Was a school teacher before the Civil War.

Enlisted in Company I, 14th Alabama Infantry Regiment on July 29th, 1861. Listed as James H. White on rolls of the 14th Alabama. Was promoted to Sergeant. Was promoted to Lieutenant. Was wounded on 30 June 1862 at the Battle of Frayser's Farm, Seven Days Battles, Peninsula Campaign, Virginia. Was wounded on May 6, 1864 at the Battle of the Wilderness, Virginia. Medically disabled and retired from service December 1864.

After the war became a prominent citizen.

Was the County's first tax assessor after the war. Was removed from office by the Republican authorities as a "Hinderance to Reconstruction".

Served in the Alabama Legislature 1870 - 1872.

Admitted to the Bar in 1874. Began law practice in Talladega.

Was sent as a delegate to the Constitutional Convention in 1875.

Became a methodist minister.
