She has estate property consisting of a 1/2 interest in Lots 5 & 8, Block 69 of the West End Addition of the Town of Lake Providence, being the same property acquired by Henry Dyson from the Good Samaritan Society on Sep 7, 1926 as recorded in Conveyance Book FF page 516 of the records of East Carroll Parish.

Judgement of Possession dated Dec 7, 1967 whereby GOLDIE JOHNS BUFORD and MAMIE JOHNS JONES were placed in possession of the property.
