### "THE CASTERLINE FAMILY

There is a tradition handed down in the family, that Francis Casterline settled near Franklin or Union when his son Francis was ababe and carried in his mother's arms. This prople father died Dec. 12, 1768, at the age of 96 years, and the child Frances died 1796 at the age of 106 years, placing date of settlement at 1690, and also stated that they came from France about 1690, sich would give the location of first settlement.

Francis who died in 1796, had three wives and twenty-six children. The records as far as known give Abraham, Amariah, Jacob, Stephen, Benjamin, Samuel, Francis [3], Phebe, James and Joseph.

Joseph was born June 10, 1736, married Susannah Lyon, May 16, 1772, had eleven children; married Peninah Searing, Mar. 24, 1799, had ten children. He died Apr. 18, 1832 and was buried at Rockaway. Of the brothers of Joseph but little is known, it is probable that they married and removed West. Children, 1st wife, Daniel, married, Elizabeth---, had son Joseph, born May 26, 1798, died at Dover, Nov. 26, 1882, buried a Berkshire Valley; Albert, born 1808, died Nov. 8, 1896, buried at Rockaway, and others. Ezekiel, Levi, Joseph, James, John, married Nancy daughter of William and Amy (Smith) Kirk, Oct. 21, 1810, died Mar. 7, 1812. She was born Dec. 18, 1793, died Nov. 13, 1878, both buried at Rockaway. Sarah; Susan, married Stephen Freeman; Hannah, married (1) Thomkins (2) Harris; Phebe and Huldah. Second wife, Peninah Searing, was born July 27, 1779, died at a dwelling a few yards north of Union Chapel, Feb. 21, 1862, buried at Rockaway. She was daughter of William and Peninah (Burnett) Searing, the seventh daughter of the seventh daughter, and possessed great healing power by the "laying ou" of hands. William Searing died 1804.

Mrs Harriet E. Casterlin died at the home of her son S.V., as Ionia, January 12, where she had been very sick for some time. She was born March 8, 1812, at Dover, Morris county, N.J., her maiden name being Lyon. At 18 years of age she was married to C.S. Casterlin in Lenawee county, N.Y. They came to Michigan and settled in Mason in 1869, which has been her home ever since. She united with the M.E. church about 50 years ago and her funeral is held at the M.E. church in this city today, Rev. Urch Officiating. She was the mother of Chalon L. and Chas C. Casterlin of this city, and Dexter Casterlin of Charlotte, and S.V. Casterlin of Ionia, who are attending her funeral as is also Carrie Eaton of Jackson. Her remains will rest in Mason cemetery. All respect her.

Mrs. Harriet E. Casterlin was born March 8th, 1812, at Dover, Morris county, N.J., her maiden name being Lyon. At 18 years of age

she was married to C.S. Casterlin in Seneca county, N.Y. They came to Michigan and settled in Mason in 1869, which has been her home ever since. She united with the M.E. church over 50 years ago and her funeral was held at the M.E. church in this city last Thursday, Rev. Urch officiating. She was the mother of Chalon L. and Chas C. Casterlin of this city, and Dexter A. Casterlin of Ionia, and who attended her funeral, as also Carrie Eaton of Jackson and W.A. and Carrie Bray of Albion. She also leaves J.B. Casterlin of Eureka, Cal., John A. Casterlin of Ithaca, N.Y. and Nancy Metcalf of Romulus, N.Y. Her remains were interred in the Mason cemetery. All respect her.

One of Harriet's younger brothers, Chalon Lyon, named his first daughter Harriet Elizabeth, most likely after his sister. Harriet named one of her sons Chalon after her brother. It is my estimation that Harriet's middle name is Elizabeth.

"C. C. CASTERLIN. The divine spark in man is at no time so apparent as in one who, in early life, lacking the prestige that fortune gives and the advantages and tastes that fortune call foster, rises above the barriers that stop the way and with a will to become as great as is in the power of the man to be, he sets his mark high, and in the roundness of his being is reflected the power of the Omnipotent; as Durzhaven expresses it: "But Thy presence shines in me as shines the sunbeam in a drop of dew." Our subject from earliest childhood was thrown upon his own resources and the fiber that he, is well as his brothers, was made of is shown by the fact that they earned their own way, and not only supplied themselves with the necessities of life, but sanctified their intelligence by also acquiring excellent educations.

Our subject was born in Seneca County, N.Y. October 24, 1850. He is a son of Charles S. and Harriet E. (Lyon) Casterlin, natives of New Jersey. Of a family of nine children, he of whom we write was the seventh in order of birth. All of the children obtained good educations by their own exertions, four of them graduating at Ovid, N.Y., at the East Genesee Conference Seminary, and five afterward becoming teachers. He of whom we write was but sixteen years of age when he began the business of teaching, which calling he followed six years, after which he came to Michigan, locating in Clare County. His worth soon made itself felt in the community, and his ability as a man and scholar was apparent. He was elected Registrar of Deeds, in which capacity he served the county for two terms. The succeeding two terms he filled the office of County Clerk, and in 1875 was admitted to the bar, and was Prosecuting Attorney for one term.

Mr. Casterlin has filled most of the local offices, having served as Supervisor, Justice of the Peace, Alderman, Assessor, and in other minor offices. In 1880 he was candidate for the State Legislature on the Democratic ticket, and with a Republican majority of over eight hundred in the district, he came within one hundred and thirty of being elected, a fact that in itself must be gratifying to any man with an ambition for public life, for the conditions of this failure foretell future success. Had it been left to his own county he would have been elected to the Legislature but in an adjoining county he was less well known, and hence the defeat. Although his township and village were both largely Republican, he was never defeated in them when a candidate for office.

Feeling that it is not good for man to be alone, our subject took unto himself a wife and companion. Their marriage was solemnized December 28, 1875, the bride being Miss Hattie W. Kittredge, the only daughter of Rev. Hosea and Mary B. (Daggett) Kittredge. She was born at Palmyra, N.Y., December 12, 1860. Her father was a native of Muir, and her mother of Palmyra, N.Y. The original of our sketch has not only made the struggle of life successfully for himself, but has been instrumental in helping the younger members of his family to good and profitable positions.

In 1881 the gentleman of whom we write removed to Mason, and since that time he has not engaged in the practice of his profession. He owns property in various parts of this and other States; and his care of this occupies the greater portion of his time and attention. Three children have come to bless the union of Mr. Casterlin and his amiable and attractive wife. They are C. Gay, Earl H. and Don M. D. The eldest child was born February 10, 1877, at Farwell, Clare County, this State. Earl H. was born May 31, 1884, in Mason, and Don made his advent into the world March 4, 1888. He of whom we write is a Democrat in his political preference and has ever taken an active interest in local politics as well as having watched attentively and thoughtfully the trend of national political life. He has been appointed Chairman of the Democratic County Committee, which place he has filled for the last six years, and has dignified the chair by the manliness and intelligence brought to bear upon the question of State government. He has been a delegate to nearly all of the important Democratic conventions. He is also a member of various secret societies, especially those that purport to be for the fellowship and aid of men.
