(nb given lack of "h's" in locaql accent, Hannah and Ann/Anna, must have been indistinguishable when spoken.) October 6 1798 Christening of son John at Leamington Hastings

June 6 1941 Presumed to be Hannah Fletcher aged 75 (actually 79?) living in Leamington Hastings almshouse. Son John's family were the only Fletcher's in the Parish.

March 18 1846 Buried at Leamington Hastings aged 84. Abode L.H.

Possibly Thomas' father John?

Louie seems to have been the dominant sister. A photo from Hilda, from the early '30s shows her in a matron's uniform with Emily, presumably outside the Stowe mental home which she managed for a Mrs Burden.

"Stowe was closed at the beginning of the war and Louie had to find homes for the non-violent ones. She sent one to us when we were in Harlech, Annie arrived and stayed with us for 17 years. . . . The Aunts came to Harlech to see the twins.

"Louie was most important to Mrs Burden and managed her home, also went away with her if necessary. . . . We went down to stay near them. Aunt Louie was most entertaining with her stories about Clevedon and Mrs Burden - always delivered in a matter-of-fact way.

"Louie had bought a house at Polzeath in North Cornwall and when she retired she went to live there with Emily. It was such a contrast to Clevedon and was a complete change for them.

"Nellie died first for she was less strong but we lost touch with Louie

"Those four sisters were very fond of their brother George and Louie made sure that I was looking after Tom well enough. She thought he was too thin." (Hilda, 21.10.1998)

Evidently Mrs Burden had a house built specially for Louie's retirement, on the edge of Clevedon Hall grounds. Nellie and Florrie came to live there when Florrie retired.

"So the sisters were living close to each other at last. Tom arranged for us to stay in the house when the Aunts were away. We had a good holiday there and remember it with pleasure. The twins would be eight years old and Janie two [ie 1947] but Clevedon had some attractions for children." (Hilda, 21.10.1998)
