Samuel's tombstone gives his birth year as 1832, however, I believe this to be wrong. According to census records he was born in 1836 in Harris County, Georgia.

Samuel Young Johnston was born in Harris County, Georgia, on April 1, 1836, to John and Martha Johnston. When Samuel was about two years old his family moved to Tallapoosa County, Alabama, settling in the Walnut Hill area.

Samuel was eight years old when his Mother passed away in July 1844. In August of 1844 his father remarried. His step-mother, Mary Ann C. Haynie was about 20 years younger than his father.

In February of 1854, at the age of 17, Samuel married Lucinda Jane Gray, daughter of Samuel Gray, Jr. and Mahala McBurnett, she was fourteen years old.

Following in his father's footsteps, Samuel was a slave holder. At the age of twenty-four Samuel owned nineteen slaves.

When the Civil War broke out Samuel was twenty-five years old. He served in the CSA as a volunteer in Alabama's Co. B, 47th Infantry, from May 1861 until the end of the war in 1865.

On the 1870 census at the age of 34, Samuel's occupation was listed as a school teacher. 1870 was also the year of his son John's birth. Samuel and Lucinda's other children that grew to adulthood were: Mary Jane "Mattie", born 1876; Herschel, born 1879 and Katie Idell, born in 1882, all of these children were born in Tallapoosa County, Alabama. According to 1880 census records Samuel and Lucinda were the parents of six children, so three children must have died at birth or at an early age. No records have been found for them. After his father's death, Samuel, a Notary Public, preformed the marriage ceremony of his step-mother, Mary Ann Cleabie Haynie Johnston to a Mr. Robberson Willingham on June 6, 1882.

Around 1889 or 1890, Samuel moved his family to Runnels County, Texas, settling at or near the town of Crews. Lucinda's brothers, Columbus and Johnathan Gray, had came west a few years earlier, settling also near Crews, Texas, but over the line in Coleman County.

Samuel served as County Commissioner Of Runnels County, Texas in 1891-1892. He was a farmer, teacher and Methodist Minister. According to family he was a circuit rider for the Methodist Church (traveling to different churches to preach) and Minister of Moro Methodist Church, Moro, Texas. Samuel passed away at the age of 63 years, 10 months and 21 days. He is buried in the Northview Cemetery, Winters, Runnels County, Texas.

There are many different spellings for Nancy Katherine's last name. The name on her marriage license is spelled McLeran. On a deed of gift from her father in Hopkins Co., Texas, it is spelled McLarin, this is also the spelling on the 1850 census in Hopkins Co. Billie Pierce in her book, "The Pierce Family" used the spelling, McLerran, as it seemed to be the most common spelling.

I have noticed that some people spell her christian name as "Nancy Catherine". However, everything that I have found on backs of pictures & etc. spells it Nancy Katherine, so that is what I have used.

"I, James McLarin of the county and state aforesaid for and in consideration of the love I have for my daughter Nancy Katharine McLarin do will and bequeath give grant and convey unto said Nancy K. McLarin a certain gray mare and her increase whatever it may be to her sole use and benefit hereby and by these present relinquishing all my right title and interest to said mare known as a gray mare that Samuel Matthews, deceased, formerly owned and I do hereby and by these present relinquish all claims on said mare Except as guardian of said Nancy K. McLarin."

We have rented a farm that is about 2 miles from Mocks and is three miles from Collinsville our post office.

Our place is conviently fix with out buildings and good spring close to the house and a good orchard. Apples, peaches, pears and plums and cheeries. The orchard was reserved but we are to have plenty of using right and peaches to dry. We have thirty five head of cattle in care and ten of them giving milk. Me and Betty attend to them. They are all gentle and but little trouble and we get plenty of milk. We are very well fixed up in our house for Texas. We bought

four bedsteads and six chairs and a stove. Our table com-safe and everything but one c___h and one bottle of medicine.

Well you would like to know what I think of Texas. I have seen but little of it but I am satisfied that I made a good move. The land is rich and there is plenty of water and timber in this part of Texas. Sand_____ and Rea_____ at that. There is plenty of corn here at 50___ and plenty of everything that you have in Missouri.

