The two children of William (jr)and wife Eleanor Carney were said to have come to America with their Uncle Alexander Kinnear.

KINNEAR NOTES:

From Sir Robert Sibbald's history of Fife:

KINNEAR NAME:

"The name is Celtic, and means East Hill or East Height. It was originally used by Symon de Hameel who was granted a tract of land about ten miles northwest of St. Andrews in Fife, Scotland, on which there was a hill, long known by its Celtic name, Kin [height] and Ear [east]. Symon was the son of Michael de Hameel who had arrived from Normandy around the year 1070. His son, Allary, built a castle and his younger brother, William, became its first laird and was known as William de Kiner sometime in the 12th century. The spelling of the name seems to have changed gradually over the centuries through de Kyner, deKynner, Kynere, Kynnere, Kynneir, Kinneir, from the 1300s to the 1700s. There were also variations of this spelling, but Kinnear seems to have become fairly standard by the 1800s. The Edinburgh Scotsman says that Kinnear is an old Fife name derived from the lands of Kinnear near Kilmany, that there was a David Kinnear on the family estate in 1650, and in 1550 there was an Abbot Kinnear of Balmerinoch.

She had two daughters named in her will; one was the illegitimate daughter of Stephen SUTTON, the other I will list here as the daughter of Alexander KINNEAR.

Further Details of Death of Kinnears in El Dorado Received

Husband and Wife Died from Escaping Gas; Coroner and Relative are Also Overcome

Mr. and Mrs. John M(sic) Kinnear who on the morning of January 14 were found dead in their home in El Dorado, Kansas, the same day that the death of Lou G. Kinnear, of this city occurred.

The tragedy was due to escaping gas which was used in the home as fuel. So strong was the accumulation of it that the coroner, Edward S. Turner, and Mrs. Kinnear's sister, Mrs. Albert Rosenfield, were overcome 45

minutes after they entered the house to make investigation. They were somewhat better in the afternoon, but were still seriously ill from the effects.

A fire burning very low in the stove. Presumably it was not consuming all the gas. The gas company officials say that the stove was properly adjusted, but that some lint may have gathered in it.

Surviving Mr. and Mrs. Kinnear are her sister, Mrs. Rosenfield of Rock Island, ILL. and two of his brothers: W. W. Kinnear and Charles E. Kinnear of Bartlesville, Oklahoma. Mr. Kinnear was in early life a resident of Franklin. In May 1914 he removed from Bridgeport, ILL. to Kansas. He was employed by the Skelly Oil Gas Co. The double funeral took place on Thursday of last week at Muncie, Indiana.

Mr. and Mrs. John F. (sic) Kinnear were found dead in their homes on Monday, January 12, 1925, after he had not reported to work for 2 days. The coroner, W. E. Turner said they had been dead since Friday night from gas fumes. Mr. Kinnear would have been 57 years old had he lived until next April. Mrs. Kinnear was slightly younger. They had been married about 14 years. They came here about 1914 and Mr. Kinnear worked as foreman of a roustabout gang for the Empire Gas & Fuel Co. They came here from Bridgeport, ILL.

LOU G. KINNEAR Dies as Message Arrives Telling of Death of Mr. and Mrs.

J. B. KINNEAR.

A Telegram was received by relatives here Monday stating that Mr. and Mrs. John B. Kinnear had been found dead in their home at El Dorado, Kansas, but no details were given.

A brother Lou G. Kinnear, aged 53, the well-known well-shooter, died at his home here at about the time the message was received. The circumstances present an unusual coincidence.

Another brother, Robert Kinnear, of Patchel Run, was killed in the nitro-glycerine explosion in which six met death at Semple's Corners on New Year's Day, 1924.

L. G. Kinnear died at 9:15 o'clock, Monday morning, at his residence, 317 2nd St. He had been ill since the death of his brother, Robert, and since August had been unable to be up town. He was confined to his bed, however, only a week.

Mr. Kinnear was born April 22, 1872 in Harmony, Butler Co. He lived nearly all of his life in and near Franklin and followed the occupation of oil well shooter. As such he was well known to everybody in the city and all the surrounding section. He was a member of the Loyal Order of Moose.
