Will of Allen Rutherford

I Allen Rutherford of the county of Noble and state of Ohio do make and publish this my last will and testament.

item 1st: is that all my just debits shall be paid

item 2: I give and [ ] to my son John one brown mare and her colt

item 3: I give and [ ] to my children all namely John, Joseph, Samuel, MareyAnn, Robert and James an equal share of all my lands when the youngest comes of lawful age

item 4th: I give to daughter MareyAnn all her mother's things, one bed, and bedding, one cow,[ ] and is [ ] of the house furniture and the side saddle.

item 4th: I do hereby nominate and apoint my son John, John Rutherford and Martin Beattay executors of this my last will and testament hereby authorizing and empowering them to compromise against release and discharge in such manner as they may deem proper the Debts and claims due me. I do also authorise and empower if it shall become nesisary in order to pay my debts to sell by private sale as in such maner upon such terms of credit or otherwise as s they may think proper all or any part of my real estate and [ ] to purchasers to exicute acknowledge and deliver in fee simple. I do hereby revoke all former wills by me made for testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 23 day of Sept 1851.

Allen came from Ireland by ship, landed in New York City where he met Ann and they were married. Ethel thought Ann worked at a textile mill and then they came to Ohio. Larry is suppose to send me a copy of the letter. Ann and Allen had 6 sons and 1 daughter.

Yes, there was an influenza and cholera epidemic.

Thank you so much for the reply, we knew it had to be something, so many died all in the same month. In our case Allen Rutherford (father) died Sept 28, 1851, Ann Rutherford (mother) died Sept 11, 1851 and William Rutherford (son) died Sept 1, 1851. The parents were in their mid 40's and the son was 8 yrs old. It must have hit Marion twp hard, cause there were many with the same dates ranging a two month period.

Mickey,

I found the Samuel Cooper connection!! As I said I ordered Allen's will and records of land sales by his children. I read your posts last night but this didn't hit me till this morning.... Samuel Cooper was a witness to Allen Rutherford's will. John Rutherford and Martin Beatty were named executors. Witnessed by Hugh Mybrant, Jr (hard to read) and Samuel Cooper, dated 23 Sept 1851. As I said before Allen died 28 Sept 1851, preceded in death by Ann his wife 11 Sept 1851 and son William A. 1 Sept 1851. Allen and Ann also had a daughter named Mary Ann so perhaps that is their mother's name.

Samuel Cooper is also a witness to a land transfer dated 12 February 1863 where John, Margaret Ann (his wife nee Crandle) and Robert Rutherford transferred land to Caroline Rutherford, wife of Joseph.

Albert Rutherford replied to one of our messages and I feel he may have something. Go to the Rutherford surname board and print out message #2358 for reference. I feel the family below is a place to start, since most of the names of the sons names are included in Allen Rutherford's family. I also feel Allen's father's name may have been John since his first son was named John. The only facts I know:

- 1) Allen born 1803, in Ireland
- 2) came to America prior to 1830, John born NY 1830.
- 3) Allen's wife Ann McNeal (Joseph's death cert b. NY, 1880 census listed b. Ireland) or Anna Cooper ( Robert's death cert b. Ireland), b. 1805
- 4) I have been told Allen and Ann were married in NY but have found no proof, could be Ireland before 1830.
- 5) I'm sure they were not catholic.....but don't know any more.

I did some research on an irsh web site and found the following that might help.

Although all of the above list household after they came to USA it tells us where they were. Also was told this Surname Dictionary:

Rutherford, numerous: mainly from the Ulster area. An important Scottish family from the Borders; in Ireland from 17th century.

If they can find anyone that would help us research this family I'd be willing to split the cost.....

I'd print out everything you have and give them copies to take with them and leave with someone to continue the hunt. I can't wait to see if they find anything, gosh I hope so..... Also as Keith suggests look for Rutherfords, Coopers (Samuel) and Beattys (Martin) in the same area could be a good clue.

Another clue there was a Rev. Robert Rutherford was also in Noble co at the same time, I don't know much about him or if he is connected? but this is what I know: (could he be a brother?)

Noble County History 1887 page 376

Sharon, an old and once flourishing village, was laid out March 22, 1831, under the proprietorship of Robert Rutherford and Edward Parrish. The first building erected within the present limits of the town of Sharon was a log school house.....prior to 1823.

Rev. Robert Rutherford, one of the proprietors of the town, was the first postmaster. An office was established through his efforts in 1830.

