

My 'Wolverton Family'

Generation No. 1

1. Charles W¹ Woolverton was born 1660 in Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England, and died 1746 in Rosemont, Hunterdon Co., NJ. He married **Mary Elizabeth Chadwick** 1697 in West Jersey. She was born 1674 in Springfield, Burlington, NJ, and died 1751 in Kingwood Township, NJ.

Notes for Charles W Woolverton:

Charles W Woolverton, who immigrated from England to America, was the progenitor of the Woolverton and Wolverton families in United States and Canada. The family was an old one in England, appearing under various forms of spelling, as for example, Wolfreton, Wolferston, Woolverstone, Woolverton, and Wolverton. Early records of the family are found in books on the history of the Isle of Wight. The oldest spelling appears to be Wolfreton, based on a thirteenth century record indicating that Sir Ralph de Wolfreton contributed two bowmen to defend the island. Other Isle of Wight records indicate that descendents of Sir Ralph changed the spelling to Woolverton.

Another traditional derivation of the name is based on the theory that the family seat, more than a thousand years ago, was near Wolverhampton, and that the family name was connected with the founding of the city. There is also a town in Middle England called Wolverton. A Book of Heraldry in the U of T Library includes two Woolverton coat of arms. One shows three wolf heads with the motto ' Que Sera Sera '. Another shield dating back to Henry III, belonged to a Wolverton family in Wolverton Parish, Buckinghamshire. An eagle is displayed over a belt of fire arms.

During the reign of Charles II of England, there was little religious liberty for Protestants. Many men with strong religious convictions, moved their families to America. These men were of various religious groups such as Puritans, Independents, Quakers and Churchmen who secured from the Crown, large estates in what is now known as Pennsylvania and New Jersey. Charles Woolverton who was a Quaker, disposed of his property in England and sailed to America.

It is said that Charles Woolverton, with his two brothers Gabriel and John as well as friends George Fox and William Penn, sailed from Dorsetshire England to America in 1682. A more detail account told a century later by a descendent

of Charles (Elizabeth Woolverton b. 1774), indicated that they sailed on the ship Welcome and landed at Newcastle, Delaware on November 1, 1682; that Gabriel and John died of small pox; and that they settled on Long Island and relocated to Burlington County, New Jersey in 1689. None of these facts have been verified as the earliest record of Charles W Woolverton in America is a land purchase of 100 acres in Burlington County, NJ from William Biddle dated 20 August, 1693. There are 16 recorded land transfers in New Jersey made by Charles before his death in 1746. With the exception of legal documents, little is known about his life and last days. He wrote a number of religious tracts of which three have survived. There is no documented record of his parents in England. Notes for Mary Elizabeth Chadwick:

The identity of Mary's father remains undetermined. Mary was born prior to her mother Elizabeth's three recorded marriages. Her mother married Isaac Leet in 1685, followed by John Chadwick in 1688, and John Dickson at a later date. The name Mary Chadwick is generally accepted as being the wife of Charles as her mother Elizabeth was still married to John Chadwick in 1697 when Mary and Charles were married.

Notes for Thomas Woolverton:

Thomas Woolverton was the son-in-law of Col. Joseph Barton, the most notorious Loyalist of Sussex County. In 1777, Thomas along with the Pettit and Barton families were identified as Tories by the local authorities. He was convicted under a law providing that any person who aided the British enemy between April 1775 and October 1776 and did not take an oath of allegiance to the state was subject to conviction for high treason and forfeiture of his property. Thomas spent six months in jail and on April 17, 1780, his confiscated property in Sussex County, NJ was sold at auction. Where the family lived between 1780 and 1783 is not known, but they may have gone to Washington Co. PA to live with his brother John's family until the end of the American Revolution in 1783.

In July 1783 Thomas-3 and his family sailed from NY to Saint John, NB on the ship Lord Townsend. The passengers list shows Thomas with one female (Catharine Barton Woolverton), two children older than 10 (Elizabeth Ann

Woolverton, Ann Barton) and three children younger than 10 (Joseph Barton Woolverton, Barent Barton, Charlotte Barton). His two sons from a previous marriage, Thomas(22) and Joseph(19) remained with their Uncle John Woolverton in PA.

The Wolverton, Barton and Pettit families settled on farm land in Maugerville, Sunbury CO., NB located a few miles south of Fredericton on the opposite side of the St. John river. Thomas Woolverton's 1789 land grant of 500 acres was located next to the Barton's land grant. In 1796 Thomas was granted 262 acres of land in Northampton, Carleton County, NB. He relocated his family to the new farm in Northampton, which is located just south of Woodstock on the opposite side of the Saint John river. Additional grants in the same area were received in 1813 by Thomas and his son Joseph. The land was farmed for many generations by Thomas descendents.