The people here are friendly and plain and we have church every Sunday within a mile and two miles. Methodist and Baptist. I have been to hear both sides preach and have been to one wedding and one burying at _____. But beautiful burying ground. Well Jimmy I want you and Wesley to clean off the old graveyard for me. If you please leave some bushes trim, clip for shade and _____. Frank and Eliza I want you to plant four little cedars at the head and foot of Barby and Jesse's graves. I may never see them but will satisfy the mind for them to be there for somebody to see and I can see them in the distance.

Lady is here. Her and Betty is cutting out a new dress as it is damp and rainy and not fit to pick cotton. She is grown and well turned and doesn't chew tobacco nor dip snuff. Dock and Tine is well and doing well and is living on a fine farm and seventy acres of wheat sowed and looking well and talks of sowing his oats right away. Tell James Huston seeing that if he was out here and would go with me out on the Sherman Ferry we would see the finest looking land he ever seen and plenty of it.

I must close for the present. Give my respect to all inquiring friends. Write all of you when you get this.

That he was born about 22 miles west of Troy, Montgomery (now Stanly) County, North Carolina.

Copies of three different letters were found at the Archives. In two of the letters he gives his birth year as 1811 and one letter as 1813, so I have stayed with the 1811 year as his date of birth.

Needham was married three times and was said to have 21 children. I have names of 20 of them.

In the winter of 1870, Needham , wife Elizabeth, and children: John, Sannette (Assinith), Marab, Elias "Pete", and William Sherman along with Needham's daughter, Rebecca and her husband, John Huneycutt, and their children, (Lem Burris and LeJeanus Huneycutt) moved from Stanly County, North Carolina, to Red River County in east Texas. Other North Carolina families probably made the journey also.

They journeyed on a flat bottom boat from North Carolina, down the Atlantic coast, around the Florida peninsula, back up the Gulf coast to the mouth of the Mississippi River, up the Mississippi to the mouth of the Red River and then up the Red River to the mouth of the Big Cypress (which was navigable at that time to Jefferson, Texas).

They got off the boat at Jefferson, Texas, put their possessions on an ox cart and walked to their destination in Red River County. They initially settled in Red River County near Detroit, Texas. Two years later they moved to Cooke County, Texas. The Texas towns of Blossom and Detroit were used as their post office address part of the time.

Two years later in the fall of 1872, four more of Needham's children and their families made the journey from North Carolina to Texas. They included: Thomas , his wife Martha and their nine known children; Needham, and his wife Wincie and four children; Sylvia, and her husband, Noah Huneycutt and two children; and Daniel Pressley.

On September 9, 1875, Needham Whitley of Cooke County, Texas, purchased 160 acres of land in Grayson County, Texas, (which is adjacent to Cooke Co.) on the waters of Big Mineral Bayou for the sum of \$1000.

In August 1896, Needham Whitley, attested in an affidavit that was notarized and signed with his mark to the Dawes Commission, Indian Territory. In this affidavit he attested that his age was 84 years, and to the fact that the children of Susannah Morton Whitley were of Cherokee decent through her mother, Elizabeth "Betsy" Brumbelow, and through their grandfather, Edward "Judge" Brumbelow, who was 1/2 Cherokee Indian by blood. The names of the children of Susannah Morton Whitley were: Hiram C. Whitley, Ezekiel Thomas Whitley, William H. A. Whitley, John Vincent Whitley, Susan M. A. Whitley Brasher, and George F. Whitley. Susannah Morton Whitley was the wife of William Marion Whitley, Jr.

Notes for William Whitley:

There is some contradiction as to the exact date of William "Uncle Billy" Whitley's birthdate. It is said that the family Bible, which had his birthdate in it went west with one of his children.

The Jacob Whitley papers state that he was born in 1775 and that is what is on his tombstone, other sources point to the year 1772.

On March 13, 1890, the Stanly Observer of Albermarle, North Carolina, wrote a long memorial to "Uncle Billy" Whitley stating that he died March 3, 1890, at the age of 117 years of thereabouts which indicates a birthdate of December 1772. Uncle Billy was said to have been a 114 years old at the time of the July 4, 1887, celebration which calculates to a year of birth being 1772.

