Notes for EUGENE OWEN MCSWEENEY:

ACCORDING TO THE HISTORY OF PICKFORD AREA PIONEER FAMILIES, 1972

Owen (Eugene) Sweeney was born in Ireland in 1824. He married Mary Green in Ireland and from there they moved to England. Six children were born to them: Patricia, Mary, Dennis, John, James and Richard. Dennis and Patricia died before they came to this country. Richard and Mary died before reaching adulthood. They came to New York and from there to Sault Ste. Marie. They came by boat from the Soo, the Northern Belle, and landed at Stirlingville where they homesteaded a farm now owned by Sam Ordiway.

TAKEN OFF HIS WILL

IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN.

I, Owen Sweeney of the Township of Pickford, County of Chippewa and State of Michigan, being of sound mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this my last WILL and TESTAMENT in manner following, that is to say;

FIRST: I give and bequeath to my wife Mary Sweeney fifty dollars, also the sum of seventy dollars per year during her life time as here inafter provided to be accepted and received by her in lieu of dower.

SECOND: I give and devise to my son James Sweeney the east half of the north west quarter of Section twenty-nine (29) Town 44 N.R. 1 East, upon the express condition that he shall pay Mary Sweeney, his mother the sum of twenty dollars per year during her life time, according to the terms of a certain agreement bearing date of September the 16th 1891.

THIRD: I give and devise all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate of every name and nature whatsoever to John Sweeney my son, to have and to hold the same, his heirs and assigns forever, upon the express condition that he shall pay or cause to be paid to Mary Sweeney, his mother, the sum of fifty dollars per year, payable annually during her life time.

FOURTH: I give and bequeath to my son James, one cow, to my son John the remainder of my personal property.

LASTLY, I do hereby nominate and appoint GEORGE WATSON and WILLIAM MURPHY to be executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty third day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety five. OWEN SWEENEY x his mark.

#### ANOTHER OLD SETTLER GONE

#### OWEN MCSWEENEY PASSED AWAY MONDAY, AGED 87 YEARS

Owen McSweeney, one of the first settlers of Pickford Township, died at his home in Stirlingville on Monday at the ripe old age of 87 years. Mr. McSweeney was born in Ireland in 1824, and came to this country and settled here when this was almost an unbroken forest. He was well liked and respected by all who knew him for his kind acts and benevolent characteristics. He is survived by a widow and two sons, John and James, both of this community. Several children have preceded the father to the grave. The funeral services were held from the Donaldson Catholic Church, of which the deceased was a devout member, yesterday morning at 10:30 o'clock and burial was in the cemetery at that place.

#### SETTLEMENT OF STIRLINGVILE BY ELLEN (HILL) STEVENSON

It was a solemn group which sat deeply engaged in serious conversation in a Staynor living room. One subject seemed dominant in the course of conversation; it was the plauibility of moving to Michigan.

Mr. Parker, who already had been to Michigan, slapped the knee of his neighbor and exclaimed, "It's true! One hundred and sixty acres of homestead land for sixteen dollars."

"Sixteen dollars!" rejoined Mr. Eveleigh."

That's right, one hundred sixty acres of good, fertile, level land for sixteen dollars, continued Mr. Parker.

This fired the enthusiam of many of the listeners and in a few brief days a small group of men boarded the boat for Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan. when they arrived in the town of Sault Ste. Marie, it was still a distance of thirty miles, which had to be made on foot.

The company left Sault Ste. Marie when the sun was high in the sky. It was soon unanimously agreed that the night should be spent at a farmhouse which was less then ten miles from the final destination. The course followed from the town was only a trail as they wanted the shortest route. By using the compass they were not afraid of going astray as they knew the land lay straight south of Sault Ste. Marie.

Late in the afternoon, instead of finding a farmhouse, the weary and footsore travelers found a rather forlorn and dilapidated log hut long deserted by trappers along the river.

Soon a fire was burning brightly outside the cabin door. The hungrey men busied themselves by toasting their roast beef sandwiches and heating the sweetened black coffee. Meanwhile, the conservation was ventured around the good, fertile, level land, one hundred sixty acres for sixteen dollars.

The bed for the night, which was on the floor, was as hard and uncomfortable as Jacob's pillow. The men were awakened to a beautiful and Serene morning and were again on their way before the sun could destroy the freshness of the night, so anxious were the searchers to find the 'dream land'.

At ten o'clock the men, who had been following the river, sighted their destination and were soon scattering in various directions in search of favorable homesteads.