Rev Robert Rutherford, pastor of the Presbyterian church, was an early settler, locating here before the town was laid out.

page 377

Churches. Presbyterian- the first church edifice in Sharon was erected about 1823 by the Presbyterians and United Presbyterians..... the two congregations continued to worship in this building until about 1835, when the union of the churches was dissolved. Among the early ministers were Rev. John Arthur, Rev. Robert Rutherford..... ( this is basically all the info about Rev. Robert)

Sharon township is quit a distance from Marion twp where Allen was but I find it very hard to believe there were two Rutherford's in Noble co at the same time and there are not related in anyway. I've never found anyother info about Rev. Robert. I looked on the 1880 census and found no remain family or anything. ?????

\*\*\*\* New info, I've been searching the 1880 census (www.ancestry.com) I have done Seneca, Center, Marion, Sharon, Stock and part of Wayne twps, I found some Coopers (sorry didn't print them out and can't remember where I found them now); found some Beattys, two families, but no Martin in Seneca twp; found Joseph and Robert Rutherford but no John so far. But I did find Richard Crandle age 58 farm labor b. MD, father b. MD, mother b. ?

Jane Crandle wife age 52? keeping house b. NY, father b. Conn, mother b. NY

Going thru the land transfers I have I found another clue, then found the marriage record; Mary Ann Rutherford married Isaac Youngblue July 20, 1861; so I have not found them on the 1880 census, but I did find his brother

Jesse in Center twp and Jesse testified for Robert Rutherford for his Civil War pension case. I have found no clues as to what happened to Samuel Rutherford?

Also, Keith in case you didn't know John and Margaret Ann had another son, Thomas A. s/o J & M. A. Rutherford  
died Nov 11, 1856 aged 2 yrs, 2 mo, ? days  
he is buried next to Allen at Whigville.

Keith and Mickey could you both send me the info you have about your families so I can add it to mine.

I've noticed your postings re Allen Rutherford, b 1803 in Ireland. My own Rutherfords were from co Donegal, Ireland, but I don't recall ever having come across the name Allen or Alan among them. The Christian name is usually spelt as Alan, where it appears as Allen it is usually called after a surname, eg mother's maiden name. The name does appear in the family of Rev John Rutherford, of co Down, Ireland, and his wife Isabella Alleine. Seems possible that their son Allen Rutherford was called for his mother's maiden name (Alleine). Perhaps your Allen Rutherford (b.1803) may belong to this family!

They were in the Battle of Boyne which gave the Protestants control of Northern Ireland.

I was able to find thru ancestry.com where Samuel Cooper and Isaac Youngblue both bought Federal Land. BLM - ES, GLO Records - Home If you go to this site you can select Ohio then search for your ancestor if they bought Federal Land you can see and print a copy of the land deed and the cool thing is it's signed in hand by the current president. Play with the tab on top of the info for various options and info.

Samuel Cooper of Monroe County Ohio purchased the SE quarter of the SE quarter of Section 8 in twp 7 Range 8; April 10, 1837 (So this proves he was right there at the same time as Allen Rutherford)

I found Isaac Youngblue bought Federal land in Vinton County, Sept 1, 1857 from what I could tell it fell in Eagle twp in Vinton County. This was before he and Mary Ann Rutherford were married and I suppose he stayed in Noble County for a while since they were married there and then they moved to Vinton County sometime. I also found Isaac on the Ohio Miracode index of 1910, living alone in Vinton County. So I supposed Mary Ann died before 1910. I went to Vinton Co Genweb and luckily they have a death index online. I found; What has to be Mary Ann.

Also, I'm going to be writing Noble County again for some more stuff, I'm going to ask for a search on John Rutherford I assume the same as for Isaac Youngblue that he died in Noble Co between 1910 and 1913. Maybe out luck will continue.

I've heard back on my last requests from Noble Co. They could find no death record for Samuel or Benza Cooper, nor for John Rutherford. I know John was in Noble in 1910, but now have no idea where he died?

I got the will administration for Allen Rutherford and the will of Joseph Rutherford. I asked for the will of Samuel Cooper but none was found, however they did tell me they found Samuel, Jr's will. Do you have that? They did not send it to me, but I can get it, if you don't have it.

Now I'm just waiting for Mary Ann Rutherford Youngblue's death certificate from Vinton County and I'll send you everything I have. Hopefully that will determine if Ann was a McNeal or a Cooper.

