

# *Descendants of Thomas Hayne*

## *Generation No. 1*

1. **Thomas<sup>1</sup> Hayne<sup>1</sup>** was born Abt. 1760 in Maryland, and died 20 juil. 1845 in Jefferson County, Ohio.

Notes for Thomas Hayne:

Len Haynes traces this line back further to Maryland: Francis Hayne and Isabella Canner; William Haynes and Mary Bennett; William Haynes and Mary Schooling. The Maryland connection is not yet proven to beyond a reasonable doubt.

Danny Haynes has provided the following will of Thomas Hayne:

I Thomas Hayne of Smithfield Township, Jefferson County, Ohio, do hereby make, constitute and appoint this my last will and testament. First, I hereby order my just debts and funeral expenses to be paid with cost of Administration. And touching such goods as it had pleased God to bless me with in this life. I give and bequeath of the Same in the following manner.

1st. Give and bequeath to my beloved son Charles Hayne in addition to what I have already given him, the further sum of One Dollar.

2. I give and bequeath to my daughter in-law Catharine Hayne (formerly wife of my son Thomas Hayne) the sum of Fifty Dollars - also to Arbella Hayne, the sum of Fifty Dollars - also to Mary Hayne the sum of Fifty Dollars, these two last being grand daughters, children of my son Thomas Hayne these three last mentioned legacies being in full of my Son Thomas Hayne Legacy -

3. I hereby give and bequeath to my beloved son King Hayne in addition to what I have already given him, the further sum of One Dollar -

4th - I give and bequeath to my dutiful Daughter Nancy Barcust in addition to what she has already got, the further sum of twenty Five Cents -

6th I give and bequeath to the Eight Children of my dutiful daughter Mary Hooper Dec.d the sum of Four hundred Dollars to be Equally divided between the aforesaid Eight children, the Said four hundred dollars to be retained in the hands of James McCoy (who I hereby appoint their Guardian) till they arrive at legal age. Also to my grand daughter Elizabeth Hooper, I hereby give and bequeath One Feather bed and bedding -

7th I give and bequeath to my dutiful daughter, Margaret Garrett, the sum of five Hundred Dollars -

8th I give and bequeath to my daughter Isabella Haymaker the house and lot she now lives in and on, and the further sum of Four Hundred Dollars -

8. I hereby give and bequeath to my dutiful daughter Elizabeth Hayne, in what I addition to have already given her the household and kitchen furniture (Except the feather bed and bedding bequeathed to Elizabeth Hooper) and stock I own, the money legacies to be paid to the legaties or Guardian as soon as the money becomes due from William Barkust and can be collected.

Each legatie to receive in proportion to their claim (Except two, my tow daughters Margaret Garrett and Isabella Haymaker, they in that case to have the preference of one hundred dollars a year = each till they are paid off. All of the sum paid William Barcust, husband of my daughter, Nancy Dec.d.) amounting to five hundred dollars can be collected from said William Barcust in that case I give and bequeath (the said five hundred dollars to my three grandsons, (sons of said Nancy Barcust Dec.d. to wit Isaac Barcust, Jacob Barcust, and Joshua Barcust, to be equally divided between them. They the so afore named Barcust, waiting for their shares, till the last payment is due and paid by William Barcust their Father, and after all my bequeaths are paid, my just debts and funeral expenses and costs of Administration discharged, if a surplus still remains, in that case, I hereby give and bequeath the same to my dutiful daughter Elizabeth Hayne -

Lastly I hereby nominate and appoint James McCoy Executor of this my last will and testament. Hereby revoking all others and confirming this to be my last will and testament – in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Eleventh day of September, Eighteen Hundred and Forty Four.

Notes for King Hayne:  
Danny Haynes writes:

"We certainly can not dismiss the given name King in our Haynes lines. I can find no other King Haynes anywhere in Ohio or the U.S. for that matter between 1800 and 1900 except in our family. There is a King Haynes in 1840/50 in Decatur Twp Washington county OH of sufficient age to be the brother of our Charles. Our Charles Haynes had a son King and my gr gr grandfather Thomas Haynes had a son King Haynes. My Noland lines that married into the Haynes line named some of their sons King as well as Mary Macie Haynes Bergy's lines had King for a given name."

