Census inconsistency not clear (clarence richard vs richard f), same month of birth, off by a year. Sarah's obituary states the couple had six children. Not clear why Clarence not included in list of children alive at time of her death (obituary states that three of their six children were dead-- AR is Abraham Ross, Cora and Maggie specifically listed in obit; William died in WWI, leaving Jesse and Richard not "found"). Clarence, Ross and Cora alive in Dad's obit.

Wanda Elvin Sykes:

"Old" Frank - my father's father - was in Arizona being cared for by my father. When he died he was in his nineties - no specific illnesses except cataracts - this was before surgery was possible I guess. Anyhow, Pappy had him housed and cared-for by a Mexican family just outside town. Went to visit almost every day but the day came when G'pa Elvin said "Don't bother coming by tomorrow. I won't be here." And - sure enough, he died because he wanted to - that night. According to my father (pappy), G'pa Elvin had said he couldn't see worth a damn, couldn't read, couldn't walk very well, and even his pipe didn't taste or smell very good (sic) any more.

July 26, 1919--For a few years the A.R. Elvin family lived in the East South Side, and it was while they lived there that one of the worst tragedies of Kearny County occurred. Mr. Elvin was working in the wheat harvest fields in the east at the time. When the river was low, the family used the east ford to cross the Arkansas River when going back and forth to Lakin. On this day, Mrs Elvin and the seven children in their lumber wagon went to Lakin for supplies. On the return trip they were crossing the railroad tracks east of the Millyard farm when their wagon was struck by a train. Mrs. Elvin, Elmer, her son, age eleven, and Opal, age nine were killed and the other five children were seriously hurt. Mrs. Bertha Clark, a practical nurse, opened her home for a temporary hospital where Dr. Johnston, Mrs. Clark and Mrs. Elvin's sister nursed the children back to health. Mr Elvin later moved to Lakin where he reared his family.

he laid his all upon the altar of his country and God accepted both gift and giver. Funeral services were held Friday at 3 P.M. in the Methodist Church, Rev. H.L. #### HISTORY OF NEW MILTON COMMUNITY

On Lick Run two of the earliest settlers were William Maxwell and Nathan Kelley neither of whom were married when they settled there but later married and reared large families. Nathan Kelley's wife being Elenor (Davis) Sutton, daughter of George J. Davis of New Milton, and the widow of George Sutton. Another of the earliest settlers on Lick Run was Alexander Orrahood, who lived near the head of the stream. The Husks, Davissons, Hecks, and Vannerts came a little later.

1.1.5 Alexander ORRAHOOD III, son of Joshua and Catharine (NORMAN) ORRAHUD, was born December 18, 1801 on the family farm in Hampshire County. On June 25, 1829, Alexander married Mary Elizabeth (Polly) FEASTER in Hampshire Co., WV. Reverend W.N. SCOTT performed the ceremony. Alexander's father gave him 80 acres of land on February 28, 1831. Alexander sold this land to Henry FEASTER on October 13, 1838. Soon after that, Alexander and Polly moved their family to Doddridge County, VA (WV). This move may have caused some hard feelings between Alexander and his father and may explain why he was left only a dollar in his father's will. In Doddridge County, Alexander purchased 357 acres of land near West Union. Alexander ARROWHOOD is listed on the 1850 census of Doddridge Co., VA, A.

ORRAHOOD in 1860 and Alexander R. ORRAHOOD in 1870. Polly died there April 28, 1883,

Alexander was married a second time to Elizabeth MILLER on July 30, 1884. Alexander died November 29, 1892. In his will he left all of his land and other property to his children and

grandchildren except for \$500 to his second wife. She refused her inheritance and went to court to request her dower rights. A record of the settlement has not been located.

the land transactions on the ORAHOOD land seem very complex. At one time, Alexander I had given 389 acres to Alex Jr. But a rift in 1800 seems to have resulted in 189 acres deeded back to Alex I, 100 acres to Joshua and 100 acres to Thomas Sr. Joshua was living on the 289 acres when he died, as well as another 80 acres he had bought in 1823. Joshua died about 1841 and his wife was to live on the land during her lifetime. She died about 4 Apr. 1853 and 150 acres of the land were sold by the heirs to Snowden Scott. It's possible some of the land lived on by Joshua was still in Alex' I's name in 1844. I haven't traced all the Orahood land exchanges in detail. I wish someone would.