Hello Becky,

Thank you for your mail regarding your Rutherford ancestors. I have read through the information you have and my first thought was to check the townland valuations. In 1827-1834 only two Allen Rutherfords are found in Ireland renting either a house or land.

The above John Rutherford is I think the son of Rev. John (see later) It is significant that both an Allen Rutherford and a John Rutherford are found living in close proximity.

These locations and the rarity of the name would seem to fit nicely into your research to date. I am wondering about the registers of birth and marriage for Annahilt. The Presbyterian Church dates from 1779 and theoretically birth records should be available from that date. It may be that your researcher has already explored that avenue. It could be that the early records have not survived but I can look into that. The Rutherford and Beatty/Beattie family seem to have had an ongoing connection in that I have in the data base the following references:

Eliza Ann Rutherford of Annahilt wife of Joseph Beatty  
Mother of James Beatty born 1868 and Robert Beatty born 1870

Mary Rutherford wife of John Beattie

I have the book "History of the Congregations in the Presbyterian Church in Ireland 1610-1982" from which your previous researcher took his information. The only thing I can add is that John Rutherford son of Rev John was ordained in Ballydown on 15th August 1848 and after 26 years he resigned on 1st November 1874 in order to join his family in the United States. The question is asked did he join a brother called Allen? From past experience in Irish family research I have found it was common and accepted practice for a man to call his first born son after his father, so it would seem likely that Allen Rutherford's father was indeed John. It may follow if the same principle is applied that Rev John Rutherford's father was also John as I estimate that John Rutherford jun. would have been older than Allen. Could Allen be the surname of the mother, Rev John's wife?

There are a great many resources that can be examined for evidence of your family including freeholders lists, poll tax lists, voters lists all dating from 1665-1795 There is the census of 1776 and the List of Protestant householders of 1740 The PRONI archive is the largest of it's kind in either Britain or Ireland and contains some 50 miles of records. Among these something should surely be found.

All data was copied from the LDS microfilm of the Vinton County Ohio Death Records. All data has been entered here as near as possible to what was written on the original record. No attempt has been made to change spelling or apparently incorrect data. This volume is TYPEWRITTEN instead of handwritten. That makes it easier to read, but introduces the ADDITIONAL PROBLEM of typographical errors (and I have noticed many) in the records. I have added a comment line or lines after each person where there was some discrepancy within the record. The person's name and page number are repeated on the comment lines for sorting purposes. The page numbers in Volume 4 are not in consecutive order on the microfilm (or in the original book, I imagine). For instance, the "A" surnames are on pages 55, 56, 183, 184, 121, 122, 271, then 272, but the pages have all been grouped together in the "A" section. All surnames that begin with the same letter are together in its own section. There are no Married, Single or Widowed indicators in this volume.

I do not know the exact purpose of Volume 4 since this volume covers the time period of 1909 to 1952, but all the deaths were recorded during 1952. During this time period the Ohio Department of Health kept the original death certificates. Due to the number of deaths in this volume, I believe that it was meant to serve as an index to the Dept. of Health death certificates. Each record contains a certificate number that probably refers to a Dept. of Health page number (since there are duplicates), not an individual certificate, though I have not researched how they refer. They seem to be numbered starting with 1 for each year, but not necessarily. Where parents of stillborn or very young children are given, only the father is listed in this volume. The original record should have both parent's names, except where one or the other was not known.

Becky, did you get my picture of George Washington Brown? Since he and his wife, Mary Ann Shafer, both lived into the 1890's, and since a photo was taken of him, it seems to me there should be one somewhere of her, too. That wasn't so long ago.

The following is not about the Shafers, but I'll include it here. In a xeroxed copy of a letter to my Aunt Angie (Cleary) Pigg, on November 29, 1946 (god, today is Nov 29), "Aunt Ethel" Rutherford wrote, "And about my Dad's people I don't know much either. My grandfather R came from Ireland, he and his three sisters. One sister was Mary Davison Carter's grandmother and one was Ann Jackson. Whether James Beatty's wife was a Jackson or Rutherford, I don't know which it was. But I do know we are related to the Beatty's on Dad's side anyway. Ma has a lot of relatives too at Mt Ephraim. My grandfather married in York State (New York now). Her name was Ann McCan. I know Uncle John, a joiner, was born in York State as he always called it. And there was Aunt Mary Ann Rutherford Younglue, and Joseph R, a farmer (my father), Robert Rutherford, veteran of the Civil War, Samuel R - was a cook in the Civil War. He couldn't fight as he was a cripple from a white swelling when a child. James R was in the Civil War but never came home. All died close together I don't know how far apart but the same summer, or fall, I don't know which. I have heard Uncle John talk about it. Uncle Sam had 2 daughters and a son. Uncle has been dead a long time. His son and wife and little son are at our home once. Uncle Sam's second wife was along. Uncle Sam lived at Chillicothe, O. He kept a tavern for ears, (?) owned several houses in C. One of the daughters did live in Cleveland, O. Uncle John had one son to live. He died long ago but his children are around --well or Marietta. Aunt Mary Ann never had any children. She lived and died in Vinton County. END

