2. MARY E.² FARMER (*JOHN*¹) was born March 04, 1821 in Edgefield County, South Carolina, and died July 15, 1906 in Lee Co., Alabama United States. She married JOHN HIRAM GREENE September 20, 1840 in Russell County, Alabama. He was born February 16, 1821 in Greenville, South Carolina, and died April 01, 1887 in Lee Co., Alabama United States.

Mary E. Farmer Green was born March 04, 1821 in Edgefield County, South Carolina. She died July 15, 1906 in Lee County, Salem, Alabama. She was married September 20, 1840 to John Hiram Green in Russell County, Alabama. They are buried in the Concord Baptist Church Cemetery in Lee County Salem, Alabama.

Mary was the Daughter of John and Sarah Farmer, We believe she was a Cherokee Indian although I can not find proof to back this up. The Creek Indians live in this part of Alabama and were still hostile when Mary and her family move to Alabama. I have reason to believe she spoke the Creek language because she taught Rev Cherry how to count in the Creek Indian language.

John Hiram Green was a blacksmith, locksmith, farmer, storekeeper, sort of a doctor, and a Methodist Sunday school teacher. He was born February 16, 1821 in the mountains of South Carolina in the Greenville area. He came to Russell County before 1840 from Georgia and died suddenly on April 1, 1887. (Lee County did not

exist until after the Civil War in 1866) Parts of Chambers, Macon and Russell counties became Lee county.

Mary Green (Aunt Fammie) and our Grandmother Frances Ruth Green (Fannie) were sisters who married brothers, John C. Long and James Warner Long (Papa). Aunt Fammie and Fannie were raised by there Grandmother (Mary E. Farmer Green) because there Mother Laura Ann Driskill Jones died young, date unknown after 1882 and before 1900.

These are some interesting historical notes about the original Pocahontas.

Pocahontas' father, Chief Powhatan of the Algonquin Nation, ruled the confederacy of Powhatan Indian tribes in Henri co and eastern Virginia.

Pocahontas was born about 1594 as MATOAKA, in the village of Werowocomoco, located on the north shore of the Pamunkey River (now called the York River), some eleven miles downstream from the present city of West Point, VA. Her father was Chief Powhatan who became chief of the 32-tribe Powatanas in 1570. The Powatan Confederacy were a well organized, thriving agricultural and fishing nation with a total population in the neighborhood of about 9,000 at the time that Matoaka was born. I do not believe we are related to this Pocahontas.

MRS. MARY GREEN AGE 85, IS DEAD.

She was one of the oldest residents of Motts Mill Community.

News reached the city yesterday of the death of Mrs. Mary Green, which occurred at her home near Motts Mill yesterday.

The deceased was 85 years old last March. She had been critically ill for some time and while her death was not unexpected, it was a shock to her family. She was well known by a host of friends, she, having lived at the place over a half century. She was a member of the Primitive Baptist Church, and was a devout Christian. She is survived by seven children; Miss M. A. Green, Mr. P.C. Green, Mr. J. D. Green, Mrs. Salita Prince, Mrs Laura Burton of Lee County, Mr M.S. Green of----- and Fannie Foster of Louisana, all of whom have the deep sympathy of their friends.

The funeral and interment will probably take place today.

The Rev. Francis Lafayette Cherry 1828-1887

The Rev. Cherry wrote a series of news paper articles which he used to write a book, The History of Opelika. Rev. Francis Lafayette Cherry who wrote the "History of Opelika" in 1881 was a Methodist Circuit Rider. He lived in Lee County, Alabama, the community of Pine Orchard near Motts Mill. He is buried in the Salem Methodist Church Cemetery on highway 280, the same cemetery where James Warner Long (Papa Long) and Frances Ruth Greene are buried. Mary E Greene, John Hiram Greene, Sarah Farmer, Pocahontas, Aunt Fammie, William H. Long and many more are buried in the Concord Baptist Church Cemetery on highway 280.

