Sept 1861 William enlisted at Mount Tabor in Company B, 15th SC Infantry and served until the end of the war. William was with Kershaw's Brigade, McLaw's Division, Longstreet's Corps., the first Brigade to enter the battle for the "Rocky Knoll" and "Wheat Field" at Gettysburg. In 1870 William was farming in Union Township, Union County SC.

In 1900 William was farming in Santuc Township Union County South Carolina. His youngest son was working on the farm and William had recently remarried.

In 1910 William was still farming in Santuc Township and his wife Sallie and her mother Ellen Estes were living with him.

In 1911 after Williams death Sallie moved near Leeds, Chester County South Carolina.

Dec 22, 1919 Sallie applied for for a widow's pension for Williams service during the Civil War.

They joined General Lincoln and a part of the troops crossed over the river and had an engagement with the British on Briar Creek in the state of Georgia. James was part of the troops left on the South Carolina side of the river as a rear guard. April 1780 to Jun of 1781 James served as a Minute Man under Capt John Lejarneth.
