JOHN DAY

Note: Sept 2004. The marriage data on John Day is a mare's nest. The present configuration is my best guess.

JOHN DAY, b. 1645 in Hartford, Ct. d. bef. 29 Apr 1730 in Hartford; m. 1675 in Hartford to Sarah Maynard, b. 1651; d. abt 1730, daughter of John Maynard and Mary Starr. His will was dated 16 Nov 1725, when he was "advanced in years," and proved 6 May 1730. He owned a share in a grist or saw mill, which he bequeathed to his son William."

There has been some confusion about the wife of John Day, with some claiming she was Sarah (Stone) Butler, but the following reference from Savage, "Genealogical Dictionary of New England," vol. 4, p. 446 shows that that would have been impossible.

"Richard Webb.....he died [1665] leaving no children but took Sarah, dau. of Rev. Samuel Stone, and brot. her up, until she married Thomas Butler of Hartford; and in Hall's History we see that the widow [Webb] empowered a friend, in 1677 to adj. with Butler and his wife for their claim of the estate of her Husband. Butler's wife had half, and by the court was distribut. other portions to Bartholomew Barnard, who was husband of Sarah, dau. of Thomas Birchard, to Richard Homes, Stephen Beckwith, Thomas Barnum and others, of whose degrees of consanguin. it may not be easy to determine." This would indicated that John Day did not marry Sarah (Stone) Butler & have children by her in 1675 & 1677, because Thomas Butler did not die until 1688.

John Day owned a share in a grist or saw mill, which he bequeathed to his son William.

### JOHN DAY

JOHN DAY, born 24 Sept. 1676/7 in Colchester, Ct.; died 4 Nov. 1752 in same; m. 21 Jan. 1696 in Hartford, Ct. to Grace Spencer, who died 12 May 1714 in Colchester, Ct. He m. (2) Mary \_?\_, who died 2 Nov. 1749, aged 74 years.

There is disagreement about the parentage of Grace Spencer. There were two Grace Spencers born in the same generation. One Grace, b. 27 July 1674 in East Haddam, Ct., was the daughter of Samuel Spencer and Hannah Willey. This is the Grace named by Nathaniel Goodwin in "Genealogical Notes, First Settlers of Connecticut and Massachusetts" (1982) as the wife of John Day. (Also in Virkus' "The Compendium of American Genealogy" and the Elmer I. Shepard Collection) However, TAG 27: 89 lists the Grace, b. 24 Sept. 1676 in Middletown, Middlesex, CT, the daughter of John Spencer and Rebecca Hayward/Howard as the wife of John Day and suggests that Grace,

dau. of Samuel died young as she was not mentioned in her father's will. It is possible that children not mentioned in a parent's will received their settlement before the will was written. [Since this could be the case with Samuel Spencer, I personally will not rule Samuel out as the father of the wife of John Day-mra] John Spencer and Rebecca Hayward/Howard have been the accepted parents of Grace Spencer by the Spencer Family Association. However, since it was called to their attention that there were 3 sources that named Samuel & Hannah (Willey) Spencer as her parents, they are doing further research.

According to the book, Cazenovia, an Upland Community, the Curtises operated a farm for many generations. I believe they are still there, at least some were when I was in school in the late 1960s. The Curtis farm is located on Balina Road.

Settlement began in 1793. "The main boulevard swelled into a public square at the center of the village where Linclaeen built on the south side a tavern which he sold to Michael Day, one of his axemen, and on the southwest side a company store."

Before you trot off to Caz, write to the Madison County Historical Association in Oneida. They have all the cemetery listings. White Cemetery is probably a small family cemetery as there were many White families around. Utica was originally called Whitestown.

Next, there are three or more other sources which may have information. There is a Madison County History Book, and a Biographical record of prominent citizens, old families. The Historical Association also has a book by Tuttle on all the old Madison County geneal. records, alpha by name. There is another source in the local history collection of the Syracuse Public Library on the history of upstate NY, covering a multi-county area. The last book in this 3 or 4 volume collection is biographical.

Both the Day and the Curtis names go way back to early Conn or RI. I have also seen the Day name in some of these books, and in other counties where Wilcox families resided. A Wilcox in another county, west of here, married into the Day family. I think it was around Albion, NY, between Buffalo and Rochester.

I am researching the Wilcox family south of the thruway and see the same family names from county to county.

Sorry, I don't know the address in Oneida. I just happened to drive by there on business and spent half a day. I know how to find it.

