Notes for George Latrace:

George LaTrace , 63 years old, of 2107 Salisbury street, a private watchman, died at 6:30 a.m. today at the city hospital from a bullet wound in the back, suffered Christmans morning when he was shot at 12:35 a.m. by Jack Weidig, 55, of 2317 North Eleventh street. The shooting was said by LaTrace to have been an accident and he refused to prosecute Weidig, who was released by the police. A Coroner's inquest will be held.

LaTrace was found on the floor of the real estate office of Strodman & Strodman, 3607 North Broadway. He told the police that Weidig had visited him during the night and had been drinking. Weidig took a revolver from his pocket, LaTrace said, and twirled it about on his finger. The weapon was discharged, the bullet striking LaTrace, who fell. Weidig ran and was arrested later.

LaTrace told the police that Weidig was his friend and that he was certain the shooting was accidental. Weidig said he had been drinking and that he remembered nothing of what happened. When he was arrested he was bruised about the face and head, the police say.
