should call the police, and subsequently he went out for this purpose, taking Lafferty along with him. It was by this time one in the morning. They found Constables 'Fullarton and D McDonald at Newhailes, and told them that they had better come up to Rosshill and apprehend a man who had killed another. The police were somewhat sceptical about the story, especially as Lafferty did not seem to be sober, but when one of the men went on to say a knife had been used they suspected that something was wrong, and accompanied them to Kerr's house. On entering, they found Devlin lying on the floor where he had fallen, and a slight inspection showed that he was dead. Thomas was leaning against the table in an apparently dazed condition, as he had been since the fatal blow was struck.

Constable Fullarton took him prisoner saying " I must take you into custody for stabbing that man". The prisoner, rousing himself, is said to have replied excitedly. "I did it; shoot me." On the way to the police station he talked incoherently, explaining it was a fight, Dr Semple, of South Queensferry, was summoned, and along with Inspector MacKay made an examination of the body of the deceased, after which it was removed to the mortuary at the Police Station. Apparently the knife-thrust had severed the spinal cord, as very little blood had flowed from the wound.

Yesterday the Procurator-Fiscal (Mr Henderson) and Superintendent Robinson were summoned from Linlithgow, and depositions were taken from the witnesses of the affair. In the course of the day Dr Littlejohn was summoned from Edinburgh, and he made a post-mortem examination of the body. The prisoner in the afternoon was removed to Linlithgow, where to-day he will be brought before the Sheriff. The tragedy has caused a sensation in South Queensferry, and it is noteworthy that although during the construction of the Forth Bridge thousands of men were employed at the works, nothing too serious ever took place among them.

On 1 July 1916, supported by a French attack to the south, thirteen divisions of Commonwealth forces launched an offensive on a line from north of Gommecourt to Maricourt. Despite a preliminary bombardment lasting seven days, the German defences were barely touched and the attack met unexpectedly fierce resistance. Losses were catastrophic and with only minimal advances on the southern flank, the initial attack was a failure. In the following weeks, huge resources of manpower and equipment were deployed in an attempt to exploit the modest successes of the first day. However, the German Army resisted tenaciously and repeated attacks and counter attacks meant a major battle for every village, copse and farmhouse gained. At the end of September, Thiepval was finally captured. The village had been an original objective of 1 July. Attacks north and east continued throughout October and into November in increasingly difficult weather conditions. The Battle of the Somme finally ended on 18 November with the onset of winter. In the spring of 1917, the German forces fell back to their newly prepared defences, the Hindenburg Line, and there were no further significant engagements in the Somme sector until the Germans mounted their major offensive in March 1918. The Thiepval Memorial, the Memorial to the Missing of the Somme, bears the names of more than 72,000 officers and men of the United Kingdom and South African forces who died in the Somme sector before 20 March 1918 and have no known grave. Over 90% of those commemorated died between July and November 1916. The memorial also serves as an Anglo-French Battle Memorial in recognition of the joint nature of the 1916 offensive and a small cemetery containing equal numbers of Commonwealth and French graves lies at the foot of the memorial. The memorial, designed by Sir Edwin Lutyens, was built between 1928 and 1932 and unveiled by the Prince of Wales, in the presence of the President of France, on 31 July 1932. The dead of other Commonwealth countries who died on the Somme and have no known graves are commemorated on national memorials elsewhere.

The British cargo ship Nairung, operated by the Asiatic Steam Navigation Company, left Durban on 13 Aug 1944 on a voyage to Bombay via Dar-es-Salaam. She was carrying government stores and a general cargo, along with a crew of 83 and eight gunners. She was one of three ships torpedoed and sunk by Korvettenkapitan Heinrich Timm of the German U-Boat U 862 off the north western coast of Madagascar that week. She lost all on board, and her date of sinking is variously reported as 18th or 19th August 1944.

S.S.Nairung was an ammunition ship sailing from Durban to Bombay and was sunk in the Mocambique Channel in August 1944 by the u Boat U862. Being an ammunition ship she exploded and was lost with all hands. My childhood friend Douglas Hursell was a DEMS Gunner aboard her, There is an account of the sinking by the commander of the U Boat in a book entitled:- U-Boat far from Home by an Australian David Stevens. The publisher of the book is Allen and Ushwin.