Late that evening found the same men in Sault Ste. Marie's courthouse paying their dollar to secure the title to the described land.

The same men held the floor as they related tales of adventure bubbling with enthusiasm for the new land to the mother and family. Many a Mother's heart felt pangs of homesickness as she also realized the debt of devotion she owed the husband.

The next few weeks were filled with preparation necessary to move to Michigan.

The Monday morning of the ninth of June 1876, found the several families bidding tearful farewells to loved ones that starting in wagons for Michigan. Traveling by oxen was slow and boresome. The first night had to be spent in Sault Ste. Marie. Early the next morning the long, cumbersome journey was resumed. many grew weary riding up hill, down hill, and over the jolting corduroy.

After several hours of this continuous jolting a shout of "Home! Home!" was heard. All crowded and pushed to the front stretching and straining to get the first glimpse of the new land which was to be home.

Though there was no mansion to greet the housewives was a relief to dismount from the wagon and help put up the temporary home, a canvas tent.

The next month found the men engaged in constructing log homes and clearing land for cultivation.

The homes of the Everleigh's, Murphey's, Campbell's, Hill's, Warren's, McKenzie's, Fleming's, Dodd's, Hannah's, Gray's, Sweeney's, and Jolly's were soon under construction.

Mr. Jolly whose homestead was on the other bank of the Munoscong River, could be heard singing and whistling as he constructed a boat to be used to transfer passengers across the stream. No pay was asked for the service only a pleasant smile and a cheerful disposition.

Mr. Jolly's influence was soon known in the community and as a result the new settlement was called Jolly's Landing.

The new log homes with the scooped roofs had crude homemade furnishings. Tallow was burned for lights, others used a saucer with a little rag soaked in tallow to give light. The smoke from those, thought almost smothering, had to be endured.

Before the winter months came a Mr. Stirling, who owned a steamer called the Southern Belle, erected a small frame store on the river bank. The river was frozen over in winter so that expeditions to the town of Sault Ste. Marie had to be made on the ice by foot.

Transportation was mainly on foot or by oxen and a jumper. An ax and an auger were always a necessary part of the equipment. If a runner was broken the ax and auger were needed to cut a tree and bore a hole to fit the spike.

Funeral services for John McSweeney, prominent Pickford Township farmer who died last Saturday were held this morning at the Barbeau Catholic Church. Burial was at the Donaldson Cemetery.

Mr. McSweeney had been failing in health for two years and his death resulted from a complication of diseases. He is survived by his widow, on the farm near Stirlingville; two sons Eugene and William both of Stirlingville and one daughter Mrs. Nellie Fallon of Schenectady, New York. He also leaves a brother James McSweeney of the Sault.

Coming to this country when a youth Mr. McSweeney established a farm near Pickford. His farm was one the largest and most modern in the county and he was widely known.

He was described as a quiet person who ate venison regularly. He used to own a dance hall, which is now a grain storage place. People brought their own liquor. Apparently John Dillinger's Lieutenant named Hamilton used to come to the hall. People would stay away from him. Hamilton was later found in a gravel pit near Chicago with over 100 bullet holes in him.

He and his wife had German WWII POW's working on their farm. They owned quite a bit of land at one time and almost lost it during the depression.

If he wanted a particular item such as a new wood stove he would become a dealer in that merchandise to receive the stove either discounted or for free.

His father John came over from Ireland. John was 16 when he bought his farm.

He was known for his generosity in helping other people out. He owned a Case and Massey Ferguson Tractor dealership in Pickford. The dealership is still there.

#### RECOLLECTIONS BY AARON V. SWEENEY, 8-17-03

One time the family went to pick blueberries. He went with his Dad and Richard with his mother. His Dad took him to a place that sold blueberries for \$1 a crate (16 qts./crate). They bought two crates and brought them home. Mother was surprised to see all the berries spread out over the table (they hid the crates). When asked, Dad stated they picked them. Noone was ever the wiser.

Aaron, Richard and their mother Ada were picking berries when Aaron was around 4 years old. They noticed that their father's grocery store in Stirlingville had caught fire. The store was destroyed. His father then went into farming. He bought an unused methodist church and lowered the roof, making a home out of it.

At one time on the farm they had 13 men staying in a bunk house across the road from their house.

His grandmother Ada was a religious Catholic convert. She had a strong will and made most of the family decisions.

She went to her priest in Barbeau and decided the church needed new carpet. She told the priest he was going to buy new carpet, she picked out the style and color and told him that is what he was ordering. She then gave him the money for the carpet.

She cooked everything in a pressure cooker.

