John moved north of where his father, Blake had settled, to claim the land that would become the Jarrell Plantation. In addition to being a farmer, he was a blacksmith, carpenter, wagon smith, a wheelwright, a stone mason, a tanner, and a maker of leather goods. This helped to make the plantation very self-efficient. In 1976, the plantation was opened to the public as a state park. Mary Jewett, chairman of the State Historical Commission, stated that the plantation was one of the best preserved and most complete of any that she had ever

seen.

He was a farmer through out his life.

He moved his family to Bonham, TX in Oct. of 1905. In 1906 he moved the family to Carthage, TX and 1907 they moved to Clayton, TX.

Annie was killed in an automobile accident about four miles east of Henderson, TX on the highway to Carthage. The car skidded on a curve and crashed into a tree. She died in an ambulance en route to a hospital. Her husband, Frank Wheeler, escaped with minor injuries. She was en route to Carthage to see her sister who had just returned from the hospital in Shreveport. She was first buried in the Jarrell family plot in the cemetery at Clayton, TX. Later she was disinterred and buried by the side of her first husband. Jane was divorced from her second husband in 1944.
