Bryant S. was 23 when he married Eliza, she was 21. When he was 29 years old he received 160 acres in the Cherokee Land Lottery of 1838 on the first day of January 1838. [ Listed in the Georgia Cherokee Land Lottery of 1838 page 282, Fourth District, Second Section, Cherokee, Bryan S. Rutledge, Say's, Dekalb, Garnter the previous to the first day of January, 1838.] This land lies in Walker Co., GA where he farmed this land.

Dear Jane,

Yes, I received all of the information from Stella the other day. I have done a brief once-over but nothing intensive at this time. Thank you very much for forwarding the information as well as the photos of the "family" including you and your husband. I will gather some materials that you may find interesting also and send them to you in the not too distant future.

I wish that I could regale you with family stories that would paralyze you with drama and fascination, but there isn't a lot to be told. I never met my grandparents, Thomas Albert and Lula Tant Rutledge but I did spend a great deal of time with my maternal grandparents, Michael and Christina Filiak who emigrated to the United States from the Ukraine just before the Russian Revolution. They lived most of their lives in New York City, not far from La Guardia Airport. They operated an ice cream fountain/notions store for many years and lived in an apartment above the store. Grandfather Mike died around 1954 and grandmother Christina died in January, 1994 at the age of 98 and is buried in Manchester, Connecticut. She lived the last few years of her life in a Ukrainian Orthodox Church Home where she was surrounded by people from the "old" country.

My grandparents had two children, my mother Irene and her brother, my Uncle Bill Filiak. I knew Bill as a child shortly after he returned from the service. Bill was a colorful guy, very handsome, trained in electrical engineering. During WWII, he was part of the famed Merrill's Marauders commando group that operated in Burma behind enemy lines. They were cut off for a period of three months and had to work their way back to friendly territory living off of the jungle. In the late 50s or early 60s Hollywood made a movie about their exploits -

Merrill's Marauders with Jeff Chandler in the lead. I suspect the ordeal was much worse than depicted in the movies. Uncle Bill was never the same after his return and after living in New York and doing some odd jobs, he disappeared. Occasionally he would surface somewhere and send a letter to my mother asking for some money but he couldn't say why as he said he was working undercover for Israeli intelligence (the Mossad). So, it was sad. He just dropped off the face of the earth about ten years ago. No one has heard anything since.

My father, James Lexington, was a pilot in the early days of aviation, flying the mail as well as an airline pilot for one of the early carriers - Hanford Airlines. Prior to that, he had run away from home in Florence, SC and jumped on steamer and traveled pretty much around the world working on board ship and basically raising hell. He was always interested in flying and became a pilot at an early age. He worked his way down to South America and by 1917 or 1918 was active with the Nicaraguan Army Air Corps (I didn't even know they had one) where he attained the rank of Major. Essentially, he was a mercenary, a soldier of fortune. It was after his exploits in South America that he returned to the States and began flying the mail and for Hanford. In 1941, he became the executive pilot for the old Electric Autolite Company in Toledo, Ohio and flew for them until his death in 1958. I believe he was married once before, but I don't know to who. My sister Lexi may know more details about that and, if so, I'll pass it on to you. Between me and Lexi, we have a lot of information, old pictures, news clippings, etc. surrounding our parents. As I sit in my office typing this e-mail, I am looking at a picture of my father shaking hands with Bill Lear. You would know him as the developer of Lear Aircraft and the Learjet. My father taught him how to fly. Additionally, it was Bill Lear who introduced him to my mother. Some years ago, while attending a conference in Florida, I chanced to meet Moira Lear, Bill's widow. She was the keynote speaker at the event and I introduced myself and informed her, that had it not been for her husband, I wouldn't exist. We had a nice laugh.

I never knew Uncle William Rutledge, my Dad's brother and I only met Stella once when I was quite young. Once again, I believe that my sister Lexi possesses much more material and information than I do. Be patient, I will send you information as I am able to sequester time to do so. In the meanwhile, stay warm, as spring isn't far away. I heard birds this morning.