#### *Generation No. 2*

**7. Charles<sup>2</sup> Haynes** (Thomas<sup>1</sup> Hayne)<sup>7,8,9,10</sup> was born Abt. 1797 in Kentucky. He married **Mary Mason Watts**<sup>11,12,13</sup> 01 juil. 1819 in Jefferson County, Ohio. She was born Abt. 1794 in Maryland.

Notes for Charles Haynes:  
Charles is cited as a farmer in the 1850 census.

An interesting report provided by Roxann Hoover follows:

"Told to me by my Aunt Louisa 'Liza' Burga West.

Mary 'Macie' (Haines) Burga was my great grandmother. She had two brothers 'King' & 'Tom'. Two sisters Mary Baylis [Note: this likely is Nancy, who married Richard Bayles] and Charlotte. The family farm was where Baltimore Maryland stands today. The boys left home when young never returned or was heard from again. Most couldn't read or write to communicate. Mary 'Macie's' father was John Haines. John left with a drove of hogs to 'drive' them to market. He never returned home & they thought he was murdered. His wife finally left the land & and never returned to claim it.

Mildred Mallonee"

The report seems in some ways to relate to this family but refers to the father as John. Also, Tom did not, in actualiy, "disappear". He lived in Ohio near Mary 'Macie'.

Danny Haynes' sage analysis of this oral history follows:

"No doubt John or Charles Haynes died or disappeared after taking some hogs to market or maybe he was stealing some hogs and got shot or maybe like his brother Thomas decided to abandon the family. The fact is that both Charles Haynes and his wife Mary are gone/dead by 1860. As to the family farm in MD that too may have been Charles Haynes telling stories to his children about his father's (Thomas Hayne 1760) farm in MD. As our Charles was most likely born in KY he would have never seen this farm but surely would have heard about it from his father. As for the brothers leaving the farm in MD, I think this may refer to Thomas Hayne 1760 and his brother Daniel Hayne 1762. Of course this is all supposition. A Thomas Haynes and a Charles Haynes both brought property out of the Marietta Land office about the same times, I think without looking it up around 1823-8. I do not find any record of King Haynes buying property in Ohio."

Notes for Mary Mason Watts:  
According to Danny Haynes:

"1. Mary gives her birth as Maryland in the 1850 census

2. Thanks to Roxanne Hoover providing the death certificate of Mary Macy Haynes Burgy, the mother of Mary is given as Mary M. Watts. The informant was John Bergy, son of Mary Macy Haynes Bergy, and grandson of Mary Haynes, wife of Charles 1797. John does not give Mary Bergy's father's name. He also states both Mary's mother and father were born in Germany. John Bergy's grandparents died before he was born. He undoubtedly knew that one set (The Burgy) spoke German. He assumed they were from Germany. In fact the Burgy come from Switzerland but they did indeed speak German. John Bergy I believe got the Mary M. Watts right but confused the two sets of grandparents.

3. There is no one with the surname Watts in Jefferson county Ohio inn 1850.

4. There are several families in Jefferson county OH with the maiden name Watts.

At this time, I am adding Mary Mason Watts as the wife of our Charles 1797. I am 99% sure of this."

Notes for King Haynes:

Spelled alternately "Hains" and "Hanes" in the census records from 1850-1910.

King is cited as a laborer in the 1850 census and as a farmer in the 1860, 1870 and 1880 censuses.

A number of researchers believe that King was named after his mother's surname, i.e. that his mother was named Mary King.

According to Norman Hartshorn:

The Haynes family lived by the Ohio River. Cyrus was so poor that, in order to earn money, he salvaged and sold pieces of coal that had fallen from passing boats into the river. It was on a cold day of panning for coal that he fell ill and eventually died.

Notes for Samantha Belle Smith:

According to Norman Hartshorn, Samantha suffered a stroke in later life and subsequently moved in with her daughter Elizabeth, who cared for her in Samantha's home in Steubenville.

More About Samantha Belle Smith:

Cause of Death: stroke