German POW's working on her farm feared her, but enjoyed her cooking.

(editor's note) The only thing I remember about her was that she had two black felt throw pillows with the Mackinac Bridge sewn on them. I also remembering going to her funeral.

She was driving her vehicle with her daughter Mary Ethel and went off the road. She jerked the vehicle back across the road and then lost control and rolled over. Mary Ethel was ejected and the vehicle rolled over her killing her.

He recalls that when he was in infantry school in the military his grandmother showed up at his Army base and demanded to see him. When the soldier advised her that he was out in the "field" training and would not be able to come see him, she not only re-demanded that she see him, but also would see the soldier's supervisor! The soldier told his superior what had transpired. When he looked at the grandmother he told the soldier to get Eugene out of the field and that he would not see her. Eugene was able to spend a few hours visiting his grandmother. They went to the px.

Ethel Sweeney, nine year old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Eugene Sweeney of Stirlingville, near Pickford, was fatally injured at noon today when a car driven by her mother turned over and crushed her. Mrs. Sweeney and Ethel were driving in the family car along a country road a mile south of Stirlingville, according to Sheriff J. Willard Welsh, who investigated Mrs. Sweeney turned her head momentarily to glance at some

men working in the field and at that instant the car went into a ditch.

In attempting to bring the car out of the ditch, Mrs. Sweeney "cramped" the front wheels so that they dug deeply into the earth and the car lunged sharply across the road and into the ditch on the other side, turning over at the same time. Apparently the door had opened and the child was flung out, the car falling on her and crushing her.

Men working in the field, Harvy and Howard Pennington, tried to raise the car but were not able to. They brought up a tractor and with a chain succeeded in extricating the girl, who spoke only a word or so before she died.

Dr. Cummings of Pickford was called and the body was removed to the Quinell undertaking home at Pickford.

Kidney Transplant Successful

When they wheeled him into surgery for a kidney transplant, Donald R. McSweeney, weighed only 112 pounds. that was last July 12 at University Hospital, Ann Arbor. Today the six-foot, two-inch McSweeney, of 4152 Detroit, Dearborn Heights, weighs 174 pounds. Since January 10, he has been back in uniform as a plant security

guard, making the rounds at the Riopelle Parts Department of Cadillac Motor Division. The 37-year-old victim of kidney disease received the life-saving gift of a kidney from his mother, 54-year-old Lucille (Mrs. Fred) White of Gaylord.

It was six years ago that McSweeney experienced the first symptoms of his illness - glomerulonephritis! The disease gradually destroys the kidneys' ability to function. 9-1957 He took over as Captain of the Vacationland.

11-1957 After the Mackinac Bridge was built he left the boat and became a garage foreman for State Highway Department.

1960 He became a Super intendant for Highway Department.

1-5-1980 He retired after 42 years of service with the State of Michigan.

#### LETTER WRITTEN TO SHAWN SWEENEY BY JERRY CRONAN,

Dear Sean, you being the clan Sweeney historian so to speak, I wanted to share a few memories about your grandfather. Life does not permit us to have re-runs, so the last picture of our grandparents is the one we usually remember. Let me take you back a little. I first knew him in 1946 as Mickey. Over the years as ship mates we all came to know him variously as Mickey, the Irishman, the Old-Man or Capt. What ever the name, he was well like and respected by everyone in the fleet. Sailors down through the ages have depended on nicknames to quickly identify crew members. There may be several in a crew named Bill, but when you asked for "Stoneface" there was no mistaking the person you meant. Your grandfather will remember; Baldy, Bones, Auger-leg (he was hurt in an accident), Cesspool (worked in the galley), Little Job and the Toad, just to name a few.

The captain was referred to as the Old-Man, not meant to imply disrespect.

One memory I have of your grandfather is in uniform, with gold braid and gold buttons, going from the car deck up three flights of stairs two at a time-with little loss of breath-to the pilot house, oblivious to the ladies heads he always turned along the way.

Everyone in the fleet knew about your grandfather's green sweater. (If he still has it get it bronzed.) He always wore it when he went before the Marine Inspector to sit for a renewal or extension of his pilot's license or master's license. The officer in charge was another Irishman, my father. It's gospel that the "little people" made the green sweater and all Mickey had to do was show up in the sweater and he would pass any examination. But, of course, he was always well prepared. Other mates and captains tried in vain to borrow the magic sweater.

The so called captains of industry and others are sheltered and insulated in their decision making by staff and attorneys. The ship's captain on the other hand, must stand ready to put his profession, his ship and crew on the line, in a heart beat, day after day.

