Answer: He was a mixed blooded man in some way, that was his character. We generally called them Malungeons when we talked about the Goins and them the Goins that were mixed blooded . Q. Of what race of people was Solomon Bolton? What did he and his family claim as to be his nationality? How was he treated and recognized in the community where he lived? A. I don' t know of my own knowledge what race of people he belonged to. I often heard Bolton say that he was Portugese. I have often heard his wife say the same thing. He was treated and recognized in the community in which he lived as such. My mother was an American, was born in America. I don't know what nation sh e descended from. (Shepherd Trial) Vardy Collins, Shepherd Gibson, Benjamin Collins, Solomon Collins, Paul Bunch and the Goodmans, chiefs and the rest of them settled here about the year 1804, possibly about the year 1795, but all these men above named, who are called Melungeons, obtained land grants and muniments of title to the land they settled on and they were the friendly Indians who came with the whites as they moved west. They came from the Cumberland County and New River, Va., stopping at various points west of the Blue Ridge. Some of them stopped on Stony Creek, Scott County, and Virginia, where Stony Creek runs into Clinch River. --- The old pure blood were finer featured, straight and erect in form, more so than the whites and when mixed with whites made beautiful women and the men very fair looking men. These Indians came to Newmans Ridge and Blackwater. Some of them went into the War of 1812-1914 whose names are here given; James Collins, John Bolin and Mike Bolin and some others not re membered; those were quite full blooded." Lewis M. Most of the Collins, Gibson, Bunch, Riddle, and possibly Bolen families came from the Flat River area of Orange county, North Carolina to the back woods area of the New river at the borders of North Carolina and Virginia around 1767.

Thomas Gibson family, moved to Wilkes county NC from the Flat River around this time, then to Fort Blackmore, Virginia. A Cherokee mother bears a child, known as Ridge, in the town of Hiwassee, on the Hiwassee River at Savannah Ford, at this time it is North Carolina, late r Tennessee. This is the probable birth year of Cherokee Chief Ridge.

The legend of how Vardy and Shepard Gibson came to Hawkins/Hancock Cowas told in Will Allen Dromgoole's "Four Branches of Melungeon Tree"(1890's)
(referring to Shepard as "Buck") ;

These two, Vardy Collins and Buck Gibson, were the head and source of the Melungeons in Tennessee. With the cunning of their Cherokee ancestors, they planned and executed a scheme by which they were enabled to set up for themselves in the almost unbroken Territory of North Carolina.

Old Buck, as he was called, was disguised by a wash of some dark description, and taken to Virginia by Vardy where he was sold as a slave. He was a magnificent specimen of physical strength, and brought a fine price, a wagon and mules, a lot of goods, and three hundred dollars in money being paid to old Vardy for his "likely nigger". Once out of Richmond, Vardy turned his mules shoes and stuck out for the wilderness of North Carolina, as previously planned. Buck lost little time ridding himself of his negro disguise, swore he was not the man bought of Collins, and followed in the wake of his fellow thief to the Territory. The proceeds of the sale were divided and each chose his habitation; old Vardy choosing Newmans Ridge, where he was soon joined by others of his race, and so the Melungeons became a part of the inhabitants of Tennessee."

Mildred lived in Lafayette Township, Coles County, IL in 1900 and Mildred Fugate (Fugate) is also listed on the census. She was 100 years old!! So, I am a descendant of David Denham. He is my Great-Great-Great-Great Grandmother. My grandmother's name was Caladona (Callie) Robinson. My grandfather was Alexander (Alex) Robinson. I am also an Afro-American. Many of the Denhams, because of their fair coloring passed into the white race and it is difficult to trace. I have done a lot of research about the Denhams and even have a Professor at the University of Illinois interested in the Black ancestors in IL. He, too, states that we probably are Melungeons. I also know that some of the Denhams lived on a Kickapoo Indian Reservation in KS. Denton married Nancy Thomas Neice, daughter of James Thomas and Lucy Proctor of Granville Co . NC. Lucy brought her children into Letcher Co. Ky around 1845. They may have come from Ashe Co . NC at that time. James had already died. Greenberry Thomas in the 1850 census of Letcher Co . Ky. was her brother and my great, great grandfather. This is from a source that I know is true. Her name is Nancy meade and she told me Nancy was her grandmother and that Nancy had two children before she married OD or Denton Gibson by a Neice, Neace, Nease, Niece man. I hope it was her husband, but have not found a marriage as yet. It could be somewhere else besides Letcher Co. Ky. A lot of people do not know that Sarah Belle Neace who married James Thomas the dulcimer was her daughter and Jane Neice that married Peter Madden is also her daughter . Nancy Meade from Lexington, Ky. told me she was named after her grandmother Nancy Thomas Neice Gibson so i know this

information is true. I believe Denton was married two different times.?????? Please, if you have history on my Nancy and Denton, I would love to have it. I was born and raised in Letcher Co. Ky, raised my family in Cincinnati, Ohio, but have been living in Bradenton, Florida around 25 years. I am a retired registered nurse. I have been doing my family history around 19 years.

Lona, Thanks for responding to my query about OD Gibson and Nancy. I have no information about Nancy and I thank you for what you gave me.

What we have on OD is not much. Records indicate that he was the oldest son of Sheppard (Old Buck) Gibson and Matilda. He is the brother of my great grandmother Elizabeth (Betty) Gibson according to census records in Hancock Co. TNN. 1850. OD was also bondsman for Elizabeth on her Marriage Bond to Thomas Purcell but there is no record that the marriage was ever finalized. All of her children carried the Gibson name.

Sheppard was a lot older than Matilda and died in 1942 the year Elizabeth was born.

We are still researching for more solid evidence. My cousin will be going to TNN. This spring for more research.

Letter from Jeems ADAMS to Sherry Cross:

March 13, 1979

Here you have a letter from your honorable ancestor Uncle Dave (DavidMaggard ADAMS). I kno wthere was another letter that I had read at onetime, Sherry, from your ancestor (David Magg ard ADAMS) to my dad, but was not able to locate it.

Some note of explanation. The place referred to on Critical is just across the mountain from where I live - it runs into Guest River having headed up on the slope of Black Mountain. M y grandfather Shade ROBERTS owned almost the whole creek at one time but as his second wife Letty, the daughter of Spencer ADAMS [the father of your David] and for a token sum he sold Spencer around fifty acres of land at the mouth of the creek,and he built a house on it and lived there awhile.

When David says [in his Gearheart letter] that Christmas passed of without anybody getting hurt in the neighborhood, that was noteworthy, well Harlan may be know from coast to coast for feudin and afussin and being a dangerous area, but in all reality Floyd County had it beat and no -body mentioned it. I mean it was rough - I rather suppose it stil is. One of Davids sons Sidney by name was their company deputy sheriff in one of the coal-villages and the story goes he incurred the enmity of a group of miners who were of polish extraction and he ended up buried in a sand bar on the banks of Beaver Creek. Another incident of the same family and are a Davids son George had a 12 year old girl that had aquarrel with another girl at school one day and the next day the girl brought a gun to school and slew her.