At the time of his death, Uncle Billy had in his possession several family heirlooms including a pocket knife, a tax receipt of colonial days, and a musket. In its tribute to Uncle Billy, the Stanly Observer stated, " Mr Whitley's moral character was excellent, never having fallen into excess of any kind, and his habits of industry and economy acquired in his primitive days clung to him with tenacity to the last moment of time.... His home was in Furr township, Stanly County. His remains were deposited in the Whitley family burying ground not far from his old homestead.... In physique he was rather below the average."

Billy is said to have remembered his father and two brothers coming home from the Revolutionary War, bring their guns with them.

It is said that Uncle Billy attended the Whitley Family Reunion in 1889 at which time he exhibited his third set of natural teeth which were as smooth and white as baby teeth. Uncle Billy enjoyed the fuss made over him and he never tired of having his teeth examined or telling how old he was.

On November 18, 1975, the Stanly News and Press reprinted an account of the 4th of July celebration held at Rocky River Springs at which, Uncle Billy was the stellar attraction at the ripe old age of 114.

"It was in the year 1887, I think, and as usual there was a tremendous crowd on the grounds. Rev. C.H. Martin, was then a young preacher charming everyone with his silver tongue eloquence and matchless oratory. He was present that day and made a great address.

Mr Martin almost went wild over Uncle Billy, and held him up on a high platform and proudly exhibited the aged man. . . . He (Uncle Billy) shot that same old musket on that 4th of July, standing on the platform, supported by Mr.

Martin. When the thundering report reverberated all through the hills, cheer after cheer went through the air and Rev. Charles H. Martin's voice could be heard above all the others. People laughed and wept and prayed.

It was then, with Mr. Martin's arm about him, that Uncle Billy said he had a message to deliver to the people. He was sure he would never be there another 4th, and wanted them to remember his last words. Then in a solemnly tender, earnestly warning way, with his feeble old hands stretched out in loving benediction, he said, "Prepare to meet thy God."

The November 18, 1975, article commented further about him: "Uncle Billy had never ridden a train, nor been many miles from his home. He lived through the inauguration of every President of the United States up to that time. . .from Washington on down. He always wore home spun and woven clothes. . . probably never bought a suit of clothes in his life."

Uncle Billy was a member of the Meadow Creek Baptist Church, Stanly County, North Carolina.

THE MUSKET

According to Dr. D. P. Whitley the musket , that Uncle Billy displayed, and is often mentioned, is the same gun that Uncle Billy's father brought back from the Revolutionary War. Gen. Washington purchased from France, a number of the Charlesville muskets, model of 1763, for use by the Continental troops. It has the manufacturers's inscription on it, and there is no question about its origin. This same gun is now in the possession of his family.

First and principally of all I commend my soul to God who gave it and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent and christian like manner at the

Art. 1st My will is that my Executors, here in after named, pay all my funeral expenses and just - debts out of money on hand or debts due and owing to me at my death, and if there is a deficiency the balance to be raised from sale of property belonging to my estate.

To daughters JEAN POOLE, ISABEL NORTON, MARGARET HERRON, and SALLY TUCKER, and to sons HUGH HUSTON, JOHN HUSTON, and SAMUEL HUSTON, that part of the land lying on the other side of the road from the house wherein he now lives, except for a part which shall hereafter be mentioned, beginning at corner to SEARLES LEWIS, Thomas Huston, and testator, thence with said road to a small bridge in the lane nearly opposite the old barn, thence a straight line so as to divide the spring generally known as the Big Spring, then with the drain of said spring to the lower end of the meadow, back to the road, then a straight line from a white oak which was formerly a corner between James Hughes and testator to a large walnut which is a corner between Foster and testator, then with the line between Foster and testator to Samuel Bland's corner, then with the line between said Bland and testator to WILLIAM WAKEFIELD'S, then with that line a straight line to Searle Lewis's line, thence with that line to the beginning. Said land to be laid off in lots agreeable to the quality and quantity, and one lot to JAMES POOLE, one lot to ISABEL NORTON, one lot to MARGARET HERRON, one to SALLY TUCKER, and one to JOHN HUSTON. Also a lot to HUGH and SAMUEL, to be equally divided between them, making six lots. To ABIGAIL WAKEFIELD, the strip of land which testator holds between Wakefield's line and Searles Lewis's line, and each of other daughters to which he has willed lots, and son John, are to pay Abigail Wakefield \$15.00 each. To daughter ELIZABETH HUSTON, one Negro girl named Eliza, and also the side of the plantation whereon testator now lives, and also the meadow, and the benefit of the Big Spring, and the benefit of the household and kitchen furniture. Also her choice of two horses and two plows with the gears and other utensils for

