'Benjamin Tomlinson, who was a Vestryman of Cumberland Parish from 1772 to 1780, was during the Revolutionary War successively Lieutenant, Captain, Major and Colonel. His will in Lunenburg County, Virginia, was dated September 29, 1787, and probated December 10, 1789. In it he mentions his wife Jane Tomlinson and the following children'

1. Harris Tomlinson, who was a first lieutenant from Lunenburg County, in the Revolution.
2. Phoebe Cross, wife of Charles Cross. Their marriage bond in Lunenburg County, is dated November 8, 1770.
3. Amye (Amey) Williams, who married John Williams, whose will was dated December 9, 1796, and probated June 8, 1797. Their sons and daughters named in the will were: 1. Benjamin Williams, 2. It is possible that Benjamin Tomlinson had a son Benjamin Tomlinson, not mention in his will. There is in Lunenburg County the marriage bond, dated Dec. 21, 1814 for the marriage of Benjamin Tomlinson to Nancy Gee. This Benjamin Tomlinson made his will March 27, 1818, and it was probated May 14, 1818. He mentions no childred; only his wife Nancy Tomlinson; and Lucas and Reubin Gee Executors. There is in Lunenburg County, Virginia, the marriage bond dated May 12, 1791, for the marriage of Benjamin Edmundson to Martha Tomlinson. This is thought to be the Patty Tomlinson, above, the daughter of Benjamin Tomlinson.'

Joseph B. Thomlinson filed for Civil War Pension on Sept. 4, 1870 or 1890 (hard to read). Company D, 46th Missouri Infantry. Application # 969.126, certificate #760.678, Filed from the State of Missouri, Attorney: T. W. Tallmadge. His allegiance was with the Union. Rank at Induction "Private", Rank at discharge "5 Sargent".

(12-6-03) I found at the Poplar Bluff Library, "Newton County Roots". I forgot to get the volume or date published, but in it was this: "Joseph B. Thomlinson Sgt, Co D 46 MO Vol Inf, 13 Aug 1865 - 6 Mar 1865, 6 mos, 23 days, Granby, Newton Co., MO, no disability."

I spoke w/my dad, Bill Tharp, & he said he remembers hearing a story, that grandpa Matthew went to doctor to have a boil lance that was in his ear, the doctor went in to far, & it killed him. He told me this story on 29 May, 1999.

I spoke with my "Aunt Tom" (Mary Francis-daughter of Matthew) & she said that he did have a boil in his ear, & gangrene had sit in & that is what killed him. She also told me, that Matthew was married before Alta, but does not know to whom or if there were any children of the marriage. (11 May 2000).

Census shows name as Matt or Matthias, but was always called Matthew.
