She married **(2) George Taylor Sheaffer**⁶ August-18-1917 in Montesano, WA⁷. He was born December-6-1881 in Los Angeles, CA⁸, and died November-14-1973 in Oakville, WA. Bur. Elma Odd Fellows Cem., Sec. 4.1⁹. He was the son of William Henry Sheaffer and Sarah Belle Henry.

Notes for Cora Sarah Bertha Langenbach:

Cora Sarah Bertha Langenbach was born in Butternut, Wisconsin in 1882, her family having moved there from Northampton County, Pennsylvania around 1880. After a few years they again moved, this time to Washington Territory, first settling in Winlock, Lewis County. Later family moves were to Kamilche, Summit, McCleary, and Malone. One of her first jobs was working in the cookhouse of a cedar shingle camp. In 1908 she married Jesse Carleton Price and resided in Oakville. After Jesse Price died in 1913, Cora worked in the Glover Hotel in Oakville. She married George Sheaffer in 1917, living in Oakville until her death in 1967.

Notes for George Taylor Sheaffer:

George Taylor Sheaffer was born in Los Angeles in 1881, where the family had settled after moving from Pennsylvania (with a short stop in Kansas). They moved to the Mendocino country of California while he was an infant. At age of 12 George went to work for a nearby dairy farmer, and shortly thereafter began a long career in logging, his first job being skidroad greaser for ox-team logging in the redwoods.

With the advent of steam donkeys in the logging industry in the late 1890's, his work changed and by 1900 he had become a "donkey puncher", an occupation he followed for over 40 years. About 1910 he travelled (by schooner) to the Grays Harbor area of Washington. Over the years he worked for Saginaw Timber Co., Union Timber Co., Polson Logging Co., and Mason County Logging Co. in Grays Harbor. In his later years he worked for Weyerhaeuser in the Longview area. George married Cora Sarah Langenbach Price in 1917 and his home was in Oakville until his death in 1973.

Notes for Michael Langenbach:

LANGENBACH Surname

The original spelling for this family name was LANGENBACH. Early 18th century maps of Germany show a number of towns named Langenbach in the Rhineland region. The people from these towns were known as Langenbacher's.

The German dictionary shows lang as meaning long or tall, and bach as meaning stream or brook.

Early recorded documents in America use the spelling LANGENBACH, or a slight variation: LANG a BACH or LANG e BACH. This includes ship arrival documents,

and early Pennsylvania church and civil records, such as George Paul LANGENBACH (1753) and John Jost LANGEBAACH (1772). Michael's surname appeared as LANGENBACH in the early church and county records obtained at the Easton Public Library, Easton, PA.

Over time, several variations of the spelling have come into common use by some family lines. LONGenbach is common in the Bethlehem, Pennsylvania area, with a Longenbach-Billheimer reunion held there annually since the early 1920's. Other common forms include LangenBAUGH, LONGenBAUGH, LONGABAUGH, etc.

Some family branches (including the Jacob Tilman line) have maintained the "original" spelling, LANGENBACH.

BIRTHPLACE

Evidence obtained Oct. 2005 confirmed my belief that George Paul and Elizabeth Langenbach were the parents of Michael. This consisted of church records from Friesburg Lutheran Church, Friesburg, NJ. He attended communion in 1772 in Moore Twp., Northampton County, PA

Michael was sponsor of Henry's daughter, 1785

Notes for Samuel Roth:

Salem's Lutheran Union Church records name "Conrad and Catharina" as parents of Samuel Roth, b. Feb. 27, 1801. This is in error, and has caused uncertainty and confusion through the years in attempting to trace lineage back beyond Samuel. I have always had strong doubts that Conrad was Samuel's father for the following reasons:

--- Names of 8 children (5 boys and 3 girls) born to Conrad and Catharina are listed in the Salem's Lutheran Union Church for the years 1776 to 1792. 9 years later (1801) the name of Samuel shows up as "son of Conrad and Catharina".

---Conrad's will (1814) identifies all 8 of the above children by name, but no Samuel.

---Conrad's will refers to "my youngest son, John", who was born 1792. (If Samuel was his son, he would have been the youngest).

