The Jasper County Health Department records incorrectly lists the birthplace of Clara's father, Joel Zinser, as Illinois. The record also incorrectly lists the birthplace of Clara's mother, Martha Tobias Zinser, as Ohio.

(1) Obituary for Clara (Zinser) Tyler:

Heading: "REMINGTON WOMAN CALLED BY DEATH"

Remington, April 17. - (Special) - Mrs. Clara Tyler, 54, a resident of this vicinity for forty years, died at her home three miles southwest of here this morning at 10:30 o'clock. She had suffered a stroke of apoplexy a month ago and today suffered a second stroke, resulting in her death.

Mrs. Tyler was born February 8, 1882, in El Paso, Ill., the daughter of Joseph (sic) and Martha Zinser, and married Dudley Tyler on March 9, 1905. Following her graduation from the Remington High School, she held a teaching position near here for one year. She was a member of the local Methodist church.

Surviving are three sons, Hartley, Donald and Ralph, all of Remington; a sister, Mrs John Davitt, of El Paso, Ill., and two grandchildren.

The body was removed to the Howard funeral home. Funeral services will be held from the Remington Methodist church, with burial in Remington cemetery.

Mrs. Clara Tyler widow of Dudley Tyler, passed away Friday, April 17, at the family home west of Remington, following an illness of a few weeks. Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon at the Remington M. E. Church, with interment in Remington cemetery.

Clara Zinser, daughter of Joel and Martha Zinser was born at El Paso, Ill., Feb. 8, 1882. With her parents she moved to the farm southwest of Remington in the spring of 1896. She was united with the church at El Paso, when just a young girl, bringing her letter to the Remington Methodist Church in 1898. She graduated with the class of 1901 from the Remington High School, and taught school the following year.

On March 9, 1905 she was united in marriage with Dudley Tyler. To this union were born three sons, Hartley, Donald and Ralph. Her husband preceded her in death, May 9, 1934.

For the past few years she has been in frail health, always courageous, she maintained her standards of home-making until about a month ago, since which time, she has patiently endured suffering and discomfort. Her sister, Mrs. J. W. Davitt has been with her during her last illness, ministering to her, out of the fullness of love, until she peacefully fell asleep in Jesus on April 17, 1936.

She is survived by her three sons, two grandchildren and one sister, Mrs. Davitt of El Paso, Ill. Also two nephews, one of whom, Richard Hannah, made his home with her, and Robert Zinser of Indianapolis. A brother Harvey Zinser, and sister Margurite Hannah preceded her in death. She endeared herself to many friends with the sweetness and beauty of her character.

Conflicting Death Records: Jasper County Health Department Death Records show that Clara's date of death was the 18th of April, in contrast with different newspaper obituaries which indicate the date of death was the 17th. The Health Dept. record lists her age as 54 years, 2 months, and 9 days. By using this age and calculating from her birth date, April 17th seems to be the more probable date of death, and matches the newspapers articles as well.

Notes for Dudley Oliver TYLER:

The birth certificate for Dudley states he was the second child born to Alice and Lansing Tyler. The place of birth is listed as Plainfield, IL, and the date of birth is given as December 4, 1882. The certificate, No. 3862, does not have a name written on the line where a child's name should have been entered. The certificate was not signed and returned by the doctor until January 1, 1883.

Dudley, with his parents, moved from Plainfield, Illinois to a farm southwest of Remington in the Spring of 1890.

Dudley, aged 17, was counted twice in the 1900 Federal Census. He was enumerated in his parent's household in Gilboa Twp., Benton County, as well as in the household of Henry A. Milner, in Carpenter Twp., Jasper Co. In both enumerations, his occupation is listed as farm labor.

Heading: "Death Claims Dudley Tyler After A Short Illness; Pneumonia"

Another of our good and substantial citizens passes to the great beyond, about noon on Wednesday, when the life span of Dudly (sic) O. Tyler was closed.

Mr. Tyler had been in his usual health up to four days ago, when he was taken suddenly ill and pneumonia developed. The disease rapidly grew in intensity, and on Tuesday night he was taken to the Home Hospital at Lafayette where he passed away as above stated.

The deceased was one of our most energetic and substantial farmers, revered and respected by all. He had lived in this vicinity since 1890 and on the farm he at present occupied for the past twenty years. His age was 51 past. At the present time he was a member of the township advisory board.

Besides the sorrowing wife he leaves three sons, Hartley, Donald and Ralph the latter two at home and the former living near by. His aged mother, Mrs Alice Tyler of Remington, and two brothers, Simeon of this place and Roy (sic) at Ft. Collins, Colo., and one sister, Mrs. Tom Blake of Rensselaer, besides many friends and near relatives.

The funeral service will be held this Friday afternoon at two o'clock at the M. E. Church.

Dudley O. Tyler was born Dec. 4, 1882 in Plainfield, Ill., the son of L. H. and Alice Tyler, and died May 9, 1934, aged 51 years, 5 months and 4 days.

