Be it remembered that heretofore, to wit: On the 15th day of June A.D., 1901, There was filed in the Probate Court within and for the County of Stark and State of Ohio, an Instrument of writing, purporting to be the last Will and Testament of Jennie Johnson deceased, which is in the words and figures following to wit:

In the name of the benevolent father of all:

I, Jennie Johnson of Marlboro Tp., Stark Co., Ohio do make and publish this my last will and testament:

Item 1st: I give and devise to my daughter Manda Vourron one hundred dollars, one bed, my room carpet and three pictures and frames vis. her father's, her mother's and her grandmother Cartier's.

Item 2nd: to Elsie, daughter of Manda Vourron, I give and devise fifty dollars.

Item 3rd: I give and devise to my daughter Ella Landon one dollar.

Item 4th: I give and devise to my three sons vis. Loyde Johnson, Harvey Johnson and Flory Johnson, all the remainder of my property both real and personal, each son to receive an equal share.

Item 5th: I do hereby nominate and appoint Charles J. Gulling Executor of this my last will and testament.

#### DEATH OF PAUL REBILLOT

Another old and respected resident has passed away. Paul Rebillot, after gradually declining in health for some years, closed his eyes peacefully in death Monday afternoon. The cause of his death is attributed to dropsy, but he suffered from a complication of troubles for some time. Last week he seemed somewhat better than usual and the members of his family and friends took hope. Then he became rapidly worse until the dissolution came.

Paul Rebillot was born in Mathay, in the Department of Doubs, France, May 18, 1829. He came to America with his parents in 18-3 and they settled on the farm now owned by Stephen Pickens, on the Paris Road. January 15, 1856, Mr. Rebillot and Miss Josephine Gaume were married. The ceremony was performed by Rev. Father Dorsey, who was then pastor of St. Louis Catholic Church. They lived happily together and became the parents of twelve children. Three died in infancy and a daughter, Miss Anna Rebillot, died November 20, 1887 at the age of twenty-one. The children who are living are: Messrs. Frank, Louis, Eugene and Miss Tillie Rebillot and Mrs. Paul Grisez of Louisville; Joseph Rebillot and Mrs. John Bonnot of Canton and Mrs. Edward Grisez of Alliance Twp. Children of a brother, Albert Rebillot and Miss Mary Rebillot, who were left orphans at an early age, were taken into the family and Mr. and Mrs. Rebillot accorded them the same treatment as their own children. In addition to these, there are 24 grandchildren living. One sister, Mrs. Alzire Vourron, of Canton, also survives.

Mr. Rebillot led an active life, and he was very successful in business affairs. He engaged very extensively in farming and for many years was in the live stock business. Nearly twenty-five years ago he established a meat market in Louisville which he continued to own until the time of his death. He also owned two fine farms south of Louisville and had an interest in the Stoneware Tile Co.'s works at Louisville.

From the time of his coming to America, Mr. Rebillot was a member of St. Louis Catholic Church. He always contributed liberally toward the support of the congregation and when his health permitted was a regular attendance at the services of the church.

In his death the community has lost an upright citizen and the family a kind and indulgent husband and father.

The funeral services were held at St. Louis Catholic Church Thursday morning. Requiem high mass was read. Rev. Senué, paster of the congregation, Revs. Trieber and Schoeneman of Canton and Rev. Gardner of Maximo officiated at the services. The body was entombed in the family plot in the Catholic cemetery.

Mrs. Josephine Gaume Rebillot fell asleep in death, on Saturday, at midnight at her home, a short distance south of Louisville. She had been sick less than a week and her death was caused by pneumonia. Mrs. Rebillot was the daughter of Frank and Eliza Gaume and was born on the farm now owned by Leonard Keubel; located south of Louisville, February 24, 1836, making her age nearly 67 years. On January 15th, 1856, she was united in marriage to Paul Rebillot, who died December 15, 1902. The death of her companion for so many years weighed heavily upon her and no doubt hastened the end. Nine children are living. They are Messrs. Frank, Louis, Eugene and Miss Tillie Rebillot, and Mrs. Paul Grisez, of Louisville; Joseph Rebillot and Mrs. John Bonnot of Canton, and Mrs. Edward Grisez of Alliance. Miss Mary Rebillot, who was adopted into the family some years ago, is also living. In addition to these there are twenty-four grandchildren. Two brothers, Frank Gaume, of St. Marys, Kansas, and Louis Gaume of Sacramento, California, and four sisters, Mrs. Stephen Saunier, of St. Marys, Kansas; Mrs. Constance Sonier, of Pueblo, California (Colorado?), and Mrs. August Cheveraux and Mrs. Louis S. Menegay, of Louisville, are living. Mrs. Rebillot was devoted to her home and the members of her family and was gratified in seeing her children grow into noble manhood and womanhood. Solemn high mass was read at St. Louis Catholic church, Wednesday morning. Rev. Father Cheveraux, of Norwalk, officiated as celebrant; Rev. Father Treiber, of Canton, as Sr. Deacon; Rev. Father Schoenamann, of Canton, as Jr. Deacon; Rev. Father Senner, of Louisville, as Master of Ceremonies. Rev. Father Cheveraux, who has been a life-long friend of the family, delivered a fitting sermon. The remains were followed by a large concourse of friends to the Catholic cemetery where interment was made."

Mrs. Rosan Gulling, one of the oldest citizens of Nevada both in years and residence died at the home of her son, Charles Gulling, last night following an illness of several weeks at the age of 84.  
Mrs. Gulling was born in France in 1837. She came to America in 1844 and lived in Canton, Ohio, for several years. She went to California, by way of Isthmus of Panama in 1855. In 1866, before the city of Reno was founded, she came to Nevada and lived in Glendale. In 1873 she moved to Reno and had lived here since that time.

Mrs. Gulling is survived by three children, John Gulling, Charles Gulling and Mrs. Josie Eason. There are nine grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren of the deceased living in Washoe county at the present time.

Funeral services will be held at 10 o'clock Tuesday morning at the Catholic Church.
