1920 Lake Preston, Kingsbury County, South Dakota census (January 21) lists Frances (6) and Roy (4) living with their grandparents Bert and Ella Severson and 4 of their daughters. Frances & Roy's mother had died in March of 1919.

1930 Hartland Township, Kingsbury County, South Dakota census (April 22) lists Frances (17) and Roy (14) back living with their father Otis Severson.

Frances Severson's obituary read:

"Frances Leora Paulson, 83, formerly of the Lake Norden area, died Thursday, April 11, 1996, at the McKennan Hospital Hospice (Sioux Falls, SD just 10 days after her birthday).

Frances Severson was born April 1, 1913, in Badger (South Dakota). After her mother's death, she lived with her grandparents in the Erwin area until age 9, and then lived with her father in Erwin. She attended school there and worked in a grocery store and a cafe. She later moved to Badger and worked in the cafe.

She married Art Paulson of Badger on Aug. 22, 1936, in South Bend, Indiana. They farmed (8 miles) north of Arlington until 1957, when they moved to Lake Poinsett (South Dakota). Her husband died in 1972, and she moved to Lake Norden in 1993. She moved to Sioux Falls in February 1996 because of health problems.

Survivors include one son, Loel of Brandon (her only child and his wife Joan); four grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.

Visitation is 5 to 9 p.m. Sunday and before services Monday at Johnson-Henry Funeral Home in Arlington (South Dakota)."

"Services were held Monday, April 15, 1996 at the United Cemetery in Arlington, South Dakota. Clergy was John Jacoway. Mrs. Taylor farmed with her first husband, Luke Uzell, near Badger from 1924 until 1948. He died in 1948. She worked in sales for J.C. Penney, Inc. in Brookings from 1949 until 1969. On November 26, 1969, she married Charles A. Taylor Jr. in Brookings.

Bernice Paulson spent her early years and received her education at Badger, South Dakota. She later graduated from Arlington High School in Arlington, SD, in 1928. Bernice received her two-year teaching degree from General Beadle College in Madison, SD. She taught rural schools in Brookings and Kingsbury Counties from 1931 to 1936.

Bernice was united in marriage to Roy Cox on December 24, 1937, in Prescott, Arizona. After their marriage they lived near Flagstaff, AZ, where she was employed as a bookkeeper at Sears. They moved to South Dakota in 1945 and farmed near Doland until moving to a farm in Florence Township near Castlewood, SD, in 1951. They retired from farming in 1979.

Roy passed away on October 27, 1984, and Bernice continued to live on the farm. In the fall of 1997, she moved to the Jenkins Methodist Home in Watertown, SD.

Bernice Cox died on Sunday, January 25, 1998, at the Prairie Lakes Hospital in Watertown. She was 87 years, 2 months, and 14 days old.

Bernice was a member of the Morningside Community Church in Brookings, SD, and enjoyed playing bridge and going to the Senior Center to visit friends. She had a great appreciation for family and enjoyed communicating her vast knowledge and memory of family history with her relatives. At age 25, Pauline (Tygesen) Paulsen left Hamburg, Germany on April 14, 1875. She traveled on the "S. S. Holsahia" along with her daughter Helen (age 11 months) and her husband's brother Paul Paulsen (age 26). The ship was captained by A. Barends and reached its destination of New York City on April 28, 1875.

This is an age in which the farmer stands pre-eminently above any other class as a producer of wealth. He simply takes advantage of the winds, the warm air, the bright sunshine and the refreshing rains, and applying his own hands and skill to nature's gifts he creates grain, hay, livestock, etc., all of which are absolute necessities to the inhabitants of the world, for no matter what our vocations and avocations may be or where we may choose to maintain our home, we cannot lose sight of the fact that we are depending upon the tiller of the soil and without him the entire human race would perish. It has been well said by one of our wisest men, "Burn down your cities and leave our farms and they will spring up again as if by magic, but destroy the farms and the grass will grow in the streets of every city."

One of this large class of the world's benefactors is Clifton Delano Newell, of Kellogg Township, Jasper County, who was born December 31, 1878, in Newton Township. He is the son of George W. and Amanda (Brown) Newell, the father born in Knox County, Ohio, and the mother's birth also occurred in that County on August 11, 1848. They grew to maturity there, were educated and married in their home community and began life on the farm, in fact, have continued to engage in agricultural pursuits until the present time. They came to Jasper County, Iowa, in 1878, locating in Newton Township, living a year on a rented farm a mile northwest of the town of Newton, and they continued to live in that vicinity until 1892, when they moved to a farm three miles southeast of Newton, and there became very comfortably established.

To Mr. and Mrs. George W. Newell six children have been born, namely: Nora E., Clifton Delano, of this review, Bessie H., Baxter E., Clayton Elmer and George Martin. The immediate subject of this sketch grew to manhood in Jasper County and attended the public schools, attending high school at Newton for three years. After leaving the schoolroom he took up farming with his father, on the shares, thus working until 1909, when, having gotten a good start, he purchased the one-hundred-and- forty - acre farm on which he now lives, eighty acres of which is located in section 32, Kellogg Township, and sixty-eight acres in section 5, Buena Vista Township. Until recently he owned three hundred and twenty acres in South Dakota, which he has now disposed of. His home place has been well improved and is very skillfully managed, and he carries on general farming and stock raising in a successful manner, making a specialty of breeding an excellent grade of stock.

Mr. Newell was married on January 3, 1909, to Christine Paulson, who was born in Kellogg Township, this County, September 3, 1878, the daughter of Hans M. and Pauline (Tygersyn) Paulson, both born in Denmark. They were the parents of ten children, seven of whom are living, namely: Helena Marie, Nelse R., Christine, wife of Mr. Newell of this review; Lena, Andrew, Catherine is deceased; Charley Martin, Henry is deceased, and one child died in infancy.

Politically, Mr. Newell is independent, and he belongs to the Methodist Church.