Grandfather Rutherford's name was Joseph, Sr. Grandmother was Carolyn Brown. They had 10 children, 6 girls and 4 boys. They were James, George, Tilley, Mary Ann, my mother and your grandmother. Arabella, Emma, Law, Hiram, Joe and Ethel. She was the youngest, about Uncle Ed's (my Uncle Ed, Kyle's brother) age.

They lived close to a small town, East Union. Some people called it Bragadoci(?).

To get to their home you had to go up a lane. You had to go through 4 or 5 gates, then up a large hill. We used to go there with horse and buggy (I guess you know what that was). They had a real nice spring of water.

Grandmother R was a good cook. She always had chicken. They always had 2 or 3 cows, and enough chickens for their eggs. They raised their own hogs for their pork. Every since I remember Grandpa was hard of hearing and pretty crippled. His byword was good-a-mighty. He used to come visit us. Always came on horse back (Old Maud). He was a little different than the grandpa's of today.

He came to visit us one time. When he went home they asked if there was anything new. We had an organ. He said the girls played the dulcimer all the time. He didn't have a lot of education. People couldn't cheat him in a deal. They were Scotch Irish. That picture [portraits of J and Caroline now on Becky's website] looks a lot like

them, but younger than when I knew them. Some say if it wasn't for the beard I would look like him.  
I think G.P was 70 some when he died and G.M. probably in the 80s. there was a lot of big sandstone on their place.  
I hope you can get a little good out of this....

Whilst the court was arranging for the trial, Rutherford went to the Probate's office and procured a marriage license and the plaintiff and the defendant in the suits were made man and wife, in the Prosecuting Attorney's office by C. M. Watson, Mayor. It is needless to say that the cases were continued off the docket by the courts"."

Does anyone know the name of their first baby? The only date I have for their children is Meredith W., born July 17, 1897. The other children's name I have is: Ernest, James E., Theodore C., and Bertha. I do not have any info on the others except Bertha. Bertha married a MORRIS and had three children: Mary, Thomas J., and Elmer Franklin. Have no info on these Morris children.

Chapter VIII - Border Families, Houses & Names

Rutherford

According to legend, the first of the Rutherfords was a peasant who guided the Scottish King Ruther across the Tweed just behind the present Rutherford Lodge, where their Chief still lives, and was given the adjoining land for this valuable service. It seems a pity to spoil a good story, but Scottish History knows of no "King Ruther". The ford, however, is genuine enough, and the peasant could well have taken Malcolm Canmore's great-grandfather across it on his way to Carham, the victory that gave Scotland her present size and shape. It would have cost Malcolm II nothing to give him the land as his well-earned reward, especially as it still belonged to Ethelred the Redeless (or Unready) and the name itself could simply mean "cattle ford" or the somewhat redundant "river ford" (one does not normally ford anything else!). If so the Rutherfords are the second oldest landed family in the Borders after the Swintons, and like them of Anglo-Saxon origin.

However, the first actually known to History is Robert de Rodysforde, who witnessed a charter of St. David I in 1140, and the record is only continuous (to the extent of something being down on parchment or paper for every generation of the family) from the time of Hugo de Rutherford, again mentioned as a witness to a land grant about 1215. His grandson, Sir Nichol de Rutherford, signed the Ragman Roll like nearly all Scottish lairds except Wallace himself, but later joined Wallace, to whose wife he was related, and assisted him in the Battle of Biggar and the capture of Sanquhar Castle. Sir Robert de Rutherford, his son, was a friend of Robert the Bruce and of the "Good Sir James Douglas", and fell with Sir James in Spain, guarding the Bruce's heart (which was later brought back to Melrose Abbey, where it remains hidden).