After his marriage to Miss Clara Zinser, on March 9, 1905, he attended the Methodist church with her and there his three sons were baptized and received into the church. H(e) has lived in this community since he was a child of 7 years and received his education in the District School and the Gilboa High School.

An honorable and upright citizen, standing for all that was right and good. As a neighbor and friend he few equals. He was never too tired to help his neighbors who were in need of help. His devotion to his wife and children was a thing of beauty. For them he lived and died.

Surviving him is his wife Clara, his sons Hartley, Donald and Ralph, and two grandchildren. His mother Mrs. Alice Tyler, two brothers, Simeon of Remington, Ray of Fort Collins, Colorado, and a sister, Mrs. Cora Blake, of Rensselaer.

The Jasper Co. Indiana Health Department record for Martha's daughter, Clara Zinser, incorrectly lists Martha's birthplace as Ohio. The certificate of birth for daughter Mary Josephine Zinser lists Martha's birthplace as Washington, Illinois.

Martha, age 5, is listed with her mother, Mary M. Tobias, residing in the household of her grandparents, Jacob and Elizabeth Zinser, in Washington, Illinois at the time of the 1860 census.

Obituary for Martha Tobias Zinser:

Martha Tobias Zinser was born at Washington, Ill., April 12, 1855, and passed away at El Paso, Ill., July 18, 1930.

She was married to Joel Zinser, Feb. 20, 1877. Their early married life was spent on the Zinser farm, southeast of El Paso. Four children, Harvey D., now deceased, Mrs. Clara Tyler, of Remington; Mrs. Josephine Davitt, at El Paso; and Mrs. Marguerite, also deceased, were born during their residence there. In 1896, the family moved to their farm near Remington, where in January, 1916, the husband and father departed this life. The next year, Mrs. Zinser, with her daughters, Marguerite and Josephine, returned to El Paso to reside.

In the fall of 1928, Mrs. Zinser suffered a stroke of paralysis, and from that time on she made her home with Mr. and Mrs. John Davitt, at El Paso. Several strokes in close succession, were the immediate cause of her passing.

Mrs. Zinser was a member of the Methodist Church and attended its services as long as she was able to do so. Every day found her reading her Bible, and in the last days of her affliction she offered many prayers for those about her.

She leaves to mourn her loss, besides her two daughters, one brother, E. L. Myers, of Pekin, Ill.; five grandsons and a host of friends.

Funeral services were held Monday at 10:00 a. m., at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Davitt, after which burial took place at Remington beside the husband.

John W. Davitt died at 11:15 p.m. November 26, in Mennonite hospital from a complication of diseases following influenza. Funeral services were held from the Ficken memorial home at 2:00 o'clock Sunday afternoon, conducted by Rev. Lloyde G. Strouse, assisted by Rev. L. F. Zinser. There was a large attendance and many flowers. J. A. Smith, Herman Marten, Leo Henning, Clarence West, Mervin Kemp and L. H. Knecht served as pallbearers. Interment was in Evergreen cemetery.

John W. Davitt was born in El Paso January 12, 1888, the only child of John and Margaret (Collins) Davitt, and spent his entire life in this city. When a young man he began work in S. H. Worthington's dry goods store. Later he was employed in the J. A. Smith store and then was associated with the Vogelsang Dry Goods Co. For the past seven years he had operated a dry goods store for himself. Mr. Davitt was married September 21, 1916, to Miss Josephine Zinser who, with his mother, survives.

Notes for John George ZINSER:

Rev. John George Zinser was a native of Gaertingen(Gärtringen?), Württemberg, Germany, and was born November 28, 1806. At an early age he accompanied his parents to America, settling with them in New York City. After remaining there several years they removed to Pennsylvania, where J. G. grew to manhood. He again accompanied his parents to Pickaway County, Ohio when they became residents of that county in 1837, and there remained until 1869. J. G. later moved to Section 9 of El Paso Township of Woodford County, Illinois, where the remainder of his life was spent.

Johann Georg Zinser came to America as a boy from Württemberg, Germany in 1817 according to the Ferner, Farner, and Furner Family History published 3 April 1941.

Interestingly, the family of Rev. Zinser was enumerated twice in the 1870 federal census. They were counted in the town of Washington, IL on 14 June 1870. They were counted again on 20 July 1870 in El Paso Township, Woodford Co., IL. See details below, noting the differences and errors, particularly in the El Paso enumeration.