I have watched your grandfather, dead calm, handle his ship in horrible weather conditions of wind, current, ice and visibility over which he had no control, and he made it all look like a stroll in the park. You could add a little genuflect to your respect for him. He was one of the best.

The Vacationland finally had the ship's master that carried the respect of every crew member.

Aaron "Mickey" Sweeney, 88, of Kincheloe and St. Ignace died Friday morning, May 27, 2005 at Mackinac Straits Hospital Long Term Care. He was born April 27, 1917 in Stirlingville and grew up in the Barbeau area.

He is the last captain from the ferry boats which crossed the Straits of Mackinac before the bridge. His parents were Eugene Richard and Ada Alice (Gray) Sweeney.

He married Eleanor Morrow on October 17, 1940 in Dafter Township, near Barbeau. She died March 17, 2000. They lived in St. Ignace until retirement, and moved to Kincheloe in 1996, on the golf course, where he played daily.

He was an avid hunter and faithful member of Holy Family Catholic and also St. Ignatius Loyola Catholic

Church in St. Ignace.

He started work on the ferries on August 15, 1938. He was a deck hand on the Munising and the Cheboygan. He wheeled on the Cheboygan and the Petoskey, after being involved in the christening, and earned his "AB" in 1940. He made 3rd Mate in 1945, 2nd Mate in 1950, and was 1st Mate on the Vacationland in 1951. He took the Vacationland on trial runs during the building at River Rouge in the fall of 1950, and brought her up to St. Ignace in January 1951. He was Alternate Captain, during Capt. Nelson's absence, then served as Full Captain.

In November 1957, he transferred to the State of Michigan Highway Dept. as Garage Foreman, and retired in 1980 as Superintendent for the Highway Department after 42 years of service to the State of Michigan.

Survivors include his seven children: Eugene (Kathy) of Marquette, Dennis of Marquette, Richard of St. Ignace, Robert (Maureen) of St. Ignace where he made his home the past nearly two years, Kathleen (Joe) Giannunzio of Redmond, Wash., Mary (Rob) Mumford of Hanville, Wash., Cynthia (Mark) McGuire of Lake Stevens, Wash.; 12 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Richard J., and two sisters: Edith and Ethel.

#### RECOLLECTIONS BY JOE GIANNUNZIO ABOUT AARON V. SWEENEY

Hi Everyone,

When on the plane back to Seattle, memories kept flowing in from the past, of my Father in Law, Aaron Sweeney. It's sad to think of him as gone, on this earth, but he had a great life and is in a better place until we see him again. When I met Kathy in late 1966, I had also met Eugene a short time after. I was to pick up Kathy at the house, and meet her father for the first time. Eugene told me that he didn't talk a lot, so not to be surprised. When I met him, we must have talked for at least an hour, waiting for Kathy to get ready. Of course I must have told him my whole life story. My father passed away when I was fourteen and I always felt lost and insecure at

making decisions after that.

It stayed with me, and in still there, after all these years. I felt right at home talking with Aaron, as if he was my Dad, in some ways. We discussed the Tigers and all the players, current and from the past, the same way I did with my Father. He talked about boxing,

called smokers at the theatres, where he and my Dad received 5 dollars a fight. (hope they never fought each other). We talked of hunting and the big bucks that did and didn't get away. He liked Franklin Roosevelt, my Dad liked Roosevelt, and the fact that he was for the small guy. Aaron had seven children, my Father had seven children. He didn't have to be so kind but was, and never once then or after that did he ask me about my long hair. Kathy does tell the story of Bob, when his hair was getting a little long, Dad mentioning it to him. Bob said he wanted to grow it long like Joe's. That day he was marched down to the barber shop to get it cut. That changed, however as years went on and he gave in. We talked of McCarthysim and I told him the story of my Dad, Joe, and how he was called into the office at the Ford plant, in Kingsford, where he worked and help put the pine wood on the station wagons. Evidently he told a number of people he was against the Korean war and that we should bring our American boys home, who were dying for nothing. Apparently speech wasn't quite as free as it is today or I might be in prison. He weathered that, but soon after, the Ford plant closed and 500 people were out of work. Close to the same time the ferries were to be replaced by the Mackinaw Bridge. A couple of days later when I saw Kathy I asked her what Dad had said about me. He said I seemed nice, but wanted to know my age.? Kathy told him I was 21, incase he heard that I had been in bar. Dad replied, he's 31 if he's a day.!!! (I had just turned 24), of course, that was his way of finding out how old I really was.) He never really got mad at me, that I know of, except for one time. We had first moved to Portland, Oregon and I was anxious for Eleanor and Dad to come out so I could show them our new house and all the things there were to see in the Northwest. Both Bob and Cindy came with them. We went up to Mt. Hood, they came in June, and I was so excited to see that it had snowed. Dad said it was the last thing he wanted to see.!!!

