**Notes for LEWIS KEELING:**

**In 1826 Lewis and Lydia moved from the state of Kentucky to Illinois mainly because slavery was distasteful to them. They first settled in Jacksonville, but within two years moved to Springfield. Lewis at this time purchased a Gist & Saw Mill on the South Fork of the Sangamon River. It was reported that Lewis was an intimate friend of Daniel Boone. At the time of his death Lewis Keeling was an extensive land owner, owning several thousand acres of valuable Timber & Prairie Land along the Sangamon River.**

**Notes for ATHARINE KEELILING:**

**ATHARINE KEELING** learned the Brick business at the age of fourteen, going to a pay school three monts out of twelve. It is noted that Atherine was a neighbor to Abraham Lincoln, and was well acquainted with him. Atherine left home at the age of eighteen and commenced to work for himself in the brick business, employing a number of hands and clearing \$1000 dollars the first year. He continued in this field for a period fifty two years. Besides the brick business, Atherine moved to CANTON ILLINOIS in 1841 and conducted a genera store under the firm name of MAFEL AND KEELING. It was noted that he was Alderman for several terms in Canton, commissioner of Highways and a School Director. In 1850 he purchased a farm in Section 2, Farmington Township, an operation of which he supervised until his death. In 1872 he relocated to Farmington and established a brick manufacturing plant. Atharine voted for Henery Clay in 1844, and for the Atharine Candidates until the organization of the Republican Party, at which time he supported this party. He was a member of the Baptist Church for forty years. At the first annual gathering of the fathers and mothers of Farmington Township, Atherine said " he molded with his own hands several thousand bricks which had been used to build the Old State House- now the Court House of Sangamon County in Springfield.

**Atherine Keeling whose sketch now invites attention, is one of the oldest men in the state of Illinois having in the course of his life,witnessed many changes and an immense amount of progress in the state, and also having accumulated a considerable fortune.**

## **ATHERINE KEELING**

**Atharine Keeling was born in Elizabeth, Hardin County Kentucky on the 12th day of May 1823, being the son of Lewis and Lydia Keeling. When only three years of age our subject moved with his parents to the State Of Illinois, the family leaving the beautiful Blue Grass Country for no other reason than slavery was distasteful to them, as that custom prevailed everywhere south of the Mason Dixon Line, they were forced to seek a northern home. Atharine's father Lewis Keeling died in 1856, his mother had died about 20 years before when only 36 years of age.**

**Our subjects paternal grandfather William Keeling was a Methodist Minister, and his birth was in England. He married from hat country Miss Susanna Grant, and upon Coming to America first settled in Virginia, but then removed to Kentucky Our subjects maternal grandfather Joseph Howey was born in the State of Virginia and married Miss Cecelia McKinney, they Were all of Scotch Irish descent and settled in Virginia about the time of the Colonial War.**

**Atharine Keeling married in 1848 to Miss Mary Jane Wilson, daughter of Samuel and Maria (Borehead) Wilson. She was born in Hamilton County Ohio, her father was by birth and education a Scotchman--Edinburgh being his native place. To Mr & Mrs Wilson were born seven children, Thomas J. Mary Jane, Maria, Elen, Margaret, Amanda and James who died in his youth.**

**ATHARINE KEELING--OLD CITIZEN OF FARMINGTON,  
WHOSE DEATH OCCURED SUNDAY EVENING:**

Atharine Keeling, who died at his home in this city Sunday evening at 6:45 O:Clock, of paralysis, had been ill but a few days. He suffered a stroke last Tuesday evening and failed to recover, Owing to his advanced age. During nearly all his life he was a very active man, but with the advance of years he gradually failed in Strength. When Atharine was eighteen years of age he traveled to Canton with some of his brothers,all of whom now are deceased. They walked the greater portion of the way from Springfield to Canton, Owing to the lack of traveling facilities of the time, which was about 1851. All of his life since that time had been passed in Fulton County, and the last 33 years in Farmington.

The deceased is the last of 11 children, many of whom continued there residence in Fulton County for some years, while some joined in the gold rush to California in 1849.

Funeral services will be held at the home Wednesday Morning 10 o'clock, the Rev Samuel C. Welsh, pastor of the Baptist Church,officiating interment will be in the Providence Chapel Cemetery, six miles west of Farmington.