This is from Rev. Cherry's book page 190;

" The mode of counting among the Creeks of old Russell, was doubt-less very simple and easy to them, but will appear complex and tongue-twisting enough to the reader, as the following will show, which I learned from Mrs. Mary E. Greene, a venerable and worthy lady now living near Pine Orchard, and who resided in the county several years before the natives left, and from whose retentive memory I hope to draw much interesting matter-of fact, incident and anecdote, for the benefit of my readers. They counted on their fingers, and the units, in their

language, were:

Notes for JOHN HIRAM GREENE:

John Hiram Green is the first of that Family to settle in Lee County, Alabama. Not much is known of his background. He was born on February 16, 1821 in the mountains of South Carolina in the Greenville area. Also his mother and father were born in South Carolina. However, he came to Russell County Before 1840 From Georgia, and none of his family came with him. On March 23, 1855, he bought the farm south of Bleeker where he lived until his death. On September 20, 1840, he married Mary E. Farmer. He died suddenly on April 1, 1887 and is buried in Concord Cemetery.

John Hiram Green was a blacksmith, but did all kinds of metalwork, including locksmithing. He was also a sort of a doctor and a farmer. He also kept a store where he sold homemade products- - jams and jellies, salt-rising bread, meats and homespun thread and cloth.

He was a Methodist and a teacher in the Methodist Sunday School that met at Green School. He was known as an excellent and talented worker. the writer of his obituary said that "Mr. Green was noted for his honesty and straight-forwardness in every particular."

Mr. J. H. Green is Dead.

Mr. J. H. Green, a prominent farmer of Lee County, Ala., died suddenly yesterday morning about 8 o'clock. He went into a field to work. He complained of being cold and went to a fire to warm. He spread his hands over the fire and suddenly fell upon his back. When he was reached it was discovered that he was a corpse. It is supposed that heart disease was the cause of his death.

Mr Green leaves a wife and eight children. While he was not a member of any church, Mr. Green was noted for his honesty and straight-forwardness in every particular.

Following are the names of some of his children: Mr. Minus S. Green, who works for Smith & Newman on Twelfth street; Mrs J. G. Burton, P. C. Green, of Brownsville; Mrs. Forster, of Louisiana, Mrs. S. A. Prince, of Tallapoosa County, Ala.

The funeral will take place this Morning at 11 o'clock.

A Lodge of the Ancient Order of Free and Accepted Masons was organized in Crawford in the year 1848, which became the Tuckabachee Lodge. John H. Greene was a member and served as Master 1850-51.

She was 57 years of age a kind wife to a husband who still survives her and a devoted and loving mother of eight children, all of whom survive her. They are Mr. John Carroll of Valdosta, Ga., Martin Farmer Carroll of this city and Mrs. Pearl Herring, (This should be Hearn), Mrs. Mary Hood, and

Powhatan, Laura, Dovie and Myrtle Carroll of of this city. (Powhatan is a brother) The remains will be taken to Concord Church west of this city for internment. The deepest sympathy of the entire community is extended to the bereaved family." This was in the Columbus Ledger-Enquirer on June 25, 1902.

The interment notice was printed on June 26, 1902, and reads: "The funeral of Mrs. M. V. Carroll was conducted at the family residence yesterday at 1 o'clock by the Rev. J. K. Jenkins Pastor of West Side Baptist Church. The remains were taken by train to Concord Church burying grounds for interment. The following gentlemen acted as Pall bearers. (at this point I can make out a few names) Fred Worth, Thomas ?, C. M. Hearn and Oscar Harroll (probably Carroll)."

"Some information about John Carroll, son of Pocahontas and Melvin, He shot his son-in-law and killed him. I went to the jail in Phenix with my mother and grandmother to visit him. My grandmother was told if she could come up with \$600.00 they would drop all charges which they did and he was released. I am sure there was a trial but do not remember. My grandmother was a person who had to fix everything for everybody and I am so like her.

Also John's son Jesse shot and killed his wife because she left him. That happened in 1949. I do not recall what happened to him seems he was executed but not sure. Jesse's mother went to the governor and begged for his life. Laura's son and I do not know which one shot and killed a revenue man. they were operating a still in the woods. I do remember my grandmother saying the Campbell's lost everything to save him, he did not go to prison."