John W. Simmons was, perhaps, the next settler. He, too, was a native of Pendleton county, and of German descent. But in his boyhood, with his parents, he came to Indian creek, this county, where he grew to manhood. He married Miss Elizabeth Hourhood, of Doddridge county, and their children were as follows:  
Mrs. Mary (Cameron) Swadley, Indian creek; Mrs. Huldah (George G.) Layfield; the late Mrs. Robert Smith, Cokeley's; and Aaron, and William Simmons, Cantwell. He died at his old home several years ago, and sleeps in the Pleasant Hill churchyard, not far distant. Mr. Simmons was the eldest son of Abraham and Mary Mullenax Simmons, who came from Pendleton county to Indian creek, perhaps more than sixty years ago, and remained until

they were laid in the Indian creek Baptist churchyard. He was one of a family of eight children; viz., Hanson, Abraham, Salathiel, George, James, Jane and Huldah, all of whom have passed on, except Jane and Salathiel.

Abraham, junior, married Mrs. Melissa Wilson Stanley, and was the father of George, and James Simmons, of Auburn.

Huldah married Absalom Cunningham, and, after her death, her sister Jane (who first married Jackson Nottingham, and later Jasper Cunningham, and William Divine' became the wife of Absalom Cunningham. She now resides with her son at Washburn.

Hanson passed on several years ago, George and James died in youth, and Salathiel lives on Island run.

Abraham Simmons, senior, was a brother of Peter, whose history appears with the Indian creek settlers.

It is my opinion that Robert Sylvester Gabbert was a son of David Gabbert and Nancy Jane Burgess and that David was a son of George Washington Gabbert and Elizabeth Ellinger. I have no direct evidence of this, only inference from George's will and from the census records.

George named grandson Sylvester in his will of 1858. He named sons John, Jacob and Abraham and daughter Elizabeth. No David was mentioned, so I assume that David had died before that date.

1.1 Joshua ORRAHUD was born about 1756 in Scotland before his parents immigrated to America. Joshua did not fight in the Revolution because he had been wounded in the arm making shot for the war probably at the foundry owned by Isaac ZANE near his family's home. On January 23, 1796, a land grant was issued to Joshua for 50 acres adjoining his father's land. On November 9, 1798 Joshua's father transferred 200 acres, including buildings, livestock and income to him.

Between August 2, 1800 and December 3, 1800 the land was realigned so that Alexander held 189 acres, Joshua 100 acres and Thomas 100 acres. On November 7, 1806 Joshua purchased the 189 acres left by his father to his sisters and brothers and on November 26, 1829 he obtained an additional 80 acres under a Treasury Warrant.

Deed Book 6:20, November 7, 1806 - Thomas Orahood and wife Sarah, John Grimes and wife Nancy, Caleb Orrahood and wife Phebe, Henry Monday and wife Ethto, John Carr and wife Abigail all of Hardy County, to Joshua Orrahood of same L70 Va. money acquit unto said Joshua into his actual possession 189 A in Hardy County on Loonie's Creek. Adjacent Joseph Praters and being formerly the land belonging to Alexander Orrahood deceased; no corners or lines with names. Present M.L. Selion, George Nevill, Nathan Parrill, Felix Welton and Edmd. Waggener; Sarah proved before A. Seymour and Manes Machir who visited her 25 Nov 1806; no other grantees except Thomas signed.

In 1808 he had sold 100 acres of original homestead to Frederick STEINBECK and on February 28, 1831 Joshua transferred his 80 acre tract to his son Alexander ORRAHOOD III and sold his 50 acre tract to Henry FEASTER. At the time of his death, Joshua was living on 289 acres of the original tract.

