### Notes for DAVID ALLEN, JR.:

Mr. Allen died at his home near Broadwell, KY (eight miles from Cynthiana, near Cynthiana and Leesburg Turnpike) after a long illness. For several years he had been an invalid suffering from paralysis, ministered to by the loving hands of his numerous children and grand children. He was one of the pioneer citizens of KY. Born in 1805, he spent his long and useful life in the neighborhood, loved and respected by all. He was a honest man and an upright citizen. His funeral was at the family residence and conducted by Rev. W.W. Chamberlain.

By a singular coincidence the text selected, 1 Thessalonians 4, 13 had the following marked in the margin of his bible. "Used at mother's funeral by Rev. Merritt." In his remarks, the Rev. Chamberlain paid high tribute to the Christian character of the deceased whom he had known for 40 years. The Rev. J.T. Sharrard assisted in the funeral services and he contrasted the condition of society and Harrison County when Mr. Allen was born and when he died, drawing from it the superior advantages and added responsibilities of those he had left behind. He also mentioned that Mr. Allen had raised a family large enough to start a world, being just the number saved in the ark. The funeral procession to the Jacksonville Cemetery was a long one.

He was owner of 300 acres of good land and a member of the Methodist Church at Pleasant Green.

A. J. SKILLMAN, farmer; P. O. Cane Ridge; proprietor of Walnut Grove Farm; is a son of John W. Skillman (whose sketch appears in this work); born November 24, 1834, on Cane Ridge, where he has since resided, coming to his present home in February, 1858. He received a limited education, then engaged in farm work with his father, and spent a short time near Decatur, Illinois, returning home in July and on the following September 26, 1856, he was married to Miss Julia Allen, of Harrison County, and daughter of David and Ellen (Berry) Allen; he a native of Bourbon County, where he spent his early manhood, then moved to Harrison, where he afterward became a prominent farmer and stock raiser of that county. By this marriage there have been ten children, a son and daughter died in infancy. Those living are: John A., born July 17, 1857, David Clay, December 8, 1858; Harvey A., January 22, 1860; Charles M., April 22, 1864; Benjamin F., February 15, 1866; I. B., January 7, 1871; Wm. F., July 1, 1873; Hattie S., July 4, 1879. Mr.

Skillman is an industrious and enterprising farmer. A conservative democrat politically and with his wife a member of the Cane Ridge Church. [Skillman

The funeral took place at his residence on the Silas Road in Harrison County and was conducted by the Rev. W.E. Ellis. Burial was at Jacksonville Cemetery. The pall bearers were: H.C. Chinn, R.L. Abernathy, D.C. Lisle, Frank May, James Thompson, R.S. Willmot. Honorary pall bearers: P.P. Cummins, R.J. Lucas, J.L. Burgess, J. Newt. Ammerman. The surviving sisters were Mrs. J. Newt. Ammerman, Mrs. R.S. Willmot, Mrs. Sarah Burgess. Mrs. Andy Skillman; the brothers were David and Clay Allen.

He was the son of David Allan, Jr. Mr Allen was a gentleman of strict integrity and high standing. He had followed farming as his occupation all of his life, and had been successful in every way. He was a member of the Leesburg Christian Church.

In the civil war he served as a private in the Confederate Army. He was in Company H, Second Regiment Cavalry. He enlisted September 1, 1862. Later transferred to Co. E on October 15, 1862.

He is buried in the David Allen, Jr. lot. However there is no tombstone.

Miss. Allen died at her home (the Bush Rod Allen farm on the Silas Rd. near Leesburg , KY). She had been ill a short time. The funeral services were held at the grave in the Jacksonville cemetery. Services were conducted by the Rev. W.G. Montgomery. The pall bearers were: Lyman and Frank Allen, Kirtly McDaniel, Irvin Etter, Joe Allen Sparks and Milton Allen. The R.P. Blair undertaking establishment was in charge of the funeral.

