According to Norman Hartshorn, the Smith family lived in or near Harrisville and Pike, both in West Virginia. Information regarding the Smith children was provided by Gloria Lewis, great-great-granddaughter of Nimrod Smith, Jr.

Nimrod served six months (from Aug. 1863 until 1864) as a private in the 4th West Virginia Cavalry of the Union Army. He is described as a farm laborer in the 1870 and 1880 census.

Nimrod is listed in the 1870 census as black but in the 1880 census as white. I suspect that he may have been

Melungeon, or what is considered tri-racial. This mixture - which most experts believe combines European, Native American and African blood - is common throughout Appalachia. There has long been a tradition in the family that Samantha Bella Smith, Nimrod's daughter, was dark complexioned and the source of Native American blood in the family. Claims of Native American ancestry were common in many families that had a Melungeon ancestor, as Melungeon blood was considered the worse of two evils.

Also, my family has certain common Melungeon physical characteristics and disabilities. I as well as two distant cousins in two different lines descending from Nimrod have a bump at the back of the head. Nimrod B. Smith is reported to have been dismissed from the Union Army because of "disability rheumatism and liver complaint". Both of those symptoms are common to sufferers of Familial Mediterranean Fever, or FMF, a disease prevalent among those of Melungeon descent. Other family members suffer or have suffered from migraines, colitis, chronic fatigue syndrome and gall bladder pain; these are often misdiagnosed symptoms of FMF.

An interesting report provided by Roxann Hoover follows:

"Told to me by my Aunt Louisa 'Liza' Burga West.

Mary 'Macie' (Haines) Burga was my great grandmother. She had two brothers 'King' & 'Tom'. Two sisters Mary Baylis [Note: this likely is Nancy, who married Richard Bayles] and Charlotte. The family farm was where Baltimore Maryland stands today. The boys left home when young never returned or was heard from again. Most couldn't read or write to communicate. Mary 'Macie's' father was John Haines. John left with a drove of hogs to 'drive' them to market. He never returned home & they thought he was murdered. His wife finally left the land & and never returned to claim it.

Mildred Mallonee"

The report seems in some ways to relate to this family but refers to the father as John. Also, Tom did not, in actualiy, "disappear". He lived in Ohio near Mary 'Macie'.

Danny Haynes' sage analysis of this oral history follows:

"No doubt John or Charles Haynes died or disappeared after taking some hogs to market or maybe he was stealing some hogs and got shot or maybe like his brother Thomas decided to abandon the family. The fact is that both Charles Haynes and his wife Mary are gone/dead by 1860. As to the family farm in MD that too may have been Charles Haynes telling stories to his children about his father's (Thomas Hayne 1760) farm in MD. As our Charles was most likely born in KY he would have never seen this farm but surely would have heard about it from his father. As for the brothers leaving the farm in MD, I think this may refer to Thomas Hayne 1760 and his brother Daniel Hayne 1762. Of course this is all

Each legatie to receive in proportion to their claim (Except two, my tow daughters Margaret Garrett and Isabella Haymaker, they in that case to have the preference of one hundred dollars a year = each till they are paid off. All of the sum paid William Barcust, husband of my daughter, Nancy Dec.d.) amounting to five hundred dollars can be collected from said William Barcust in that case I give and bequeath (the said five hundred dollars to my three grandsons, (sons of said Nancy Barcust Dec.d. to wit Isaac Barcust, Jacob Barcust, and Joshua Barcust, to be equally divided between them. Given under by hand and seal of the Province, the 28th day of June, 1668, and the 20th year of the raigne of our Sovereign Lord Charles the Second, of England and Ireland King defender of the faith (signed) Ph. "E. B. Huntington, A Genealogical Memoir of the Lo-Lathrop Family in This Country Embracing . . ." (Ridgefield, Conn., 1884), is a well presented family history, especially for John Lothrop's life in England and America. Lothrop's family can be traced back a number of generations in England, and his own baptism is recorded at Etton, Yorkshire, 20 December 1584. He graduated from Cambridge University with a B.A. in 1605, and M.A. in 1609. He became curate of the church at Egerton, County Kent from ca. 1611 to 1623. In 1623 he was called to succeed Rev. Henry Jacob (who had left for Virginia) at the First Independent Church in Southwark, Surrey. Independent worship being illegal, Lothrop's services were conducted in secret. In 1632 he was imprisoned, but released on bail in 1634. Nathaniel Morton (New Englands Memoriall, p. 140-41) relates some of his background, including the death of his first wife in England. Huntington, p. 25, quotes from Governor Winthrop's Journal under date of 18 September 1634 "The Griffin and another ship now arriving with about 200 passengers. Mr. Lathrop and Mr. Sims, two godly ministers coming in the same ship." That same year Lothrop went to Scituate, where he formed the first church there, and then in 1639 the church divided and Lothrop went with the group that settled at Barnstable, becoming minister there, too. His records of some activities and events at Scituate and Barnstable are in NEHGR 9:279-87, 10:37-43; also see text. Two of his letters of 1638 to Governor Prence mention in rather vague terms the forthcoming move from Scituate (Huntington, p. 28-32). One of the letters is also signed by Anthony Aniball, _____ (no doubt Henry) Cobb, and _____ (no doubt Isaac) Robinson "In behalf of the church." He became a freeman on 7 June 1637 (PCR 1:60).
