David Force and Jerusha Updike Force moved from a farm near Princeton, New Jersey, about 1799 to Tompkins County, New York and then to the town of Tyrone in Schuyler County, New York. David was nineteen at the time of the Battle of Princeton and helped care for the wounded. Jerusha was a child at the time and, as the battle was partly fought over her farm she had to be taken to a place of safety. Several of the children were born in New Jersey before they moved to New York. David died sometime after 1815 and Jerusha married Stiles Beach. David's grave has been lost. Jerusha is buried behind the Baptist Church, at Atlay, New York.

David Force, immigrant ancestor, was born in 1758 in France, and being left an orphan during the French Revolution, or in the troubles preceding, was cared for and brought to America by a Quaker with whom he was living. A youth of nineteen, at Princeton, New Jersey, at the time of the Battle of Princeton, in 1777. Restrained from enlisting in the American Army on account of the non combatant principals of his guardian he was at that time impressed into the service to help care for the wounded and dead. Among those who were conveyed from the danger zone between the armies was Jerusha Opdyke, a Holland Dutch girl. Whom he afterward married. Both his home and hers were between the firing lines and the Opdyke house was converted into a hospital. Among the descendants of this couple were many physicians and surgeons. Children: John, a soldier in the War in 1812, died in the service; Benjamin, mentioned below. The name in France was "La Force". and some of the descendants still retain that spelling.

Joshua King of Tompkins county New York, and Anna Force, daughter of David and Jerusha Updike Force, were married in New York State, sometime before 1813, and moved to the town of Jersey, County of Stueben, New York, sometime before 1823. They sold their New York Land and went west by flat boat to North Bend, Ohio. Later they went into Fayette county, Indiana in a section known as Yankeetown, near Bentonville. This town was mainly populated by primitive Baptists, many of them having come in a group with their minister, Elder Minor Thomas, from Convert Seneca, New York. Joshua King's Parents are not known, but he probably was a grandson of Barzilla; King of Convert.

Benjamin, son of David Force, was born in 1793, and died in 1873. He spent his youth in his native place in New Jersey and was a pioneer settler at Steuben County, now Schuyler county, New York. Where he followed farming all his active life. In politics he was a Whig and afterward a Republican. An Intense abolitionist, he was prominent in all anti slavery movements and his house was a station of the underground railroad. His grandson and namesake was instantly killed while serving in the Union Army in the Civil War in Sherman's "March to the Sea", in 1864.

He married (first) Sophia Caswell, born in 1796, and died in 1831. Her mother, Miriam (Smith) Caswell was born and raised in Massachusetts. A number of descendants of Thomas and Miriam Caswell were prominent business men in Ohio. Children of Benjamin Force were: John, Lodencia, Dr Lyman, Dr Alfred, and Chester B. Alfred Force, Physician, Attica, was born in the state of New York, June 8, 1822, son of Benjamin (a farmer) and Sophia (Caswell) Force native of New York and Massachusetts, respectively, and of English descent. Their family consisted of six children, of whom Alfred is the fourth. Our subject was reared on the farm, receiving his early education in his native state. He was united in marriage, in 1844, with Lucinda, daughter of Lewis Davison, and of English decent and their children were Alice, wife of S. Tackbury, Clarence C. a physician, and Windfield S., a medical student in Attica. In 1852 our subject came to this county and commenced the study of medicine in the office of Dr Franklin, at Tiffin, subsequently attending medical collage in Cincinnati, Ohio. He was in active practice till 1864, when he enlisted in the One Hundred Eighty-First Ohio Volunteer Infantry, and was appointed Assistant Surgeon of the regiment; most of the time however, he filled the position of Surgeon Major. At the close of the war he was mustered out of service. The Doctor then practiced in the state of New York until 1881, when he came to Attica, where he has since followed his profession. Dr Force is a member of the Universalist Church.

Chester B., son of Benjamin and Sophie (Caswell) Force was born at Kendall, in Altay Valley, Steuben County, New York, now in Schuyler County, in 1832, and died in 1906. He was educated in the public schools. He was a gifted musician. But his principal business through a long and active life was farming. His home was near Geneva, Ontario County, New York. In politics he was a Republican; in religion a member of the Christian Church.