Sir Robert's grandson, Sir Richard Rutherford, was an ambassador to the English Court in 1398 and Warden of the Marches (together with his sons) two years later. Another of the same generation was Robert Rutherford of Chatto, also known as "Robin of the Tod's Tail" from his unconventional battle standard at Otterburn in 1388. He had conveniently killed a fox just before the battle and finding nothing more suitable to use as a rallying point for his men, he tied its brush to a lance. It was distinctive enough, and it worked: he survived and found himself on the winning side.

Philip Rutherford, near the end of the 15th century, was the first Rutherford heir in 300 years, and perhaps longer, to die before his father; his eldest son Richard was the first head of the family to die without issue, and the present head of the family is descended from Philip's younger brother Thomas.

The Rutherfords of Hunthill are descended from John Rutherford of Chatto, a younger son of Sir Richard. One of his sixth-generation descendants was Andrew, later Lord Rutherford and Earl of Teviot, who served in the French army in the first decades of Louis XIV's long reign. He came to England with Charles II, who gave him a peerage, and brought with him his regiment, who became the 1st Royal Scots. Subsequently he was made Earl of Teviot as a reward for helping to negotiate the sale of Dunkirk (taken by Cromwell a few years earlier) to Louis: this gave Charles II a useful lump sum for which he did not have to answer to Parliament. Lord Teviot was appointed Governor of Tangier (which had become an English possession as part of Catherine of Braganza's dowry) but was killed there by the Moors in a skirmish. Tangier was later abandoned as too expensive to defend and supply—a grave strategic error as it could have been used to keep the Barbary pirates bottled up in the Mediterranean and, together with Gibraltar (seized from Spain 20 years after Tangier was given up to the Moors),

it would have given England complete control of the Straits.

The Hunthill branch of the family also included Major Andrew Rutherford, who fought with Claverhouse at Killiecrankie and later emigrated to France like many adherents of James VII and II (and the King himself). With the Scottish company he commanded, he served with distinction in the French army, notably at the capture of Rosas on the Costa Brava and in the defence of Alsace (conquered a few years earlier by Louis XIV and Turenne) against a German counter-attack. Major Rutherford and his men, wading breast-deep through the icy Rhine in December, recaptured a small island to which the Germans had already built a pontoon bridge, then held it against heavy odds until reinforcements arrived. Major Rutherford is not recorded as having been killed in the battle but probably died from wounds suffered there, as nothing more is heard of him.

An earlier Rutherford of Hunthill was the "Cock of Hunthill", also an ancestor of William Gladstone, who played a prominent part in the action at Redeswire, the last "official" battle between Scots and English, though there were several later affrays and raids. Nine of his sons also fought there, among them Richard, the "bald Rutherford" who led the Jedburgh men as their Provost and who had a few years earlier presided over the "debagging" incident mentioned on p. 23.

Several Rutherfords of the Hundalee branch (descended from yet another son of Sir Richard) were provosts of Aberdeen. One of them, Alexander, held this office for nearly 20 years and was a noted Anglophobe. He made a speech against the Union of Crowns, first in Scots, which the English nobles could not understand, then in French, then in Latin, but avoiding speaking any English, except a few words whenever he ran out of Latin. This made a great impression on the scholarly King James, who disagreed with him but gave him a ring from his own finger as a token of appreciation. Provost Alexander Rutherford also had to put down a "sit-in" by the boys of Aberdeen Grammar School, who were armed with "hagbuttis, pistollis, swordis and lang wapynniss", organised as a protest against the suppression of Christmas celebrations by the Kirk.

An interesting document from the family history of the Rutherfords is their "peace treaty" with the Kerrs at Ancrum Spittal in 1560. Written in medieval Scots and difficult to read, it provides compensation of £500 to be paid by the Kerrs to George Rutherford of Longnewton, whose father had been killed not long before, and for Robert Kerr of Newhall to "offer his sword" to George Rutherford (and presumably get it back) "according to the practice and fashion of the country". Additionally several Kerr-Rutherford marriages were to be arranged, in some cases between unspecified young couples, when the girls were 12 and the boys reached an unspecified age of majority (probably 14 or 15). In one case the parties were named; Andrew Kerr (Robert's son) and a daughter of Philip Rutherford of Edgerston. If Andrew died, his next available brother was to take his place; if the girl died, "another gentlewoman of that surname and blood". Some of the signatories were illiterate, so the notary "led their pens".