The following paragraph is an excerpt taken from the History of Seneca County (Ohio), page 498, addressing Clinton Township:

Salem German Evangelical Church dates back to the conference of the association held in 1856, when Tiffin was set off as a station, with Rev. Leonhard Scheuerman, pastor. The original members were Jacob Schneider, Louis Schubert, Jonas Huber, J. G. Zinser, William Negele, Sr., A. E. Dresbach and Joseph Beidleman. The pastors succeeding Mr. Scheuerman were J. G. Theuer, J. G. Zinser, C. Tramer, G. Hasenpflug, J. Frankhouser, C. F. Negele, E. B. Crouse, F. Frech, C. G. Koch, W. Schupp, G. Schneider, W. F. Zander, and the present pastor, C. Gahn. The secretaries have been J.G. Zinser and William Negele, the latter now holding the office. The church was erected March 28, 1858, at a cost of \$2,400, on Sandusky Street, near Perry. The society was incorporated October 11, 1876, with the following named members: William Negele, Charles Werner, Got. Meister, L. and Juliana Schurtzes, John Samuelt, Jonas Huber,

Peter Schneider, C. G. and Catharine Koch, L. Shuber, John Lechti, G. Behler, Reuben Harris, Thomas Dixon, William Tiansed, Christina Endel, Susan Miller, Rosa Shubert, Angelina Heelman, Caroline Behler, Hannah Fishbaugh, Mary Strauss, Lottie Endell, Margaret Stahlschmidt, Margaret Samuelt, Sarah Becher, Eliza Morlech and Lena Stahlschmidt. Five trustees were elected at this time.

The following paragraph is an excerpt taken from Chapter XIII of the History of Pickaway County (Ohio), page 161, addressing Pickaway Township:

Ebenezer Church of the Evangelical Association stands about half a mile east of Hayesville, near the center of the township. The class was formed by Rev. John Dreisbach in 1835, the first members being Rev. John Dreisbach and wife, Thomas Kraft and wife, Adam Boyer and wife and John Kraft and wife. Abraham Dreisbach, who subsequently became minister of the church, and Isaac E., Catherine and Sophia Dreisbach and Mrs. Eliza Steely were also early members, uniting soon after the organization was effected. The first meetings were held at the dwellings of the members and afterwards in a log schoolhouse. Subsequently the society used the frame schoolhouse, which replaced the log one, until the erection of their present church in the summer of 1850. Rev. John Dreisbach, who lived on the farm where the church is located and whose remains lie beside those of his wife in the adjoining cemetery, gave the ground for the church and cemetery, and the sum of \$1,000 toward the building of the church. The church is especially historic to the members of the Evangelical Association from the fact that Mr. Dreisbach was one of the . founders of the association, which was first known as the Albright Church, being a coworker with Bishop Albright. The church building cost \$903.61 to erect. It was dedicated December 22, 1850, by Bishop Joseph Long and Presiding Elder J. G. Zinser. The outside of the building has never been structurally changed, but the interior has been remodeled several times. Rev. John Dreisbach preached for the class for a few years, until the regular circuit preachers were appointed. John Heisler was class leader until 1840, when Isaac E. Dreisbach, son of Rev. John Dreisbach and father of the present Sunday-school superintendent, B. F. Dreisbach, was appointed. Isaac E. Dreisbach continued as leader until his death in 1897--a period of 57 years. The church has a present membership of 50. Rev. G. W. Miesse, of Stoutsville, is pastor. The church building, although over 50 years old, has received such good care that it is still in excellent condition, being worth about \$2,000 at this time. The sexton's house adjoining the church is valued at \$600. B. F. Dreisbach has served as Sunday-school superintendent for the past 31 years.

The following paragraphs are excerpts taken from Chapter XVI, of the History of Pickaway County (Ohio), page 182, addressing the churches of Walnut Twp. of Pickaway County:

There have been two churches of the Evangelical Association in Walnut township. Mount Zion's Church, at one time called the Zinser Church, was organized in 1830, at the home of Solomon Zinser, where meetings were held until the frame church on the south line of the township was erected in 1840. The original members were: Solomon Zinser and wife, John Bridagum and wife, Jacob Rife and wife and Valentine Reber and wife. The church building was the first church edifice erected by the denomination west of the Allegheny Mountains. Previous to its completion, the first Ohio Evangelical Conference was held in a barn on the farm then owned by Solomon Moyer, afterward the Andrew Ucher farm. The church was abandoned in the '80's.

Emanuel Church of the Evangelical Association was formed about 1832, with the following members: John Tobias and wife, Peter Tobias and wife, John Hittle and wife and Peter Moyer and wife. Meetings were held at the dwellings of the members, until the church in the southeast corner of section 28 was built, in 1848. Rev. A. J. Diefenderfer has been the pastor of the church for the past two years. The membership of the church, which in former years was more than 100, has been decreased by removals and deaths to 25. There is a flourishing Sunday-school.

The original members were: Solomon Zinser and wife, John Bridagum and wife, Jacob Rife and wife and Valentine Reber and wife. The church building was the first church edifice erected by the denomination west of the Allegheny Mountains. Previous to its completion, the first Ohio Evangelical Conference was held in a barn on the farm then owned by Solomon Moyer, afterward the Andrew Ucher farm. The church was abandoned in the '80's.

Emanuel Church of the Evangelical Association was formed about 1832, with the following members: John Tobias and wife, Peter Tobias and wife, John Hittle and wife and Peter Moyer and wife. Meetings were held at the dwellings of the members, until the church in the southeast corner of section 28 was built, in 1848. Rev. A. J. Diefenderfer has been the pastor of the church for the past two years. The membership of the church, which in former years was more than 100, has been decreased by removals and deaths to 25. There is a flourishing Sunday-school.