---If Catharina, b. 1750, was Samuel's mother, she would have been 51 years old at the time of

his birth -- extremely unlikely.

---1810 census, Plainfield Twp., shows Conrad Roth with one male 16-26 years, none under 16.

Subsequent research has established that Samuel Roth's father was Jacob Roth, son of Conrad Roth

Samuel may have been married more than once. Maria "Polly" Magdalena is shown in Church records to be mother of Levina, b. 1827.

1850 census shows Samuel age 50 and Polly, age 46. 1860 census shows Samuel, age 59 and Elizabeth, age 40.

Data was obtained Oct. 2005 from the Friesburg Lutheran Church, Friesburg, NJ that verified my long-time conclusions that George Paul and Elizabeth Langenbach were the parents of Michael. This consisted of baptismal records for Michael and his brothers. It is apparent that the family lived in NJ for some time prior to moving to Moore Twp., Northampton County. George came to America on the ship "Richard and Mary" in 1753. First evidence I have of Michael and his brothers in Moore Twp. is 1772

Evidence obtained in Nov. 2005 lists the birth of another son, Ernest Jacob to George Paul and Elizabeth who was baptized July 14, 1754, records at Germantown Reformed Church. I have no further information on this son.

Notes for Margaretha Charles:

Margaretha Charles - notes

An unconfirmed story exists, and has appeared on websites, regarding the ancestral history of Margaretha Charles. This version portrays Margaretha (b. 1775), and John Charles (b. 1778), as brother and sister, whose parents were Garrett Fitzgerald and Maria Diebel. The story then becomes confusing in relating that (1) Garrett was beheaded in 1778 in Ireland during political uprisings, or (2), Garrett came to America to avoid political persecutions (prior to 1775) where Margaretha and John were born, and (3), birthplace of John Charles is variously listed as Ireland or Pennsylvania. Apparently in America John, Margaretha and Maria Diebel changed their name to "Charles".

The verifiable facts are:

- Margaretha and her husband, John Billheimer, sponsored the baptism of John Charles' son, Simon
15 Nov. 1812, recorded in Salem Lutheran and Reformed church records, Moorestown, PA.
- This fact lends credibility to John and Margaretha being siblings.
- 1850 Federal census, Luzerne county, PA. lists John Charles (who moved there from Northampton county in early 1800's) "Place of Birth, Pennsylvania".
 - 1870 Federal census, Northampton county, Moore Twp. entries for John, Christian and Samuel Billheimer, sons of Margaretha and John Billheimer, indicate that their "mother was not foreign born".
 - Burial records for Salem Lutheran and Reformed church, Moorestown, list Maria Diebel Charles,
1754-1849.

Summary - the above facts indicate:

- (1) John and Margaritha Charles were probably brother and sister and both born in Pennsylvania
- (2) Maria Diebel Charles was quite possibly their mother, but this needs verification
- (3) "facts" about Garrett Fitzgerald and his relationship to this have yet to be clarified and verified.

-- Jacob Roth (my 5th grandfather), came to America on the ship "Dragon", arriving at Philadelphia Sept. 26, 1749. This ship had "Foreigners from Palatinate and Zwiebrucken". A friend, George Hartlieb, was a fellow passenger on this voyage from Germany.

-- Jacob settled in Plainfield Twp., Northampton Co., and his son Conrad was born August 27, 1752. His god-father was Conrad Bittenbender.

--The names of Jacob Roth, George Hartlieb, and Conrad Bittenbender all appear on the list of settlers who were assigned to various "Frontier Forts of PA" (Northampton County)during the 1750-1760 period.

--Jacob Roth and Bittenbender were both killed in an Indian attack May 2, 1757, in Hamilton Twp., Monroe County, PA. Account of this incident is related in a book "Frontier Forts of PA", by Thomas Lynch Montgomery, 1916. Excerpt from this book appears in RootsWeb, PANORTHA-L Archives.

-- After the death of Jacob Roth, George Hartlieb was appointed guardian of Conrad (age 5) and his siblings, by the Orphan's Court, Northampton County.

-- Anna Elizabeth Roth, "widow of Jacob Roth, who was killed by the Indians beyond Blue Mountains", returned to Moore Twp. She remarried Sept. 8, 1758 to George Stolze.
