Reprints from Hendricks County Republican: July 21,1892: John White,age 80, was stricken with paralysis on the night of the 14th, and is now speechless and helpless with a hopeless outlook for his recovery. July 28,1892: John White, age 80, died of paralysis on the 17th. He leaves 11 children, 10 grandchildren, and a large number of great grandchildren. He was a member of the Methodist Church and the funeral sermon was preached by Eli P. Wells.

Notes for JAMES T. WHITE:

James was captured at Philadelphia, Loudon Co., Tennessee during the Civil war and was sent to Belle Island, Virginia where he died.

This was a small island at the west end of the City in the James River. Used as an incarceratory for enlisted men, it had a few shacks and some Sibley tents. No barracks were erected to house prisoners, they had only tents and not enough of those to go around. A hospital for prisoners and an iron factory also occupied the island. The men were allowed to swim in the river and some escaped in this manner while others drowned as the rapid water was very perilous. Cannon and rifle pits effectively discouraged many attempts of this nature. Although Belle Isle Prison was intended to hold only 3,000 men, with tents provided to house that many, by 1863, almost 10,000 men were imprisoned there. The old Richmond & Petersburg Railroad bridge to the island was called by the prisoners "Bridge of Sighs". It has long been a center of dispute. The South claimed a low death-rate; the North, a very high one.

"Stormy and disagreeable weather. From fifteen to twenty and twenty-five die every day and are buried just outside the prison with no coffins- nothing but canvas wrapped around them." So wrote captured Union soldier John Ransom in his November 27, 1863, diary entry from Belle Island

Prison. On February 11, 1864, the 20-year-old brigade quartermaster wrote that there was "a good deal of fighting going on among the men;" they were "just like so many hungry wolves penned together." Bands of predatory prisoners roamed the encampment, robbing their fellow prisoners of rations, blankets, and anything else they wanted. The commandant admitted that he could do nothing to stop the gangsters, as he had only enough men to try to prevent escapes.

All Civil War prisons were deadly and Belle Isle was no exception. "Can those be men?" was Walt Whitman's query when he saw some prisoners who had returned from Belle Isle. "Those little livid brown, ash streaked, monkey-looking dwarves? - are they not really mummified, dwindled corpses?" Civilians and soldiers alike went hungry in wartime Richmond, and the subsistence provided to the Union prisoners proved such a drain on the area's resources that most were shipped out to new and better facilities, with more food resources, in an area untouched by the war- Camp Sumter, near Andersonville, GA.

Notes for ISAAC W. WHITE:

Isaac was a Private in Co. H, 1st Kentucky Cavalry during the Civil War. He joined for duty and enrolled 14 Sep 1861 at Bradfordville for 3 Years. he mustered in at Camp Dick Robinson 28 Oct 1861 and was paid \$130.00 for furnishing his own horse and equipments. Isaac was wounded at the Battle of Wild Cat, 22 Nov 1861. He was captured at Philadelphia, Tennessee, 20 Oct 1863, confined at Richmond, Virginia, 1 Nov 1863 and on 18 Feb 1864 he was sent to Americus or Andersonville, Georgia as a prisoner of War. He was admitted to the hospital at Andersonville, Georgia, 6 April 1864 and returned to prison 24 April 1864. Isaac was paroled at Savannah, Georgia, 28 Nov 1864 and reported to Hospital Division 1, Maryland, 5 Dec 1864. Isaac was exchanged and restored to duty 20 Dec 1864. (Copy of Isaac's Military Record in Files)

On 21 July 1875, Frances Ann (Matherly) White applied for pension as widow of Isaac White.

Frances Ann Matherly's parents were Clabourn and Talitha (Inman) Matherly. They married 28 Dec 1830 Washington County KY. Frances Ann married (2) Stephen C Smith 11 Jan 1881.

1880 census, Washington County KY, Frances White has Martha and Cynthia with her. William and Sarah are with their grandfather John White. Where is Phillip Edmund? Not with Frances' parents as they are both deceased. And, what of May who is on the 1870 census? Probably deceased as not mentioned in Frances's pension application.

1850 Mercer County Kentucky census shows a Smith Christison and 1860, W. S. (perhaps William Smith) Christison. Since these two families were close, this may be

Charles was a Private in Co. H, 1st Kentucky Cavalry during the Civil War. He was captured 18 Oct 1863 at Philadelphia, Loudon Co., Tennessee and probably taken to Richmond, Virginia before being sent to Andersonville Prison in Andersonville, Georgia where he died 27 June 1864 of Anasarca (dropsy). Charles is buried at Andersonville Prison Cemetery, grave # 2584, section K.

By the winter of 1863-64 the Confederacy was near the last of its resources and manpower. Knowing this, Union General Ulysses S. Grant refused to continue the prisoner-exchange agreement that had been in operation during most of the war. This action cut down on the number of Confederate soldiers Grant's army would have to face in the coming campaign, but it also meant death to a great number of Union prisoners who would otherwise have been exchanged. The concentration of war prisoners in Richmond, Va., drained the local food supply and was a source of danger should the Yankees attack. To relieve the burden, a new prison site was selected in the heart of Georgia, near the village of Andersonville in Sumter County. The prison was officially named Camp Sumter. When the first prisoners arrived in late February 1864, they found 16.5 acres of open land enclosed by a 15 foot tall stockade. The not yet completed prison provided little in the way of housing, clothing, or medical care. The only fresh water was a stream that flowed through the prison yard, with the downstream end serving as the camp latrine. During the next few months, 400 more prisoners arrived each day, and in June the prison was expanded to 26 acres. By then there were 26,000 men enclosed in an area intended to hold 10,000. By August the prison contained more than 32,000 Union prisoners.

Conditions at Andersonville were worse than at any other war prison, North or South. The Georgia heat, along with disease, filth, exposure, and lack of adequate medical care, took a fearful toll. In September 1864, General William T. Sherman's Union army captured Atlanta and brought its cavalry within reach of Andersonville. The confederacy relocated surviving prisoners to other camps, and Camp Sumter operated as a smaller facility for the rest of the war. But the summer had taken a terrible toll: of the 45,000 Union soldiers confined at Camp Sumter, 13,000 died.

My Dad Marion F. Johnson served in the Civilian Conservation Corps from 10 June 1934 to 21 March 1935. He was in the 560th Company. He first saw service at Camp F-160, Gold Center, Clarkia, Idaho doing labor (B. R. Control) type of work which he explained was really keeping the brush under control to prevent forest fires. He has many pictures that he took while there and also had the thrill of going hunting for the first time where he bagged his first deer.

Dad next saw service at Camp P-216, Las Posadas, Angwin, California doing Brush Gang work but he explained that they planted a lot of trees. His one wish was to go back some day and see how the trees had grown. Sadly he never made it.

After giving it much thought he decided not to re-enlist and was discharged at Fort Knox, Kentucky the same place he was enrolled eight months earlier. My Dad really enjoyed his days in the CCC's.