Joshua married Catherine NORMAN, probably before the Revolutionary War. Catherine was born in 1768. Joshua died sometime after June 8, 1841 when his will was dated and October 3, 1842 when his will was probated. He left his land, houses and income to Catherine for her use during her lifetime. After her death, he ordered that everything be sold at auction and the proceeds divided among his daughters except for Nancy NIPPER who was left one dollar. He also left his son Alexander III one dollar since he had already received 80 acres of land. In the 1820 census Josea ARCHOOR is listed in the Hardy Co., VA census. In the 1830 census he is listed as Joshua ORROWHOOD and in the 1840 census as Joshua AROWHOOD. In the 1850 census, Catherine was living next door to her daughter Abigail in Hardy County, VA. Catherine died April 4, 1853 and her will was probated April 5, 1853. After Catherine's death, Dr. Gabriel BARBEE (executor of Joshua's will) sold the 150 acres and holdings at public auction to Snowden SCOTT. Dr. BARBEE purchased the remaining 139 acres for \$400. The final settlement of the estate was recorded May 5, 1856 at a value of \$1,221.085 and divided between five of the six daughters mentioned in the will.

FRED L. FEASTER. An interesting example of true educational leadership is found in the person of the superintendent of schools of Grant District in Preston County, Fred L. Feaster. A brief description of what he has done there and elsewhere is in an important sense a valuable contribution to the educational system of the state.

Mr. Feaster is a school administrator in his native state, his birth occurring at Maysville in Grant County, August 25, 1885. The Feaster family was established in Grant County by his great-grandfather, who came about 1810 from Rockingham County, Virginia, and acquired considerable land in Grant County. Though he lived before the Civil war he always employed free labor in his fields. He died about the time of the war. Among his sons were William Henry, John, Cornelius, Mrs. Mary Raceler, and Margaret, who married Henry Keplinger.

William Henry Feaster, grandfather of Superintendent Feaster, spent his active life as a farmer, held the office of squire in the early days, was a Union man at the time of the war and a republican and a member of the Disciples Church. He died at the age of seventy-eight. By his marriage to Mary McDonald he had four sons and a daughter, and by his second wife was the father of four other children.

William C. Feaster, whose mother was Mary McDonald, was born near Maysville, April 30, 1855, and secured his education in the old type of subscription school. He became a farmer, and continued actively in that vocation until he retired and is now living at his home near Maysville. He married Rebecca Painter, daughter of Elias Painter, an old settler of Grant County, who came as a boy to Rockingham County, Virginia. In later life he acquired extensive holdings of land in the county. Elias

Painter married Eliza Danna, and they had six children. William C. Feaster and wife had the following children: Albert, a teacher and farmer at Maysville, Grant County; Mrs. Sophia Simpson, whose husband is a farmer near Maysville; Samuel O., a representative of the Metropolitan Insurance Company at Fairmont, West Virginia; Fred Lewis; Lulu, wife of Milton Simpson, of Maysville; Harry U., a roller in a tinplate mill at Marietta, Ohio; Lottie, wife of Ed Haslacker, of Maysville; Orrie, wife of Edward Puf-

finbarger, a farmer near Maysville; and Elvin, who is also a farmer near Maysville.

Fred L. Feaster grew up on the home farm, and the knowledge he gained of farming and country life has been an important asset to him as a leader in rural education. He attended the public schools, Broadus Institute, then located at Clarksburg, now at Philippi, and later the State University at Morgantown. When he was a boy there was not a high school in his home county, and to secure advantages beyond the common schools necessitated paying tuition and living expenses, all of which he earned. He began teaching at the age of eighteen, and alternately was teacher and pupil until he had completed his education and secured a high rating as a teacher. His first term

of school was taught in his home county. In order to board at home he walked three and a half miles back and forth, and received \$25 a month as wages. After teaching four terms he left the state and went to the far Northwest, stopping in Hubbard and Baker counties, Minnesota, and during the two years he was there he taught a term of nine months' school in each county. On returning to West Virginia Mr. Feaster resumed teaching in Grant County for three years. He was then called into Monongalia County as teacher of the village school of Blacksville. While there he had much to do with arousing public opinion and bringing about the establishment of a district high school, which gave a great impulse to education, increasing school attendance and developing the school from a two-room grade to a first class high school, wherein half the teachers of the district have taken college work.