I coaxed him into driving all the way to California so we could all see the Redwoods, Crater Lake and the Oregon caves, the ocean and so forth. When at Crater Lake, Mom said, look at all those fools way up high on the mountain with their cars. She was shocked when Dad said....that's where we will be in just a few minutes!! Getting back to Dad getting mad it me.....It was during the time of the first gas shortage. It was getting near dark and we couldn't find a gas station open anywhere. We finally saw a line of cars at one, turned the corner, went around the block to get in line, and I said...Oh no.....it just closed!!! My joke didn't go over to well with him as I got yelled at. He never mentioned it again. Thinking back, I did have him drive us around the whole northwest, after along drive from St. Ignace think both him and mom enjoyed seeing the countryside, thou. I used to get in all the movies free and would take them when ever they visited us. I remember they really liked Midway, with surround sound and it felt like the bombs were dropping right in the theatre. That was new, at that time. We took them to see Summer of '42, and there was a little nudity in it. Mom wanted to know why we took them to a XXX show? She told Aunt Edna and Uncle Richard that when they came out to see us, we would be taking them to x rated movies. I know it's sad that they are both gone, but family and friends do live on. Have you noticed they will come to mind out of nowhere with maybe something they once said or something they did? When I see all the children, grand and great, I can see a little bit Mom and Dad in all of them. In Joey I see Aarons big hands, but my Dads expressions. It will show up in all of you now and then. When Gina and Joey were younger and would be walking in downtown St. Ignace they were asked several times if they were Sweeneys? In Iron Mountain they would be asked if they were Giannunzios? One thing I really noticed was how fair Dad, Aaron was with everything pertaining to his children. He always made sure you all had equal gifts and no one was slighted. That has carried on and payed forward. It is not always the case with other families. I've heard of huge fights for things after parents are gone. I don't ever remember Dad asking for anything in his entire life. Both Mom and Dad Sweeney were so kind and are together this very moment in heaven. They truly had a wonderful life on earth with all of you to carry on the good. I feel very fortunate to be a part of all of you.

The night her older brother Russell died, she was asleep in her bed and was woken up by her brother Russell sitting at the end of her bed. She had a short conversation with her brother and then he told her she should be getting back to sleep. Her brother was in fact down state at that time in a hospital and probably had died prior to Mary Eleanor seeing him at the foot of her bed. When she woke up the next day it was then she learned of his death.

We surely never became sick from meat being under cooked by Mom - everything was well done. We ate a lot of venison. Her cookies were also very well done as when the timer went off she simply turned off the oven and left the cookies in to cook a little longer.

After she passed away in Minnesota the family returned home to find a picture of Aaron's parents and his aunt and uncle on the floor. This picture was hanging in the living room above the dining room table. The picture's wire hanger was in tact and the nail was still in the wall, unbent. Eugene speculates that it is possible that these deceased family members may have been giving the family a message that all is well and they were there to greet Eleanor when she died.

#### RECOLLECTIONS FROM DEBBIE (MORROW) JOHNSON, 9-25-03

I have many fond memories of the house on Truckey St. We had a cottage up near Raber and we would go there for the summer. No matter how busy Aunt Eleanor was, she always had time to sit down and chat. There could be 18 things going on around her but she had a way of making you feel important and comfortable in her home. I can remember this really special chocolate cake she would make with the peanut butter frosting. Yummmmm. She was so good about keeping in touch too. She would call me every year to see how my family was doing. It was always so good to hear from her.

William lived with and was raised by Eugene and Ada Sweeney after his father divorced his mother.

While Bill was serving in WWII, he was behind enemy lines in a 5 or 6 truck convoy. They came upon a large German convoy of trucks carrying troops and heavy artillery. They met at a Y intersection in the road. While the Germans passed the American troops waived at them. The Germans thought the Americans were German also as they waived back.

He was one of only a few of the soldiers out of his company who survived. He was in a recon unit behind enemy lines.

After the war was over he and another soldier from Sault Ste. Marie were collecting German lugers to bring back to the states when a German soldier came out of the woods and threw a grenade in their jeep. Bill rolled out of the jeep, but his friend did not survive.