THE DAY TAVERN by Daniel H Weiskotten

The Days, not Michael Day, mind you, but Jacob, Ralph, and Daniel Day were three brothers and the sons of Daniel Day. Jacob and Ralph had built a brick building about 1810 at the northeast corner of the Square, where the wooden back half the Merchants Bank is now. It seems that it may have been an office of some sort and Oran Baker printed The Pilot in this brick building between 1810 and 1811.

Jacob and Ralph Day were the proprietors of the former Johnson House as early as 1810 but Ralph Day continued only for a short time and Jacob continued until 1813 when Daniel Day became the tavern keeper. It is not known if this was Daniel Day the father or Daniel Day the son. Daniel Day kept the tavern for a few years and is last found in 1817. It is from the not-so- well recorded ownership of the Days that the confusion with Michael Day has arisen. <http://www.erols.com/weiskotten/johnson.html>

This is a very brief overview of the 161st NY.

The regiment was recruited from a legislative or state senatorial district that included Broome Co. There were men from Tioga, Chemung, Steuben, and Allegany as well as Broome Co, and men from Tioga and Bradford Co, PA, were credited to towns all over the district.

The 161st didn't fight in any of the famous eastern battles, but along the Mississippi River at places that are now mostly forgotten. The regiment was organized in 1862, officers went to recruit companies from different towns. Replacements in 1863 and 1864 were recruited wherever they could be found, but enlistments in 1862 were mostly from these places:

Per WEW she broke her leg c. 1933 and, as it healed poorly, she thereafter used a brace and wheelchair. I feel she rebroke it abt. 1951 and it was improved. I remember no brace but recall her moving around slowly leaning on the handles of her wheelchair there being no "walkers" in those days. She and Aunt Grace had a TV at 393 Main St. that had been Uncle Brad's and possibly the first I ever saw. It was about a 2.5 foot cube with a screen possibly 11" diagonal in the center of the front. It had a green electric eye for tuning purposes that fascinated me and a complicated rotary dial like a radio which also included FM stations. It ultimately came to me and I finally disposed of it about 1993 after a year in my garden shed finally caused the case to crumble. When it was misbehaving during her last year, my father and I went to check it out. There was some good natured kidding that she had her own small tool kit and was quite willing to attack it with her screwdriver (perhaps for fine tuning purposes). It seems to me that she liked to watch Fred Waring on Sunday evenings especially because there was a performer in a wheel chair for which she had some sympathy. In the last 5 years of her life she suffered from a weak heart and was treated with nicotine pills and a cherry brandy. My father chided her about taking up smoking and drinking at her advanced age. It sticks in my mind that she had a liking for licorice and that we sometimes tried to give her a box of it on her birthday. Apparently toward the end she got a little vague, perhaps from spending so much time alone with her thoughts, and would sometimes throw Aunt Grace a curve when she came home from work as she would be operating in an earlier decade. I saw her last at Stan and Adair's wedding July 4, 1955. She died very peacefully. Aunt Grace was home suffering from shingles and sleeping irregular hours. Grandma apparently got herself up and went in to sit in her green leather platform rocker (which I have in storage) and quietly died. Hers was the first funeral I ever went to. One event shortly after her death sticks in my mind. We had picked up my grandmother in Belleville (as she was now living alone since Stan's wedding) to go out for ice cream and stopped at Aunt Grace's to see how she was. As she let us in, she went toward the kitchen for something and my father signalled me to sit in Grandma's chair so it would not sit empty while we visited. Aunt Grace, of course, had been rather housebound as it was too much for her to take Grandma places without help getting down 2 long flights of stairs. On the spur of the moment as we left my father asked Aunt Grace if she would like to go with us for ice cream. She was ready with the speed of light and never stopped going till the day she died.

2) According to WEW they tried to bury the wrong man. I believe my grandfather was in Irvington when he was struck by a passing vehicle while entering his own car. He suffered a severe head injury and died later in hospital. I seem to recall that it fell to Uncle Ev to go to Lyndhurst and tell the boys. Thirty years later he remembered tapping on the window trying to rouse my father who was sleeping on the couch. He seemed to think that was better than banging on the front door. My grandmother scandalized her mother by choosing to have the funeral from a funeral home rather than her own home. While she and my father waited at the Mortuary, the Funeral Director asked them what my grandfather had died of. This struck my father as a rather odd question and checking up he discovered that the wrong body had been retrieved from the hospital. Aunt Grace once told me that Uncle Brad commented at the funeral that given my grandfather's love of automobiles it was ironic that he only got to ride in a really fine one by dying. Following the funeral, Grandma said, family and friends came to her house to comfort her and in the process began looking at the old photo albums (which I have scanned). Sorrow and solemnity were replaced by hysterical laughter at the pictures of women in their high-fashion hats c. 1912.