In 1918 Mr. Feaster came from Blacksville to Bruceton Mills to take up his work as superintendent of Grant District. In this field he has been practically the pioneer in the matter of advanced education. He has had to achieve the establishment of a high school, which was started three weeks after he began his term. Its first enrollment was nineteen students, and in its third year the enrollment was forty. At Hazelton the first centralized rural school in Preston County has been created, and its work has justly aroused much enthusiasm. It is the result of a consolidation of five older districts, and the school is now-graded, with three teachers in charge. Its children are transported by the district to and from school, and some of the pupils had not previously attended school for several years. The facilities of this school comprise full eight grades.

The schools of Grant District have been graded to harmonize with the state course of study, and as a means of providing school supplies supplementing the funds provided by the state the schools have raised more than \$1,800 by holding socials and other entertainments for that purpose. The records in the office of the county superintendent of schools show that Grant District has the best school attendance in the county. Club work among the boys and girls has been encouraged. Many have carried out some projects in harmony with instructions issued by the extension department of the State University, and Mr. Feaster has busied himself with keeping the project and the people in touch with the University Extension System. Pig Clubs, Poultry Clubs, Potato Clubs and Corn Clubs have been formed by the boys, and the girls also have clubs in sewing, poultry, potatoes and sheep. The district has an annual camp, where members of these clubs meet to consider and develop the "Four-eight" [sic] idea. "Four-eight" [sic] stands for hand, head, heart and health development. This camp is continued for a week. The prize winners in the different projects are sent to the state camp, usually held at the university, and there compete for the degree or honor of being an all star in the project idea.

Mr. Feaster has spent eighteen years in different districts and in different types of school work. He undoubtedly has the fundamental qualities of a real educator, being an inspiring leader rather than a routine instructor. He is broadminded, keeps his mind open to new ideas and is ready to support anything that will make the schools more efficient in the training of men and women. A district "round table" provides the teachers with an opportunity to exchange views, and the twenty-three teachers of Grant District are regularly associated to their benefit in these table meetings.

Mr. Feaster was married while teaching in Minnesota, at Park Rapids, July 30, 1909. His wife was Bessie E. McIndoe. Mrs. Feaster was born in Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, daughter of James and Elizabeth (Lauer) McIndoe. Her father was born in Pennsylvania and was a Baptist minister. Mrs. Feaster was one of a family of four daughters and two sons, and during her girlhood she lived in Pennsylvania, Maryland and West Virginia, her father having pastorates in all these states. She finished

her education in the Shepherd College State Normal and Broadus Institute at Clarksburg, and for several years before her marriage was a grade teacher. Mr. and Mrs. Feaster have four children: Irene, Nellie, Marguerite and Lois. The family are Baptists and Mr. Feaster has been

active in church and Sunday school work, serving as super- intendent or class teacher in the Sunday school.

Before the Kiles had come from Rockingham, Va., George and Jacob of the Kile family were taken prisons by the Indians. Jacob was very strong and was made to carry burdens. One night he gnawed the rope open that was holding him and he released his brother. They had come back as far as the Roaring Plains when George lay down in some brush, utterly unable to proceed. Jacob went on to the blockhouse at the Mouth of Seneca, and because of his Indian costume came near being fired on by a sentry. A relief party was sent out and George brought in. During the time this Seneca Blockhouse served was used as a rallying-point, the towering cliff nearby served as a lookout.

Captain Dalton, Superintendant of Indian affairs for the United State, arrived here last week from Canada, which he left about a month since, in company with 200 Americans, who are at length happily liberated from a cruel captivity with the savages. But he is sorry to inform us that there are a number of unfortunate fellow sufferers, who are still retained as prisoners by the Indians. The sufferings of Captain Dalton and his lady have been very great, both having been many years prisoners with the enemy, and forced to endure the most cruel treatment from their captors. For the satisfaction of their friends, Captain Dalton has given a list of the unhappy people who are confined chiefly among the six nations , viz. the Shawanese, Delaware, Munseys, Ouiactenaws, Putawawtawmaws, &c. &c.

