Notes for ARTHUR PEARMAN:

Arthur attended Katherine Bailey's Charity School.

Arthur Pearman was a weaver by trade afterwards becoming a grocer's porter. Possibly due to the slump in the industry in the late 1800's. He and his family moved to 4, Barnes buildings, Holyhead Rd., later the name of the address changing to 19, Holyhead Rd. The house still exists in 2002 at the bottom of the Holyhead Rd. Now owned by Touchstone housing and converted into flats. It is a listed building, having formerly been a watchmaker's shop. Hannah was a silk dyer when they married.

[My Butler and Pearman ancestors.FTW] Arthur, his wife, Hannah and his father, James all died in 1908. Hannah and Arthur were both 51 years old. I believe that Arthur died before Hannah, as I remember my Nan (Florence) telling me that she looked after her Mother when she was ill, and she married Grandad Death afterwards.