Notes from the book 'The Woolverton Family 1693-1850 and Beyond':
Thomas-3 was the progenitor of NB Wolvertons. Based on St. Luke's Church records in Woodstock, 'Thomas Wolverton, 76, of the Parish of Northampton, NB, was buried in that parish on 14 September 1819'. His age appears to have been recorded in error based on the fact that he signed a legally binding document in 1758 and was the eldest son of Thomas-2. Based on this information he was born in 1735 rather than 1742 and died at the age of 84.

The theory that Thomas-3 had two sons named Joseph is based on the fact that property was registered to a Joseph Woolverton in PA before Joseph Barton Wolverton was of age. No other evidence of his existence has been found.

Notes for Joseph Barton Woolverton:

Joseph Barton Woolverton was 6 years old when his Empire Loyalist father (Thomas-3) immigrated from the US to Maugerville, Sunbury CO., NB in 1783. Joseph's mother (Catharine Barton) and his half sister (Elizabeth Ann) were the only other family members that came with them. A half brothers Thomas and Joseph went to live with their uncle John Woolverton in Washington County, PA and never immigrated to NB. A younger brother (James Barton) was born in Maugerville, NB in 1785 but immigrated to the United States following an altercation (based on family stories) with his father and Joseph.

The Woolverton farm in Maugerville was a short distance from the land granted to Dr. John Larlee in 1787. Dr Larlee immigrated from France and was the first white doctor on the Saint John river. Joseph married John Larlee's daughter Jane in 1798 and moved further up the St. John River to his father's farm in Northampton, which had been obtained as a land grant in 1796. Their first child (1 of 11) was born in Northampton in 1799. Additional Northampton land grants were made to Joseph, his father Thomas, John Larlee Sr. and John Larlee Jr. in 1818. Six additional land grants totalling 650 acres were obtained by Joseph Barton Wolverton and his male descendents during the eighteen hundreds. Joseph's first born son (Thomas Thatcher Woolverton) continued the family trend of settling further up the St. John River by purchasing a farm in River de Chute, Wicklow Parish, in 1832.

Note: There are a number of minor conflict with data for Joseph Barton Woolverton in the book ' Woolverton Family 1693-1850 and Beyond ' published July 2001. (1) Joseph was born in 1777 in Sussex County NJ - not 1779-1780 in Washington County, PA. Joseph Woolverton's head stone in St. Luke's Cemetery, Lower Woodstock, NB indicates that Joseph was 66 years old when he died on 26 April 1843. Joseph's age at death is also confirmed by Vital Statistics Vol 10 item #917 dated 6 May 1843. The Anglican Church Northampton Parish Register (archives film F1056) indicates Joseph died at age

63. This hand written church document #206 is very clear but a recording error appears to have been made. (2) Joseph and Jane were married Nov 17, 1798 - not Nov 17, 1799. The hand written church record (Archive film F8508 record #3) confirms the 1798 marriage date.

Notes for Leonard Oscar Wolverton:

Leonard went to Colorado in 1883 when he was 18 years old to work in the lumber woods cutting mining props. He returned home in 1890 and bought a farm in Upper Knoxford, Carleton County, NB. The 150 acre farm had a very small clearing. He cleared the land and built two large barns and a nine room house. In 1891 he married Mary Gallup of Upper Knoxford and they raised six children. A nearby farm of 100 acres, with house and barn, was purchased in order to provide additional farm land for his two sons. However, only his youngest son Miles remained on the family farm. Leonard had a paralytic stroke at age 52 and later developed gangrene in his foot. Leonard died at age 62 and

his wife Mary died one year later.

Notes for Miles Atwood Wolverton:

Miles was born on the Upper Knoxford family farm and lived there his entire life. Potatoes were grown as the main cash crop and horses were used throughout his life to haul the farm equipment and work in the lumber woods. He was fond of horses as work animals and raised six of them from one brood mare. He was self educated as an electrician and auto mechanic. During a number of years the price of potatoes dropped below a dollar a barrel (165 lb.) which was below the cost of growing them. During these years he supplemented family income by repairing Neighbours tractors. When public electricity was extended from Centreville to rural communities he also wired numerous farm houses for a reasonable price. Collecting payment for the electrical supplies and labour often stretched over a number of years. Although offered a number of jobs as a full time electrician, he refused to leave the farm. He was determined to carry on the tradition of maintaining a family farm for future generations. Miles died at the early age of 47 in 1950, and he never knew that six generations of Wolverton family farming had come to an end in NB.