We know that the family first arrived in America between 1760 and 1776. Son Thomas was born in Scotland but fought in the Revolutionary War. During the period between 1755 and 1771, it is estimated that about 20,000 Scots immigrated to America due to serious land reforms taking place in Scotland. Mr. Richard KROUSKOP, a descendent of Caleb ORRAHUD, reported to Mrs. RI ORDAN that an elderly distant relative had found an old scrap of paper stuffed in an old

pitcher. The paper indicated that Alexander, Joshua and Thomas came to America from Scotland and had the dates 1745 and 1763. Based on Thomas' birth year, I would have to guess that the 1763 might indicate when the family arrived in America.

The family eventually settled in what then was Hampshire County, VA. The county was part of VA that became WV. The area was located in a part of Hampshire County that later became Hardy County. It is not known if this was the first area where they settled. Thomas enlisted in the Revolutionary Army in Chester County, PA. The earliest record in Hampshire County is 1782. Is it possible that the family first settled in Chester County, PA?

1. Alexander ORRAHOOD is found in the 1782 census of Hampshire County, VA. This is the earliest census of this area. Alexander is listed as the head of household of 10 whites. In the 1784 census he is listed as head of household of 9 whites with one building. Alexander ORRAHOOD was listed on the Personal Property Tax Roll for Hardy County in 1787. A land grant was issued to Alexander ARROWHOOD on May 15, 1788 for 389 acres for a compensation of two pounds sterling. Two days later a grant was issued to William NORMAN. William's land description includes "ARROWHOOD's line" and "ARROWHOOD's corner", showing that these two were neighbors. It is believed that these two families had been neighbors for quite some time and these grants were simply confirmation of ownership of lands that these two families had lived on during pre-Revolution times. In this area there is a stream named Norman's Run and it was common practice to name these streams after the first family to settle on them. The ORRAHUD land was located on a ridge between Lunice Creek between Petersburg and Maysville, VA ( WV). The land was located in Hampshire County, VA that became part of WV and then part of Hardy County, WV. On November 9, 1798, Alexander transferred 200 acres to his son Joshua. On August 2, 1800 he transferred 100 acres to his son Thomas. On August 8, 1800 the 200 acres transferred to Joshua were transferred back to Alexander. On December 3, 1800 Alexander transferred 100 acres back to Joshua.

Alexander was married to Ethalen before moving to America. If the earlier theory is correct, her maiden name might have been HUD. Alexander and Ethalen died after 1800 but before 1806. They had seven children:

- 1.1 Joshua ORRAHUD, the eldest son was born prior to 1760 in Scotland.
- 1.2 Thomas ORCHARD was born in 1760 in Scotland.
- 1.3 Caleb ORRAHUD was born about 1763 in Hampshire County, VA (WV).
- 1.4 Alexander ORRAHUD, Jr. was born in Hampshire County.
- 1.5 Nancy ORRAHUD was born in Hampshire County.
- 1.6 Ethalen ORRAHUD was born in Hampshire County.
- 1.7 Abigail ORRAHUD was born in Hampshire County.

The property Alexander owned on Lunice or Looney's or Luney's Creek (and that passed to his descendants after his death and that son Joshua became the owner of in 1806) was at one time part of Virginia. After the Civil War, of course, that property was situated in West Virginia. The same situation took place with the counties. At first it was in Hampshire County. But when the new Hardy County was formed, the Orahood property was in Hardy County. And when Grant County was formed from

part of Hardy, the Orahood property became part of the new Grant County, West Virginia.

