Martin, New Pennacook Folks, Early Rumford with Genealogy of First Families, (1980), Joshua Ripley, date and place of birth undetermined, came to Rumford before 1793 with his wife ____ Bartlett and settled on the west side of the Ellis River near the Andover town line. He was present at the first town meeting held March, 1880 and elected to an office. He was a Revolutionary War pensioner. He is known to have owned property in 1820. Date of death undetermined.

He sold out to Nathan Hunting in 1806, and moved just south and rebuilt near the Howe brook.

The 1800 Census shows a Joshua Ripley in Rumford, Cumberland, ME. 1 male 16-26, 1 male $>$ 45, 2 females 10-16, and 2 females 16-26.

The 1810 Census shows a John Ripley in Rumford, Oxford, ME. 1 male $<$ 10, 3 males 16-18, 1 male 26-45, 2 males $>$ 45, 2 females $<$ 10, 1 female 16-26. Joshua may be one of the males $>$ 45.