working said land, and the profits of said land as long as she remains single. But if she changes her way of living for a married life, then the land mentioned is to be sold and she is to have one-third of the money arising therefrom. Also all of the horned cattle to Elizabeth except one milk cow which is to go to daughter Sally. Also to daughters Abigail Wakefield and Sally Tucker, two ewes each, and the other part of the sheep to daughter Elizabeth. All of the hogs to daughter Elizabeth. The Negro woman Lucy and child Caroline are to be sold, and Elizabeth to have one-third of the money with the rest of the money to the rest of the heirs to be equally divided. To daughter Elizabeth, all of the crop of grain which is on hand, with rents due testator this fall, and all of the outstanding debts out of which Elizabeth is to pay all of testator's just debts and funeral expenses.

Appoints William Wakefield, and daughter Elizabeth, as executors. September 15, 1824.

EARLY GENTRY HISTORY

The following is a summary of the early Gentry History, by John Reed, as provided in the " The Gentry Family in America 1676 to 1909" , written by Richard gentry in 1909.

There is a tradition in the Gentry family that the first Gentrys to settle in America were Nicholas and Samuel, who came from England as members of a British military unit sent to quell Bacon's Rebellion in 1677. The rebellion had ended by the time they arrived from England, but Virginia Commonwealth didn't have enough money to send the soldiers back to England. After a few years, many of the soldiers decided to stay in America. The Gentry brothers settled on land in New Kent County, Virginia, which later became part of

Hanover County, Virginia. Just before the Revolutionary War, Nicholas Gentry's grandson, George Gentry, left Hanover County with his wife Elizabeth and settled near Free Union in northern Albemarle County, Virginia. Following the war, his son, James Gentry, returned from military service and helped run the Albemarle County Gentry farm. After George Gentry's death in 1810, James Gentry purchased 400 acres in Orange County along the Lynch River and turned it over to his son, John Gentry, to operate. John Gentry had married Patsy Hicks in 1804 and they raised their children on the Gentry farm in Green County. The Green County farm passed from John Gentry to his son, John Gentry, Jr.

After ten or so years, around 1765 or 1768, they moved to the Juanata Valley in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, to obtain cheap land for farming. His wife, Jane, died about 1769, leaving him with six children to care for. In 1771, he purchased land on the north side of the Juanata River. During this time, he married Abigail Brown, who was twenty-nine years his junior. She bore him nine children.

James was a slave holder, owning one or two slaves at different times. He owned 350 acres of land. At age 60, he served as a private in the Revolutionary War, in the Cumberland County, Pennsylvania Militia, 4th Battalion. His two oldest sons were also in service during this time. James was a Presbyterian Church leader, at one time a Constable and an Overseer of the Poor. He died December 3, 1789, in Mifflin County, of a hemorrhage following the extraction of a tooth. He was baptized at the Old Swedes Church in Wilmington, Delaware, on February 12, 1721, parents James Husten and Mary. He married Jane Elliott, Abt. 1755, in the same Church where he was baptized. After ten or so years, around 1765 or 1768, they moved to the Juanata Valley in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, to obtain cheap land for farming. His wife, Jane, died about 1769, leaving him with six children to care for. In 1771, he purchased land on the north side of the Juanata River. During this time, he married Abigail Brown, who was twenty-nine years his junior. She bore him nine children.

James was a slave holder, owning one or two slaves at different times. He owned 350 acres of land. At age 60, he served as a private in the Revolutionary War, in the Cumberland County, Pennsylvania Militia, 4th Battalion. His two oldest sons were also in service during this time. James was a Presbyterian Church leader, at one time a Constable and an Overseer of the Poor. He died December 3, 1789, in Mifflin County, of a hemorrhage following the

extraction of a tooth. The Huston tract was in Derry Township (later Wayne, now Oliver Township), a part of Cumberland County until 1789 at which time Mufflin County was formed. It is not known where James was buried.