1.2 Thomas ORCHARD (ORRAHUD) was born in Scotland in 1760. He immigrated to America with his parents as a very small child. In the spring of 1776, Thomas enlisted in the Company of John PUGH in Chester, PA. He served in the 13th Pennsylvania State Regiment of Colonel WALTER. Thomas fought in the battles of Germantown, Monmouth, Stony Point, and White Plains. From July 6, 1777 to October 27, 1777 Thomas served at Brandewine. He was discharged in 1781. When he returned home to Hampshire County, Thomas married Sarah (Sally) NORMAN, who was possibly the widow of John NORMAN who was the son of Alexander ORRAHUD's neighbor William NORMAN. Thomas and Sarah were married on March 29, 1785. Thomas is listed on the Personal Property Tax Roll for Hardy County in 1787. On February 6, 1797 William NORMAN transferred 100 acres to Thomas and on August 2, 1800 Alexander transferred 100 acres to his son Thomas. In 1804 Thomas sold 100 acres of his land to George SEYMOUR. In 1806 Thomas sold his inheritance from his father and his final 100 acres to Joseph PRATHER. About 1816, Thomas and his family joined the first movement of people westward over the Alleghany Mountains. They settled in Concord Township, Ross County, OH. On July 13, 1818, Thomas filed an application for a pension due to his military service. On his application, he stated that he had no income, one horse, four sheep, no trade and that he was too frail and infirm to work. He also stated that his property was valued at \$30 and he had a wife, five grown children and two children still at home, ages eleven and seven. He was allowed a pension. In a lawsuit filed later by a daughter on behalf of the heirs of Sarah ORAHOOD, nine children were listed. Thomas ARROWHOOD is listed in the 1820 census of Concord Twp., Ross Co., OH.

Thomas died March 26, 1844. In the 1850 census, Sarah was living with her daughter and son-in-law, Ethali and Edward Young. Sarah died December 26, 1854. Thomas and Sarah ORCHARD are buried in the Christie-Rowe-Young cemetery located about 8 miles northwest of Frankfort, Concord Township, Ross County, OH. The cemetery is now abandoned. 1.3 Caleb ORRAHUD was most likely born in Hampshire County before 1776. Sometime before 1790 he married Phoebe COBERLY (CUBBERLY). Based on her death information Phoebe was born in 1776 which means she was married at the age of 14. There are no records of Caleb owning land until 1806 when he purchased 60 acres from Jonathan WATSON. He also signed the deed on November 7, 1806 with his siblings when they sold their inheritance to Joshua. Caleb sold his 60 acres to Henson VEATCH prior to 1818 when he and Phoebe and their daughter and son-in-law moved to Ross County, OH. Sometime between 1820 and 1825, they all moved to Liberty Township, Union County, OH. After Phoebe died in 1839, Caleb and his daughter's family moved to Coles County, IL where his daughter and her husband died. Caleb ARROWHOOD is listed in the 1840 census of Coles Co., IL. Nothing further is known of Caleb except that it would appear that some of his children returned to Liberty Township, Union County, OH where descendents are living today. The list of surveys and patents given below, and dating from before 1790, has been compiled from the records of the Surveyor's office of Augusta and in the Land Office of Virginia. The name of the person for whom the tract was surveyed or patented is followed first by the number of acres, next by the year of the survey or grant, and then by a description of its location. Unless this is followed by a capital P (for patent, the tract is a survey. Otherwise, it is a patent granted in the same year. In the following list, "adj. himself" refers to a tract surveyed or patented by the person at an earlier date.

Where the Mullenax's came from is unknown, however, there are some family traditions. The most common one is of five brothers who came from Canada, settling along the east coast. Another story suggests that they fled from Ireland, while yet another claims France as their homeland. Family genealogists found a Molyneux family that settled in Nova Scotia. "The History of the Molyneux Families" by Nellie Rice Molyneux, includes the lineage of a Robert Molyneux (pronounced Mullen-nuh or Mullen-no) family. They were French Huguenots who fled to Ireland, around 1685, Robert Molyneux, left Ireland, taking his family to Prince Edward's Island in Nova Scotia. His children were supposed to have been Robert, Jr., Michael, William, James, Edward, John, Thomas, Jannette, and Sara; all born about 1665-1690. Only Robert Jr's line is carried forward. Since Robert Jr.'s brothers are not carried forward, they must have left the region. This would have five or six brothers traveling south along the east coast of North America. The children of Robert Jr. are known to have moved to New England.

This Molyneux family would explain each of our family traditions. The John Mullenax that died in Goochland County, VA. might be the same John Molyneux who was the son of Robert Sr. of Nova Scotia. At this point the connection is only speculation and will require further research.

Mullenaxes came to Highland Co. Va. and Pendleton Co. WV. in the early 1700's. They settled on North Fork and the South Branch of the Potomac River. John Mullenax and his wife came to the lower Crabbottom Valley, purchased 110 acres on Jackson's River.