Not all the Rutherfords were soldiers, landowners or provosts: one of them was a naval captain at Trafalgar and several were professors of theology, medicine or science, among them Samuel Rutherford, D.D., one of the leading Covenanters', Dr. John Rutherford, and his son Daniel. Sir Walter Scott's uncle, who discovered nitrogen gas. As a young man in Paris, Dr. Daniel Rutherford refused to attend a party where Prince Charles Edward, by then an alcoholic and an overweight shadow of his former self, was expected to be present; though not a Jacobite, he had too much respect for the House of Stewart to witness the degradation into which they had sunk. He died suddenly, while stroking a cat, after attending his sister, Sir Walter Scott's mother, who had gone down with "paralysis"; another sister died two days later and Mrs. Scott not long after.

If we now live in the nuclear age, for better or for worse, part of the responsibility must lie with Lord Rutherford of Nelson (1871-1937), the father of atomic science. He was born Ernest Rutherford, near the town of Nelson in New Zealand, from which he took his title, his grandfather having emigrated from Perth thirty years earlier, and educated at Nelson College and at Canterbury College, Christchurch, where he graduated with first-class honours in mathematics and physics. He then came to Trinity College, Cambridge, and worked under Sir J.J. Thomson (also of Scottish descent, though born in England), experimenting with electromagnetic waves and with various kinds of radiation. He was appointed Professor of Physics at McGill University in Montreal before his 27th birthday, returned to New Zealand to be married and settled with his wife in Montreal, continuing his research into radio-activity there and at Manchester University, where he became Professor of Physics in 1907. While at Manchester he discovered the division of the atom into a nucleus and electrons but did not manage to actually split the atom, though he foresaw that it could be done and would give rise to an entirely new and terrifying form of energy. He succeeded Thomson as Professor of Experimental Physics at Cambridge in 1919 (having been knighted a few years earlier), was elected President of the Royal Society in 1925 and was created a peer in 1931.

Robert De Rutherford witnessed a charter by David 1 around 1140. Sir Nichol de Rutherford is mentioned in several charters between 1161 and 1272. Sir Richard Rutherford was a favourite of Robert III he was ambassador to England in 1398.

Thomas Rutherford, The black Laird of Edgerston, was famed for his daring attacks upon the English. His most notable exploit was at the battle of the Red Swire at Caterfield in July 1575. This came about when the English and the Scots wardens of the marched had met to hear mutual grievances and to give redress for complaints. The Scots demanded the surrender of a notorious English brigand named Farnstein. The English claimed that Farnstein had fled and could not be found. Sir John Carmichael, the Scots warden, doubted this and said so to Sir John in plain terms. The English warden retorted with insults regarding Carmichael's family whereupon the English bowman discharged a flight of arrows among the Scots Sir John Carmichael was taken prisoner However the Rutherfords and the men of Jedburgh soon appeared and put the English to flight, freeing Carmichael and instead taking prisoner the English warden and a number of lieutenants.

The Lairds of Edgerston further distinguished themselves fighting for Charles I during the civil war Rutherford raised a troop of horse at his own expense and fought in England until the king surrendered in 1646. He took up the cause again only to be severely wounded and have his whole troop wiped out at the battle of Dunbar in 1650.

General Andrew Rutherford was raised to peerage as Lord Rutherford in 1661. He was appointed Governor of Tangier in Morocco in 1663 and was killed in battle against the native forces in 1664 He had been advanced to the earldom of Teviot, but died without issue, this title became extinct, the title Lord Rutherford passing to a cousin. This title is also extinct.

Andrew Rutherford was a MP for Leith from 1839-1851. He held the office of Lord Advocate and was raised to the bench with the judicial title of Lord Rutherford. Earnest Rutherford discovered the alpa particle and developed the nuclear theory of atomic structure, laying the groundwork for the development of nuclear physics in the 20th century. He was knighted in 1914 and appointed to the Order of Merit in 1925 and died in 1937.

The lands of Rutherford in Roxburghshire near Maxton The first is that a man named Ruther guided an ancient king of Scots (Rhyderch Hael?) over a little known ford in the river tweed, giving him a victory over the Northumbrians. He was given a grant of land there after, named after the crossing. Another story tells of an English army which foolishly abandoned a strong position on heights above the River Tweed to attack a Scottish force on the opposite bank The English attempted to force a crossing of the river and were defeated. The Scots named the place Rue the Ford, To commemorate the disaster at that spot