Miss. Allen died at her home (the Bush Rod Allen farm on the Silas Rd.) near Leesburg, after an illness of two months. The funeral services were held at the Whaley Funeral Home in Cynthiana, KY and conducted by the Rev. Lewis Foster, pastor of the Leesburg Christian church. Burial was in the family lot in Jacksonville cemetery. Pall bearers were Kirtly McDaniel, Irvin Etter, I.B. Skillman, Lyman, Frank and Henry Clay Allen.

She was born in Harrison County and spent her entire life in the neighborhood in which she died. She had lived quietly, giving time and devotion to her family, and had many friends who were saddened by her passing. She never married.

The personal property sold at a public sale at the farm on Friday, March 10, 1944 at 10:00 A.M. Examples of items are: Cherry bedroom suite (spool bed), cherry drop leaf tables, cherry trundle bed, elegant cherry sideboard, (all above are rare antiques). Dishes of all kinds, etched amber glasses, old vases and pictures, chairs, old hickory straight-back and other antiques ones. C.M. McDaniel was the administrator for the estate.

The original land of Bush Rod Allen was inherited by his four children. The tract allotted to Lula D. Allen (46.15 acres) was inherited by her two brothers and one sister. The same tract of land was inherited by the two brothers after Ella's death. The brothers sold the land to Alvin's son Frank and his wife Fenton for a some of \$10,614.50 on the 20th day of April, 1944. Frank Allen and his wife Fenton sold the land to Albert and Nannie Johnson on the 12th day of March, 1945.

Mr. Allen, a retired farmer, died at a Lexington hospital after a stay of 10 days. Death was attributed to heart trouble. He had been ill for the past 6 months. He was born in Harrison county. The funeral services were conducted at the Whaley funeral home in Cynthiana with Rev. T.J. Mattingly in charge of the service. Interment was in Battle Grove Cemetery with the following selected as pall bearers: Frank and Henry Allen, Kirtley McDaniel, Conrad Anderson,

Earl May and Irvin Etter.

He was a member of the Cynthiana Christian Church, having affiliated himself with the denomination when he joined the Leesburg Christian Church during his youth.

J. M. BOYER, farmer, P. O. Connersville. Among the early settlers of Harrison County was Jacob Boyer. He was a great usefulness in his day, and dying left a son named John, who married, and the union producing J. M. Boyer, the subject of this sketch, in 1845. His parents dying when he was five years old, he underwent an orphanage, and has had to struggle for a place in life. How well he has succeeded will be understood when we tell that he now is the owner of 337 acres of land two and one-half miles northeast of Connersville, handsomely improved, and fine productive soil. He married Miss Sarah E. Allen, daughter of David

Allen, of Harrison County. By this union they have eight living children, viz: Mary E., Johnnie, Alice C., Perry David, Jacob, Emma; Mattie died in 1877; Allen and Sarah E. He and his wife are worthy and consistent members of the Christian Church at Leesburg. He affiliates with the Democratic party, and as an evidence of the confidence and esteem in which he is held by his neighbors, he was made, and served in the office of Treasurer of the Grange of which he was a member for a long time.

He was a pall bearer at the funeral of David Allen, Sr. in 1892

Frankie's recipe for Chicken Casserole.

6 slices of bread (crust cut off)

1 lb. cooked chicken of turkey  
1/2 lb. cheese  
1/2 stick melted margarine  
1/2 teasp. dry mustard  
1/2 teasp. salt  
3 whole eggs  
1 pint milk

Break up slices of bread. Put 1/2 of it in casserole dish (I use 9 x 13 inch dish). Arrange 1/2 of the chicken over it. Add 1/2 of the broken cheese. Then add the rest of chicken, bread, and sliced cheese.

Beat well the eggs, mustard, salt, and milk and also pour over mixture. Let sit overnight, Bake at 350 degrees. until done.
