"Almira Jane Wire was born in Ohio, February 3, 1894, and died in Berrien Springs, Michigan June 1916. She was united in Marriage to John Wire in the year 1852, who passed to the other world in 1904.

She leaves to mourn her loss - one brother, and a sister, two sons, Miles and Willard Wire, of Berrien Springs; also four grandchildren, two great grandchildren, and one great, great grandchild.

In the year 1887 on the 4 day of September Reverend W.J. Hathaway received Sister Wire from probation into the Methodist church at Berrien Springs. While unable to attend church services for sometime past, she lived the life on one who knew God. To the last she trusted in God's ability to keep and guide "in the valley and shadow of Death". While she held dear her many friends, she like Paul, desired to depart and be with Christ.

In the old family Bible are found many evidences of her Christian experience. Such thoughts as "Heaven", "The way to Salvation", and many others are left behind as remaining witnesses of her trust in God.

Calmly smoking a cigaret, Willard Wire, 43 years old, a former resident of this village, waited for death to come, after he had slashed both his wrists with a razor in his room at 822 S. Lafayette blvd., South Bend, early Thursday morning, 'Just tire of living, that's all,' is the explanation he gave.

Blood spurted from his wounds and covered his bed and the floor of the room making it necessary for police officers, who answered the hurry call sent in by neighbors, to walk through blood to get Wire to the ambulance.

At headquarters, Wire was treated by the police surgeon, and then removed to Epworth hospital, where the verdict is that he will recover "He lost considerable blood,' said the nurse, 'but he didn't reach the arteries in either wrist. or 9 Ora's Aunt Laura sent Ora to pick cherries for a cherry pie. Ora brought in a pail of cherries, and her Aunt Laura sent her back out to pick the stems off the trees. Ora's brother Kenneth heard his sister Ora crying, and went to investigate. When he found out what the situation was, Ora said her brother "beat up Uncle John (Benson)".

Ora completed 10 years of school in Benton Harbor, Michigan and lived at home with her parents until age 10 or 11. At this time she moved in with Fred G. and Anna Armstrong. She baby-sat their children in exchange for room and board. John Allmandinger's was another family where she baby-sat their children in exchange for her room and board. She worked alternately between the two families. At age 14, she returned to her mother's home to discover that her mother had moved, and left no forwarding address. At this time Ora went to board with Eli and Pearl Keller. While staying with them, she found employment at Baker Vater (paperworks). She ran a punch press, then a perforator, then another punch press. After she left Baker Vater (after WWI), she moved to Chicago, Illinois, to live with her sister Laura . . . and worked at the Fair Department Store. Origin and Changes Of The Riddle Surname

The following is a slightly edited extract from the book *Some More Riddles Of North Carolina* by Richard Riddle.

Ridlon (G.T. Ridlon's "History of the Ancient Ryedales and Their Descendants in Normandy, Great Britain,

Ireland, and America, From 860 to 1884) states that the surname [Riddle] appears on the pages of the Doomsday Book and in a variety of forms, such as Ridle, Ridel, and Ridell. We must look to Norway or Normandy for the origin of the name.

The name, Riddle, is a local type name (makes reference to a locality or territory] from a place in Scandinavia called Rugdal or Ryedale, the valley of rye". Other Riddle historians have postulated that as the name changed from Ryedale and Riddell to Riddle, as the name is always pronounced by Scotsmen, it has not caused a loss of the full meaning of the original.

A riddle was an instrument by which rye and other grains were winnowed and cleansed and the change to Ridler and Riddler makes the form denote one who winnows grain with a riddle or sieve.

At what point in time did the Riddles start giving their name to the land or estates they owned is not precisely known. It is known that Walter de Ridale got his lands from David I, King of Scotland, between 1124 and 1153, and that these lands were called "Baronies of Riddell and Whitton". The several branches of the family have followed the early custom of bestowing their own names upon their lands whenever and wherever acquired. We have in Scotland, "Cranstown-Riddell", "Glen-Riddle", "Mount-Riddell", and into-Riddell".

In the United States we find "Glen Riddle", "Riddle's Banks", "Riddle's Station", "Riddleton", and "Riddle's Crossroads". The surname used by the Riddells of Roxburghshire, Scotland was originally derived from a place known as Ryedale. The three ears of rye and sheaves of grain, almost universally found in their coats-of-arms is sufficient proof. Nearly all branches of the Scottish families have spelled their name "Riddell", however many old documents spell their name as "Riddle" in the Scot and English houses. Many small branches exist in Scotland and England who claim descent from the Ryedale and spell their own name "Riddle".
