JANE GREENWOOD (JOHN ANDREWS WOODCOCK'S MOTHER-IN -LAW/ANNE FLIGHT'S MOTHER JANE GREENWOOD DIES .THE UNDERTAKER WAS JOHN WOODCOCK OF STRAFORD ESSEX (POSSIBLY THE FATHER OR BROTHER/A RELATIVE OF JOHN ANDREWS WOODCOCK. ANN FLIGHT WAS A SCHOOL MISTRESS AT STRATFORD GREEN STRATFORD AND REMAINED IN STRATFORD ESSEX FOR MOST OF HER LIFE. HER GRAND FATHER HANSON FLIGHT (1773-1823) OWNED ABBEY MILL, STRAFORD,ESSEX AND ALSO ONE AT BERMONDSEY SURREY.THE STATFORD MILL SUPPLIED NOT ONLY THE WHOLE OF LONDON BUT ALSO ALL OF WELLINGTON'S ARMY WITH FLOUR DURING THE PENINSULA WAR. HANSON'S SON JOSEPH (ANNE'S BROTHER) BECAME MILLER OF ABBEY MILLS IN HIS TURN ANNE'S GRANDFATHER( HANSON )ELDER BROTHER; THOMAS FLIGHT PURCHASED THE WORCESTER PORCELAIN COMPANY IN 1783 FOR STG POUNDS 3000 HAVING PREVIOUSLY BEEN THE LONDON AGENT FOR THE COMPANY AT THE WAREHOUSE IN 2 BREAD ST. LONDON. THE WORCESTER PORCELAIN COMPANYWAS RUN BY THOMAS'S TWO SONS JOHN (1766-1791)& JOSEPH(1759-1851).ON 2 MAR 1789 AFTER A VISIT FROM KING GEORGE 3RD. THEY WERE GRANTED THE ROYAL WARRANT/APPOINTMENT. ANNE MARRIED JOHN ANDREWS WOODCCOCK(CARPENTER & BAKER ) 18 SEPT 1824 AFTER HE DIED IN 1857 APPROX ANNE (AGED ONLY 32 YRS ) CONTINUED TO RAISE 6 CHILDREN AND RESIDED AT VARIOUS ADDRESS'S NEAR STATFORD:- 1839 PIGGOT'S DIRECTORY. SCHOOLS IN STRATFORD SARAH ANN & ELIZA WOODCOCK(HER NIECES) 1840 PIGOT'S PROVINCIAL DIRECTORY UNDER ACADEMIES & SCHOOLS ANN WOODCCOCK MARYLAND POINT. 1841 CENSUS MARYLAND POINT.(AS LODGERS WITH MARY STERLING,LAUNDRESS) 1851 CENSUS LANGTHORNEE PLACE STRATFORD.( HER ELDEST CHILDREN JOHN(25 YRS ) AND HANSON (AGED 23 YEARS) HAD LEFT HOME AND HENRY,CHARLES,CATHERINE & JOSEPH WERE STILL WITH HER. 1861 CENSUS 220 LANGTHORNE PLACE STRATFORD ANNE NOT LISTED BUT HER DAUGHTER CATHERINE LISTED AS AGE 26 YEARS UNMARRIED SCHOOL

UNFORTUNATELY JOSEPH'S FATHER JOHN ANDREWS WOODCOCK DIED 23RD JULY 1836,JUST 2MONTHS AFTER HIS BIRTH. AT THE TIME OF THE 1881 CENSUS APRIL 1881 JOSEPH AND FAMILY WERE RESIDING AT 78 HENNIKER ROAD STRATFORD AND HIS OCCUPATION WAS A MACHINIST PROBABLY WITH THE RAILWAY YARDS(NOT YET CONFIRMED).

As at the 1891 census the family resided in Islington South (London) ;Henry was not listed and at age 27years one could assume he maybe married or moved out on his own; Everyone else was home and the records indicate they had a Lodger Rosetta Moore age 45 (DOB 1846 Birmingham Warwickshire).