He married, in 1860, Catherine Cromwell Winter, born Ontario County, in 1832, died in 1893, daughter of Joel Winter, born 1799, died 1872. Her father was a native of Danbury, Connecticut, a farmer by occupation, and a carpenter by trade; a Democrat in politics, and a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church. her mother, Lina (Witter) Winter, was born in 1805 in Orange County New York, Died in 1859, and resided from her second year until her death upon the homestead in Ontario County, near Geneva, New York, and was buried on the old homestead.

Abner Winter, father of Joel was born in Connecticut or Massachusetts; was a soldier in the Revolution and died

at Sodus Bay, New York. The father of Anna Miner, of an old Connecticut family, and while he was in the service During the Revolutionary War she cared for the family, harvesting the grain with a sickle and doing the other work of the farm. Ezra Witter, father of Lina (Witter) Winter, Purchased a tract of "New Country" in Ontario County, New York, Near Geneva, in 1807, and his estate was held in part by his descendants until the fifth generation. My Grandfather Charles H. Force was born Dec 3, 1841 in Jennings County, Indiana. He was one of 10 children born to David S. and Eliza Day Force. He married Emmerette Robinson on Dec 26, 1865. They had 9 children (5 girls and 4 boys). My father being the 6th child.

On July 7, 1861 my Grandfather joined the Federal Army, at the age of 20. He went to Minnesota and joined Company F of the 2nd Minnesota Infantry. Why he went to Minnesota to join the Army, I do not know. It may have been on account of his age.

In Nov and Dec of 1861 he was in the General Hospital of Louisville, Ky. due to a low grade fever. He lost all his hair only to have it grow back. He remained in the hospital until April 30, 1862. In Oct 1862 he took a short leave do to illness.

He re enlisted as a Veteran Volunteer on Dec 23, 1863 and was mustered out on July 11, 1865. From these dates he was in the Army four years and four days. When my father died in 1965 I found numerous original documents of my Grandfathers war records. I have given these to Duane for safe keeping.

The pension papers of Charles H. Force indicate that he was wounded in Georgia at Kennesaw Mountain, at 2 AM on June 22, 1864, by an exploding shell. The man on right was killed by the explosion and seven others were killed or wounded. This is substantiated by a Lt. Charles M. Friend. His company was under the command of General Sherman, who had a total of 1,556,000 men while the Confederate Army had a total 900,000. On May 7, 1864 Sherman started his march through Georgia to the sea. Atlanta fell on Sept 2, 1864. The march continued to Savannah which fell on Dec 22, 1864. On Shermans march through Georgia the Federals had 31,752 killed, wounded and missing, while Confederates had 38,023. The War actually ended on April 9, 1865 when General Lee surrendered.

Grandpa didn't apply for pension until Feb 23, 1895. Several of the affidavits presented indicates he could not work for half of each year, since the war and that he was unfit for labor from about 1893 onward. He had a persistent cough, back pains and kidney trouble. One affidavit states that his disabilities are permanent in character and are not due to any vicious habit and that he suffered continuously with lung and throat disease from 1867 to 1876.

Grandpa lived with my folks several years before his death which was on May 20th, 1925. He is buried in the cemetery on the south side of Plymouth, Ind.

Ray Force of Ponca Ne, who started trucking livestock to Sioux City in 1918, remembers the "Joys" of travel in mud. There wasn't a mile of hard surfaced, he said. With good luck we could make the 25 mile trip to Sioux City in a day's travel time. We would stay all night in Sioux City, and take the next day to go back.

Fifty cents a ton mile was a reasonable rate in those days. Mr Force's first load was eight 500-pound sows. For hauling them 28 miles he received a payment of \$23.

His truck was only pickup size, 5 by 8 feet. During 1918 most of his hauls were to the railroad at Ponca, which he took livestock on to Sioux City. About 25 percent of his hauls were direct to the market and 25 percent to Sioux City that year.

Ray farmed at Plymouth, Ind before moving to Ponca, Ne.
