Notes for John W. R. Thomasson:

No further information has been found on John W. or Libby Thomasson since the birth of their last child. It is thought that they both died and that is why their children were raised by other family members.

Were their children born in Franklin Co., Georgia or Newberry Co., South Carolina. Did they move to Newberry, South Carolina (before/after parents 'died') and then raised by family members of Libby's?

1830 Franklin Co., Georgia census for Michael Dickert shows one male and female of the appropriate age for John & Libby. Could this be them??

Namesake?? In the 1820 GA Lottery, Walton County, William R. Thomason received 2 draws; speculation that he was a Revolutionary War soldier. On 9 mar 1822, a William R. Thomason gave power of attorney to Frederick Baldwin to sell Lot 329 in 3rd Dist. of Earley County. Walton GA C-D-26. William R. Thomason was a resident of former Jackson Co GA per Wayfarers in Walton, by Anita B. Sams.

2. Arnold P.³ Thomasson (John W. R.², George¹)^{3,4,5,6} was born 06 February 1831 in Newberry, South Carolina, and died Abt. 1862 in Gordonsville, Va. during the Civil War.. He married **Harriett Suber** Abt. 1855 in Newberry Co., South Carolina, daughter of John Suber and Mary (--?--). She was born 1831, and died 1884 in Newberry, South Carolina.

Notes for Arnold P. Thomasson:

As reported by Maggie (Peg) Thomasson, (my great aunt) his granddaughter: Arnold or his father left Ireland during the potato famine. Arnold went off to war between the states, never heard from again. Arnold was very opinionated, had little to do with others.

1920 census information on son, John Beauregard Thomasson, reports Arnold was born in Georgia.

Arnold's sister, Susanne (Cromer) named her second child, Jacob Preston. Could 'Preston' be the Arnold's middle name, OR is it Pressley, which is the middle name of James, his son.

Your great-great-grandfather Arnold Thomasson is definitely buried here, and we appreciate very much your interest in the accuracy and completeness of what we know about him (admittedly, that's very little). Thomasson is buried in an individual grave (i.e., *not* in a mass grave), but he does not have his own headstone.

However, his name, military unit, and grave number *are* listed on the large marble monument in the pictures I sent Debbie last year. The monument sits in the center of Lot 178 and lists the names of all 50 men buried there, including Thomasson.

State of South Carolina

County of Newberry

I, Texie E. Thomasson of Newberry County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, make my last will and testament as follows, hereby revoking any previously made will.

First, it is my wish that my husband, Andrew C. Thomasson, Sr., in case he survive me, shall have the use of all my property both real and personal as long as he lives.

Second, it is my will that my debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon as practicable after my death and for this purpose I desire that my place in No. 2 Township, known as the Knight Place containing 76 acres of land, more or less, be sold and the proceeds from same used for this purpose, the cost of same not to exceed \$1,000 and in case this place sells for more, the amount over this is to be divided equally among my three children, namely, Maggie V. Thomasson, Andrew C. Thomasson, and Janie Thomasson Davis.

Third, I give to my daughter, Janie Thomasson Davis the lot north of my home place, fronting on Shelby Street, between my residence and the lot belonging to my daughter, Maggie V. Thomasson.

Fourth, I give to my daughter, Maggie V. Thomasson, my home place fronting on Shelley Street.

Fifth, all of my personal property I wish equally divided among my three children, namely Maggie V. Thomasson, Andrew C. Thomasson, Janie Thomasson Davis.

Sixth, I have already made advances to my son, Andrew C. Thomasson, in the form of a building lot and for this reason he is not named here equally with my daughters.

I appoint my daughters, Maggie V. Thomasson and Janie Thomasson Davis, and my son, Andrew C. Thomasson, Jr. executors of this will.

Signed, sealed, and declared to be my last will and testament this 16th day of January, Nineteen Hundred and Thirty.
